HIMSELF ONLY AS RALPH. HE THEN OPENED THE BRIEFCASE AND DISPLAYED WHAT HE SAID WAS \$25,000 AND SAID, "IF YOU DECIDE TO TAKE THE JOB, THERE IS \$50,000 MORE WHEN IT'S COMPLETED." LEON POWELL ADVISED HIS BROTHER IS NOW LIVING AT THE SCOTTISH INN IN MIDLAND, TEXAS. POWELL DENIED THAT HE OR HIS BROTHER WERE INVOLVED IN THE KILLING OF MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. AFTER SEEING THE ASSASSINATION DOCUMENTARY ON TELEVISION, HE DECIDED TO COME FORWARD AND FURNISH THIS INFORMATION. POWELL STATED THE REASON HE BELIEVES HE AND HIS BROTHER WERE CONTACTED IS BECAUSE HIS BROTHER, CLAUDE SERVED FIVE YEARS FOR ARMED ROBBERY AND AT THAT TIME IN 1967, HIS BROTHER HAD A REPUTATION FOR BEING AN EXPERT WITH A SHOTGUN. POWELL STATED HIS BROTHER, AT THAT TIME, CONSTANTLY CARRIED A SAWED7OFF SHOTGUN. LEON POWELLY ALLEGED THAT PETE DAVIS, WNER OF THE BAR, NOTICED RALPH (LNU) COME INTO THE BAR AND WOULD BE

SHIRLEY LANE, BARTENDER, DRIFTWOOD LOUNGE, 1575 MORELAND AVENUE, ATLANTA, GEORGIA, ADVISED APPROXIMATELY SEVEN OR EIGHT YEARS AGO, AN INDIVIDUAL NAMED PETE DAVIS DID, IN FACT, OWN AND OPERATE A BAR IN THE NEXT BLOCK OF MORELAND AVENUE. SHE HAD HEARD THAT PETE DAVIS HAS SINCE PASSED AWAY. MS LANE ADVISED PETE'S WIFE, DOROTHY DAVIS, COULD PROBABLY BE CONTACTED AT TELEPHONE NUMBER 957-2626. DOROTHY DAVIS ADVISED HER MOTHER DID OWN AND OPERATE BAR ON MORELAND AVENUE, AND, UT ONE TIME, WAS KNOWN AS PETE'S PLACE. HUSBAND DIED MAY, 1975. SHE IS UNFAMILIAR WITH THE NAMES RALPH (LNU), LEON AND CLAUDE POWELL. SHE REMEMBERS HER HUSBAND TALKING ABOUT RAY GODFREY, HOWEVER, HAS NO IDEA HOW HE COULD BE LOCATED.

THEM IN CONTACT WITH AN INDIVIDUAL WHO WOULD PAY THEM TO MURDER MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. POWELL BROTHERS EXPRESSED INTEREST IN THE CONTRACT TO MURDER KING AND THE CONVERSATION WAS TERMINATED WITH GODREY.

APPROXIMATELY ONE WEEK AFTER THE MEETING WITH GODREY, THE POWELL BROTHERS WERE AGAIN DRINKING IN PETE'S BAR, EXACT DATE UNKNOWN, AT APPROXIMATELY FOUR OR FIVE PM, WHEN THEY WERE APPROACHED BY AN INDIVIDUAL NAMED RALPH (LNU), WHITE MALE, HEAVY-SET, SIX FOOT ONE INCH TO TWO INCH, NO ACCENT, WELL-GROOMED, LATE FORTIES, WELL-SPOKEN, DESCRIBED AS "LAWYER-TYPE", WHO WAS IN POSSESSION OF A BRIEFCASE. RALPH (LNU) APPROACHED THE POWELL BROTHERS, PUT HIS BRIEFCASE ON THE TABLE AND SAID, "I GUESS YOU KNOW WHY I'M HERE". THE POWELL BROTHERS NODDED IN ASSENT, AT WHICH TIME RALPH (LNU) OPENED HIS BRIEFCASE, DISPLAYING WHAT HE SAID WAS TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND THEN SAID, "IF YOU DECIDE TO TAKE THE JOB, THERE'S FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS MORE WHEN IT'S COMPLETED". This pertains to the shooting death of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., on 4/4/68. James Earl Ray has pled guilty to this murder and presently in local confinement.

The attached from Atlanta Office advises of information furnished by one Leon Owen Powell who, in essence, claims he and his brother Claude Powell, Jr., while in an Atlanta bar in early October - November, 1967, were approached by a mutual friend Ray Godfrey, who asked the Powells' if they were interested in making \$50,000. Godfrey told them he would put them in contact with an individual who would pay them to murder King. Approximately one week later at same bar the Powells were approached by an individual named Ralph (Last name unknown) who said "I guess you know why I'm here" and subsequently opened his briefcase displaying what he said was \$25,000. Powell said they told Ralph they needed time to think it over. Ralph replied "if your mind is not made up now, I can't do business with you". Powell said Ralph never said the money being offered was to kill King. Powell states neither he nor his brother involved in murder of King.

No identifiable information in Bureau files on Leon Owen Powell, Claude Powell, Jr., or Ray Godfrey.

DEMONSTRATION BY RESEARCH ACTION GROUP ON ASSASSINATION

This letter is to alert you to an inquiry which may be made of you concerning the assassination of Martin Luther King, Jr.

At 11:30 A.M., January 15, 1976, a group of 15 demonstrators representing the Research Action Group on Assassination appeared at the New York Office of the FBI. Robert Ranftle, spokesman for this group, was met by one of the Special Agents in charge of our New York Office. Ranftle stated the purpose of the demonstration was to bring to the public's attention the possibility that a conspiracy existed in the killing of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and that this should be pursued. The demonstration lasted one hour and was peaceful.

Ranftle was advised by our representative that the Attorney General of the United States is currently reviewing the FBI investigation of Dr. King's death. He was also advised that the New York Office did not have the complete investigative file concerning this matter.

Ranftle indicated he would communicate with the Attorney General concerning this matter.

Files of FBI Headquarters and our New York Office contain no pertinent information concerning the Research Action Group on Assassination and Ranftle.
