

In 12/67, McCARVER was back in Eureka Springs visiting. In about 2/68, McCARVER was on a drinking spree with GERDON WHITNER, during which WHITNER told McCARVER that he was aware of McCARVER's background and asked McCARVER what it would take to get McCARVER to eliminate MARTIN LUTHER KING. McCARVER advised WHITNER he would not get involved in this type of a deal. WHITNER stated it did not matter, as "King would die." McCARVER pointed out that WHITNER has a strong dislike for Negroes and talked in terms of doing the community a service by eliminating KING.

McCARVER stated that after this drinking spree he traveled to the State Hospital, Topeka, Kansas, where he admitted himself and was under the care of Dr. SHAKER for three months. McCARVER stated that about a week after he entered this hospital KING was killed.

McCARVER felt that GERDON WHITNER could shed light on the killing. McCARVER stated he would be available to answer additional questions if necessary, and again requested his name not be linked to the information.

It is noted that in Memphis airtel they instruct the Butte Division to furnish the information in a form suitable for dissemination; however, if the information is disseminated, WHITNER would not have any difficulty determining where the information came from. This would greatly jeopardize the life of MORRIS R. McCARVER.

It would appear that if the information must be disseminated to outside sources, such as the Memphis PD, it would be safer to disseminate the information verbally and not make mention of MORRIS R. McCARVER or the offer made to him.by WHITNER.

UACB, Butte Division will not set information out in a form suitable for dissemination, as to do so might very possibly jeopardize the life of McCARVER.



### NOTE:

Butte advised Memphis by letter (no copies to Bureau) that one Morris R. McCarver has told Agents of the Butte Office that just prior to King's murder (King murdered 4-4-68), he, McCarver, was approached by one Gerdon Whitner of Eureka Springs, Arkansas, who was asked what it would take to get McCarver to kill King. Memphis instructed Butte to furnish this information to the Bureau and Memphis in a form suitable for dissemination and instructed Little Rock to locate and interview Whitner.

McCarver also said that Whitner offered him a considerable sum of money in 1953 to eliminate Orval Faubus, former Governor of Arkansas, but McCarver turned down the offer. Little Rock is interviewing Whitner for full details regarding this information and upon receipt of same it will be evaluated to determine if appropriate authorities should be notified. It is further noted that McCarver admitted himself to a State Hospital for three months in 1968 (type of hospital unknown).

Butte, by their communication dated 4-16-69, advised that unless the Bureau advised to the contrary, they will not set the information out in a form suitable for dissemination, as to do so might very possibly jeopardize the life of McCarver.

Butte being instructed to submit the information in a form suitable for dissemination as the information contains an allegation of a possible conspiracy and will be disseminated to the Department.

Kansas City being instructed to determine hospital in which McCarver allegedly admitted himself and full details surrounding same.

- 1. BURGESS was interviewed with regards to his letter of 3 PSB 69 to the Director, P.B.I. BURGESS could not supply any information regarding the Dr. KING murder. It is the opinion of this investigator that BURGESS is unstable mentally and that most of his letter was his imagination with a small part being information he obtained from local news media.
- 2. BURGERS is 39 years old and resides by himself in a house which was left to him by his parents. The house is very run-down outside and the immediate area is very messy. The interior of the house is very filthy, having numerous piles of garbage and other debris scattered around. BURGESS could be classified as a hermit, although he leaves the house delly and hitch-hikes continually to London and St. Thomas, int.
- Prior to the interview with BERGESS, several enquiries were made to try and verify some of the points brought out in the letter. Enquiries conducted with regards to Verna PEARSON proved negative, as no such person had ever resided at 52 Hincks St., St. Thomas. As far back as could be checked, there was no record of Verna PEARSON.
- 4. BURGESS has also written letters to the Ontario Provincial olice and the London City P.D., attempting to assist them in investigations. The London P.D. investigator has also interviewed BUFGESS and reached the same opinion as I did.
- 5. At present, SURGESS is in the process of writing another letter to the Director, F.R.I.
- 6. I feel BURGESS would not harm anyone, although I believe he could cause embarrassment to dignitaries visiting in this area. A photograph of BURGESS will be obtained and forwarded under separate cover with all particulars concerning him so that a V.I.P. Surveillance card can be distributed. Report will be submitted under appropriate scaption.

This is the case involving the murder of Martin Luther King, Jr. A new Memphis Criminal Court Judge, Arthur Faquin, took over the James Earl Ray matter following the sudden death of Judge W. Preston Battle.

My memorandum of 4-7-69 reported that Memphis Office has advised that Mr. Don Owens (a local attorney and advisor to Judge Battle prior to his death) had informed that Latent Fingerprint Examiner George J. Bonebrake who was scheduled to appear 4-11-69 in Criminal Court, Memphis, at possible contempt hearing, would not have to report on that date unless advised to the contrary; further that while this was not an official notification, he felt certain the Bonebrake matter would be considered closed.

On 4-21-69, Memphis Office advised that Judge Faquin is still studying this matter and had tenatively set a new hearing date for Bonebrake on 5-23-69. He is primarily concerned with matters relating to the Ray's appeal and it is believed that a final decision as to what he will do in the Bonebrake matter should be forthcoming before 5-23-69. Bonebrake is aware of new hearing date. Memphis will keep us advised.

### JAMES EARL RAY

Raul Victor Esquivel, Sr., was interviewed at his residence, 4524 Persimmons Street, Metairie, Louisiana. Esquivel identified himself as a Trooper with the Louisiana State Police, and stated he had been so employed for the past ten and one-half years. He further advised that he had been assigned to Troop B of the State Police in Metairie, Louisiana, for the past several years.

Esquivel stated that he has resided at his present residence for the past several years, that he built the residence himself, that he has raised his family in that residence, and that at the present time, only he and his wife are residents of the home. He stated that his son, Raul Esquivel, Jr., is married, resides in New Orleans and that he is a grandparent as a result of his son's marriage, his grandson having been mamed Raul Esquivel, III. Esquivel furnished the following information:

Upon observation of a photograph of Charles J. Stein, Esquivel did not recognize Stein as a person he has ever seen, nor did he recall of having ever heard of the name Charles Stein. Upon observation of three photographs of James Earl Ray, including two front and one right profile, Esquivel recognized Ray for the reason that Ray's photographs were widely publicized following his identification as the individual who assassinated Martin Luther King. Esquivel has never been personally acquainted with Ray and to the best of his knowledge has never personally observed Ray, except by photographs through news media. Esquivel has never visited Canada, Mexico, Birmingham, Alabama, or Memphis, Tennessee. Esquivel has no personal knowledge of James Earl Ray.

According to "Look" magazine articles concerning activities of James Earl Ray, the following dates are noted wherein Ray and his friend "Raoul" are alleged to have been together.

July 18 - August 24, 1967

According to "Look" magazine articles, subject met "Raoul" in Canada on about eight occasions during this period.

August 21, 1967

Subject Ray and "Raoul" were in Windsor, Canada.

August 28 - 30, 1967

Ray met "Raoul" during this period in Birmingham, Alabama.

October 7 - 10, 1967

Ray arrived San Francisco Hotel, Acapulco, Mexico, on October 10, 1967. One or two days prior to that time, he met "Raoul" in Nuevo Laredo, Mexico.

December 17 - 19, 1969

Ray met "Raoul" at New Orleans, Louisiana, and received \$2500

from him.

April 4, 1968

"Raoul" allegedly was in Memphis, Tennessee, and fired the shot at 6:00 PM that killed Martin Luther King.

Prior investigation has disclosed that Trooper Esquivel had worked as follows during the month of August, 1967:.

August 1, 2, and 3:

On Duty; 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM

August 4:

August 5:

On Duty; 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM

August 6 and 7:

Off duty due to a death in

his family.

On duty; 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

August 24:

Off Duty.

August 25 and 26:

On duty; 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM

August 27:

Off Duty

August 28, 29, and 30:

On duty; 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

August 31:

Off Duty.

Further investigation has disclosed that during August, 1967, Esquivel was assigned to duties in different areas of the Troop B responsibility since he was filling in for other troopers on their day's off. During August, 1967, Esquivel worked in the New Orleans area.

Esquivel stated that he has not engaged in any lengthy travel of recent years and noted that for the past three years, a great majority of his off-duty time has been devoted to the building in his garage at home of a small airplane. Esquivel advised that he is a licensed pilot.

Esquivel recalled that during the summer months of 1967, he was performing duties out of Troop B, but that he does not recall any specific activities on any specific dates. He stated that he would also be unable to recall any specific dates of his activities during the months of October and December, 1967, and April, 1968.

Esquivel pointed out that he regards himself as a professional law enforcement officer, that he takes pride in his occupation and that he has nothing whatsoever to hide. He stated that if he did possess any information concerning Ray or the assassination of King, he would not hesitate to furnish same to the FBI.


