WENDELL SUTTON POWELL, FOREMAN, PHARR YARNS, INTERVIEWED AT HIS HOME, 218 EWING DRIVE, BELMONT, N. C., ADVISED HIS CORRESPONDENCE WITH HIS BROTHER CLAUDE POWELL, JR., IS VERY POOR WITH ONLY AN OCCASIONAL TELEPHONE CALL. HE LAST SAW CLAUDE THREE YEARS AGO WHEN THEIR MOTHER, HEPSIE POWELL, WAS VERY ILL IN TOCCOA, GEORGIA. WENDELL RELATED HE HAD NOT HEARD OF ANYONE CONTACTING HIS BROTHERS CLAUDE AND LEON AND OFFERING THEM MONEY TO ASSASSINATE MARTIN LUTHER KING AND ADVISED IF CLAUDE HAD SEEN \$25,000 IN ONE LUMP SUM, CLAUDE WOULD HAVE TOLD OTHERS ABOUT IT. HE SAID CLAUDE USED TO DRINK A LOT AND TALK GLIBLY WHEN IN A DRUNKEN CONDITION UNTIL A DOCTOR TOLD HIM TO RESTRICT HIS INTAKE OF ALCOHOL FOLLOWING AN ACCIDENT.

CAPACITY TO ASSASSINATE KING. CLAUDE GOT NICKNAME "SHOTGUN" SEVERAL YEARS AGO WHEN A SHOTGUN WAS TAKEN FROM HIM BY A POLICEMAN AFTER CLAUDE WAS STOPPED FOR DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED. WENDELL SAID NEITHER HE NOR MEMBERS OF HIS FAMILY LIKED KING. WENDELL SAID KING STIRRED UP TROUBLE WHEREVER HE WENT AND HE AND MEMBERS OF HIS FAMILY DID NOT BELIEVE IN TROUBLE. WENDELL BELIEVED KING BECAME A MARTYR TO HIS PEOPLE BY BEING ASSASSINATED WHICH MIGHT NOT HAVE OCCURRED HAD HE LIVED. WENDELL STATED IN ADDITION TO BEING INCARCERATED BY THE N. C. PRISON AUTHORITIES, HE HAD SERVED TIME AS A JUVENILE AT BOYS TOWN OF GEORGIA LOCATED BETWEEN ATHENS AND MACON, GA. WENDELL SAID NEITHER HE NOR MEMBERS OF HIS FAMILY KNOW ANYTHING ABOUT JAMES EARL RAY OTHER THAN WHAT THEY HAVE READ IN NEWSPAPERS, TO HIS KNOWLEDGE. NO MEMBERS OF HIS FAMILY ARE KNOWN TO BE PRESENT OR FORMER MEMBERS OF THE KU KLUX KLAN OR OTHER EXTREMIST ORGANIZATIONS.

WENDELL POWELL SAID HE HAS THREE BROTHERS, CLAUDE JR., LEON, AND EDWARD, WHO RESIDED IN ATLANTA, GA., HE BELIEVED, PLACE NOT KNOWN, AND ONE SISTER, FLOYCE BRYSON (WIFE OF JOHN

ALTHOUGH MOTEL PERSONNEL AND RECORDS FAILED TO LOCATE REGISTRATION FOR CLAUDE POWELL, JR., INVESTIGATION MIDLAND, TEXAS, JANUARY 8, 1976, DETERMINED SEVERAL CONSTRUCTION WORKERS FROM GEORGIA RESIDING VARIOUS ROOMS SCOTTISH INN MOTEL. INQUIRY WITH FORMEN AND MEMBERS OF CONSTRUCTION CREW UPON THEIR RETURN TO MOTEL LATE EVENING JANUARY 8, 1976, DETERMINED POWELL RESIDING ROOM 211 SINCE JANUARY 4, 1976 WITH THREE OTHER CONSTRUCTION WORKERS.

QUESTIONED IF HE HAD EVER BEEN OFFER A LARGE SUM OF MONEY TO COMMIT A MURDER HE IMMEDIATELY VOLUNTEERED THAT HE HAD IN FACT BEEN OFFERED \$25,000 SHORTLY BEFORE THE ACTUAL ASSASSINATION OF MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. TO MURDER MARTIN LUTHER KING JR.. HE RELATED THE FOLLOWING:

THREE OR FOUR WEEKS PRIOR TO THE MURDER OF MARTIN LUTHER KING HE AND HIS BROTHER LEON WERE SEATED IN A BOOTH IN PETE'S BAR ON MORELAND AVENUE, IN ATLANTA. HE RECALLED THAT A FRIEND OF HIS BROTHER, RAY GODFREY, A MUSICIAN AND AN ATLANTA CITY EMPLOYEE JOINED THEM IN THEIR BOOTH AND ENGAGED IN CONVERSATION WITH LEON. HE PAID NO PARTICULAR ATTENTION TO WHAT THEY WERE TALKING ABOUT. GODFREY LEFT THE BOOTH AND, IN APPROXIMATELY TEN TO FIFTEEN MINUTES, AN INDIVIDUAL PREVIOUSLY UNKNOWN TO HIM CAME TO THEIR BOOTH AND SEATED HIMSELF OPPOSITE FROM HE AND LEON. HE RECALLED THIS INDIVIDUAL AS BEING A WHITE MALE, APPROXIMATELY 5'8" IN HEIGHT, MEDIUM BUILD, APPROXIMATELY 150 POUNDS, EARLY 30'S, WELL DRESSED, CALM AND COLD IN MANNER AND VERY CLEAN CUT. AS THE PERSON SET DOWN HE PLACED AN EXPENSIVE LOOKING BLACK BRIEFCASE ON THE TABLE. THIS INDIVIDUAL APPEARED TO BE OUT OF PLACE IN SUCH AN ESTABLISHMENT

IN VIEW OF HIS DRESS AND HE IMPRESSED POWELL AS BEING A WELL EDUCATED PERSON WHO APPEAR TO BE A PROFESSIONAL TYPE, SUCH AS A LAWYER. HE MAY HAVE INTRODUCED HIMSELF BUT HE DOES NOT REMEMBER A NAME.

THE UNKNOWN PERSON ASKED HE AND LEON IF THEY WANTED TO PULL A JOB. HE DOES NOT REMEMBER THE EXACT CONVERSATION BUT HE QUESTIONED THE UNKNOWN PERSON CONCERNING THE NATURE OF THE JOB AND HOW MUCH MONEY IT PAID. THE UNKNOWN PERSON TOLD THEM THAT HE WANTED THEM TO DO AWAY WITH SOMEONE AND WHEN QUESTIONED FURTHER SAID IT WAS SOMEONE IMPORTANT. THE UNKNOWN PERSON THEN TOLD THEM HE WANTED THEM TO KILL MARTIN LUTHER KING AND WOULD PAY \$25,000 NOW AND \$25,000 WHEN THE JOB WAS DONE. THE UNKNOWN PERSON THEN OPENED HIS BRIEFCASE WHICH WAS FULL OF WRAPPED CURRENCY, SOME OF WHICH WERE IN \$100 DENOMINATION. HE STATED THAT HE WAS SHOCKED AND INITIALLY ASSUMED THAT IT WAS SOME SORT OF JOKE OR POSSIBLY A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER TRYING TO

TRICK HIM. AFTER THE UNKNOWN PERSON MADE THE OFFER HE IGNORED ANY FURTHER CONVERSATION WHERE UPON THE UNKNOWN PERSON CLOSED HIS BRIEFCASE AND DEPARTED.

HE HAS NEVER HAD ANY FURTHER CONTACT NOR DID HE EVER ASCERTAIN THE IDENTITY OF THE UNKNOWN PERSON OR MEANS OR REASON FOR THE OFFERED PAYMENT TO KILL MARTIN LUTHER KING. HE RELATED THAT HE HAD GAINED A REPUTATION AS BEING A HOODLUM BECAUSE OF HIS PAST PRISON RECORD, PARTICIPATION IN SEVERAL FIGHTS, AND HIS HABIT OF CARRYING A SHOTGUN IN HIS VEHICLE. HE SAID HE FREQUENTLY LOANED HIS SHOTGUN TO THE BARTENDER AT PETE'S WHEN TROUBLE OCCURRED AT THE BAR. HE DENIED EVER RECEIVING SUCH AN OFFER PRIOR TO THIS INCIDENT AND FURTHER DENIED ANY AFFILIATION WITH A WHITE HATE GROUP. HE ADMITTED THAT HE HAD MADE STATEMENTS, WHILE DRUNK, TO THE EFFECT THAT HE HAD NO AVERSION TO KILLING BLACKS ALTHOUGH HE HAD NEVER SERIOUSLY CONSIDERED DOING SO.

HE MENTIONED THAT HE WAS SHOCKED AND DISMAYED TO LEARN APPROXIMATELY THREE TO FOUR WEEKS LATR THAT MARTIN LUTHER KING HAD BEEN MURDERED. HE SAID HE DID NOT GO TO LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS AND TELL THEM OF HIS CONTACT WITH THE UNKNOWN PERSON BECAUSE HE FELT HE MIGHT BECOOE A SUSPECT IN THE MURDER OF MARTIN LUTHER KING.

POWELL STATED HIS CONTACT WITH THE UNKNOWN PERSON WAS APPROXIMATELY FIVE MINUTES IN DURATION AND THAT HE WOULD NOT RECOGNIZE HIM IF HE WAS BOUGHT INTO HIS MOTEL ROOM AT THAT MOMENT. A FACIAL IDENTIFICATION CATALOG WAS PRESENTED TO POWELL AND THOROUGHLY EXPLAINED. POWELL OBSERVED ALL ITEMS IN THE CATALOG AND STATED HE COULD NOT RECALL THE UNKNOWN PERSON'S FACIAL FEATURES AND WOULD BE UNABLE TO PROVIDE AN ARTIST CONCEPTION.

POWELL IS DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: WHITE MALE, 6'2", 170 LBS., DOB [REDACTED] POB STEPHENS COUNTY, GEORGIA; MOTHER, HEPSIE POWELL, ROUTE 3, TOCCA, GEORGIA; FATHER DECEASED; SISTER, FLOIS BRYSON, ADDRESS UNKNOWN, FRANKLIN, NORTH CAROLINA; BROTHERS, LEON POWELL, ATLANTA, GEORGIA; HUBERT POWELL, ROUTE 3, TOCCA, GEORGIA; WENDALL POWELL, BELMONT, NORTH CAROLINA, ADDRESS UNKNOWN; EDWARD POWELL, SHANDON, GEORGIA; WIFE, JACKIE POWELL, 4163 CANBY LANE, DECATER, GEORGIA, NO TELEPHONE. 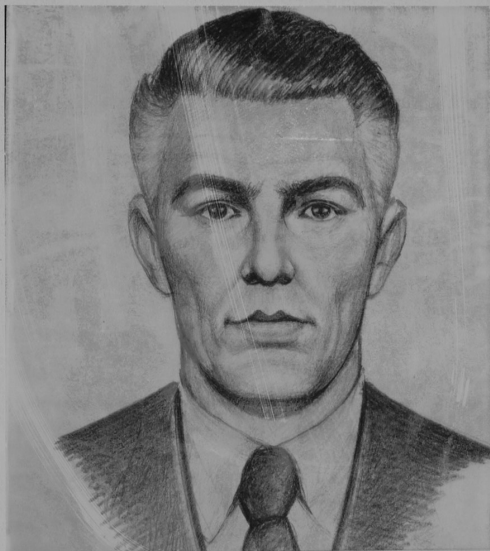

NOTE: This case pertains to the shooting death of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., on 4/4/68.

Pursuant to a Departmental request, we have instituted investigation to resolve an allegation by Leon Owen Powell that he and his brother, Claude Powell, were offered payment in 1967 to murder Dr. King. Leon Owen Powell claimed Ray Godfrey initially approached him re this payment. Claude Powell has also been interviewed and also states offered to kill Dr. King made; however, Claude Powell's account differs in many respects to that of Leon Owen Powell.

On 1/9/76, Departmental Attorney Robert A. Murphy, Chief, Criminal Section, Civil Rights Division, requested the above additional investigation.

He stated no actual polygraph examination should be afforded until this matter further considered by Department; however, he desires to know whether Godfrey and Claude Powell would submit to polygraphs. (Leon Owen Powell has already indicated he will submit to a polygraph.)
