On November 19, 1979, Paul Bernard Marler, 716 East 10th Street, Anniston, Alabama, telephonically contacted the Washington, D.C. office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation at which time he related the following:

In September or October 1970, he and his brother were arrested at the VFW Hall in Anniston, Alabama, following a fight resulting from drinks. His brother, when put in jail, was beaten by the officers. This is not a racial matter as the police officers and his brother were white.

On June 15, 1979, Paul Bernard Marler appeared at the Anniston, Alabama, Resident Agency, obviously under the influence of either alcohol or narcotics. Throughout the interview, Marler would doze off or begin crying unexplainably. Marler complained that in 1970 he and his brother, "Duke", had gone to the VFW Club in Anniston to pay their dues. While there, they began to drink and trouble broke out between them and some of the patrons or bartenders at the club. Marler stated that seeing his brother in a fight with several other individuals, he then broke a bottle and came to his brother's assistance. Marler stated

that unquestionably, he had "assaulted them", but stated that he felt this was the only reasonable action to protect his brother. Following the fight, Marler and his brother went to the parking lot of the VFW where they encountered Anniston Police Officers Rick Townsley, Terry Walters, Ralph Turner and Jerry Carroll. Marler stated that he was then handcuffed without cause and taken to the Anniston Police Department. During the drive to the Police Department, Marler stated that he had addressed Officer Carroll as "son" and Carroll had advised him that he was not his son and did not appreciate being called son by Marler. Marler further advised he then told Carroll that his family would not forget Carroll's family and that also, he, Marler, would not forget Carroll's family. Throughout the interview, Marler rambled incoherently, stating that he had spent \$37,000 to find out what he is now telling the FBI and that he wanted a warrant sworn out for the officers immediately and that he was also suing the Police Department for one million dollars. It was pointed out to Marler that this would be impossible, but if he had a complaint, it could be brought to the attention of the FBI.

After a great deal of difficulty keeping Marler on matters relevant to his complaint, Marler continued that he was then put in a cell and after being locked up in a "drunk tank" he was then visited by unknown officers who kicked him, splitting his forehead open and then "hammered" his teeth out.

Marler continued to cry and doze off as he related the above facts and when asked why he had not come to the FBI earlier, he explained that he did not wish to make a complaint at that time because it would disgrace his family.

Marler, in conversation, admitted being an alcoholic and under the influence of drugs for which he has a doctor's prescription. In addition, he currently is an outpatient in the Veteran's Administration Hospital for mental incompetency.

It was pointed out to Marler that because of his condition, at this time, it would be impossible for any statement to be taken by the FBI, but if he desired, he could return when he was obviously not under the influence of alcohol and narcotics and a statement would be taken. Marler gave no indication as to whether he planned to return.

No investigative action is being taken by the FBI.

**PURPOSE:** To place on record ticklers of the Laboratory Division pertaining to the Murkin investigation and have them made a permanent part of Bufile 44-38861.

**RECOMMENDATION:** That the Laboratory Division Murkin ticklers be made an enclosure to this memorandum and maintained as a bulky exhibit to Bufile 44-38861, inasmuch as they have been reviewed under the FOIA and portions made public through litigation with captioned requester.

**DETAILS:** Ticklers maintained by the Laboratory Division pertaining to the Murkin investigation were reviewed pursuant to the provisions of the FOIA, and portions were released to requester, Harold Weisberg, by letter dated February 21, 1980. The review was made at the behest of Quinlan J. Shea, Jr., former Director of the Office of Privacy and Information Appeals, Department of Justice, who was at that time conducting a Second Administrative Appeal Review of the FBI's FOIA processing of Murkin and related documents. This second review was ordered by District Judge June L. Green in Harold Weisberg v. U. S. Department of Justice U.S.D.C., D.C; C.A. No. 75-1996. Three of the denied documents became the subjects of further litigation when Judge Green ordered them

PURPOSE: To facilitate the placement on record of miscellaneous materials pertinent to the FBI's investigation of the Assassination of DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. (MURKIN).

DETAILS: In compliance with numerous requests from the House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA), the former Congressional Inquiry Unit (organized to respond to requests from the HSCA for FBI records concerning PRESIDENT KENNEDY and DR. KING) obtained from the former Civil Rights Section, GID, ticklers and miscellaneous materials pertaining to DR. KING that had been accumulated but not sent to file. These materials consist of original photographs and negatives, as well as extra copies of pertinent FBI documents.

Upon completion of its assigned task, the Congressional Inquiry Unit disbanded and made its compilation of records available to the Freedom of Information-Privacy Acts Section, due to extensive FOIA litigation in both the KENNEDY and KING assassination matters. Because the litigation concerning DR. KING is drawing to a close, and the FOIA Section no longer requires the use of the materials, Civil Rights Program, CID, was requested to advise the FOIA Section whether or not it desired to have these materials returned to that unit for maintenance.

Additionally, GLANKLER advised that social security information concerning FRANK HOLT has not, to this point, proved beneficial in determining his whereabouts.

GLANKLER also advised that the more than 20 witnesses present at Jim's Bar and Grill on the date of the shooting had been accounted for, either by way of interview or by virtue of the fact that they are deceased; of those interviewed, none have identified FRANK HOLT as the shooter.

GLANKLER explained that the Shelby County Attorney General's Office is attempting to wind down their investigation by doing a background investigation on LLOYD JOWERS, to determine his bonafides. GLANKLER closed by stating that the date for the

ACTING WARDEN HERMAN DAVIS SAID RAY'S CELLMATE, DONALD EUGENE WOLVERTON, WAS FOUND HIDING BEHIND AN AIR CONDITIONING UNIT ON THE PRISON'S GROUNDS.

THE ATTEMPT WAS THE 51-YEAR-OLD RAY'S FOURTH EFFORT AT ESCAPING FROM THE 85-YEAR-OLD STONE FORTRESS.

NASHVILLE, TENN. (AP) -- CONVICTED ASSASSIN JAMES EARL RAY SAYS HE HAS "SUBSTANTIAL EVIDENCE" OF HIS INNOCENCE AND CAN TELL THE STATE PAROLE BOARD WHO FINANCED THE SLAYING OF CIVIL RIGHTS LEADER MARTIN LUTHER KING JR.

RAY TOLD THE NASHVILLE BANNER IN AN INTERVIEW PUBLISHED MONDAY THAT HE MAY ASK THE BOARD FOR A CLEMENCY HEARING WITHIN A FEW MONTHS, DEPENDING ON HOW THE STATE SUPREME COURT RULES ON A PENDING APPEAL FROM HIS 99-YEAR SENTENCE.

"THE MAIN THING I WOULD TELL THE BOARD IS I'M ALMOST CERTAIN WHO FINANCED THE KING HOMICIDE," RAY SAID. "I CAN'T TELL THEM WHO DID THE SHOOTING, BUT ONCE THEY GET THAT INFORMATION THEY COULD INVESTIGATE IT AND IN TURN HAVE SUBSTANTIAL EVIDENCE TO CLEAR ME."

ARRESTED IN LONDON AFTER A WORLDWIDE MANHUNT, RAY WAS RETURNED TO MEMPHIS WHERE KING WAS ASSASSINATED APRIL 4, 1968. RAY PLEADED GUILTY TO THE SLAYING THE FOLLOWING MARCH BUT HAS BEEN TRYING THROUGH VARIOUS APPEALS IN STATE AND FEDERAL COURTS TO RECALL HIS GUILTY PLEA.

NEVIN TRAMMELL, PAROLE BOARD CHAIRMAN, SAID RAY QUALIFIES FOR A CLEMENCY HEARING BASED ON GUIDELINES ANNOUNCED A YEAR AGO BY GOV. LAMAR ALEXANDER. UNDER THE CRITERIA, AN INMATE MUST SERVE HALF OF THE MINIMUM SENTENCE FOR A CRIME.

THE MINIMUM SENTENCE FOR RAY, WHO PLEADED GUILTY TO FIRST-DEGREE MURDER, IS 20 YEARS AND RAY HAS SERVED 12 YEARS, INCLUDING TIME IN A SPECIAL CELL AT THE SHELBY COUNTY JAIL FOLLOWING HIS ARREST.

"I AM GOING TO SHOW SUBSTANTIAL EVIDENCE OF INNOCENCE AND THEY CAN MAKE A RECOMMENDATION TO THE GOVERNOR," RAY SAID, TALKING ABOUT THE PAROLE BOARD. "I THINK I WILL HAVE THAT IN THE NEXT TWO MONTHS AND I WILL HAVE A LAWYER PRESENT THE EVIDENCE OF MY INNOCENCE."

RAY SAID HIS FIRST STEP WAS TO FILE A LIBEL SUIT IN U.S. DISTRICT COURT IN ST. LOUIS AGAINST THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT IN WASHINGTON. THE SUIT SAYS THE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT HAS LIBELED RAY DURING THE PAST 10 YEARS BY REPORTING HE SUPPORTED HIMSELF PRIOR TO HIS LONDON ARREST BY DEALING IN DRUGS AND ROBBING BANKS.

NONE OF THE ALLEGATIONS WAS PROVEN, RAY SAID, AND "I CAN'T GO TO THE PAROLE BOARD WITH THESE CONSTANT CHARGES."

RAY WAS A FUGITIVE FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PRISON AT THE TIME KING WAS SLAIN.

RAY SPOKE WITH THE BANNER ON FRIDAY IN A TELEPHONE INTERVIEW FROM THE BRUSHY MOUNTAIN STATE PENITENTIARY.

**DETAILS:** On 5/16/95, MARK K. GLANKLER, CID, Shelby County Attorney General's Office, advised that WILLIAM PEPPER, JAMES EARL RAY's London based attorney, has not yet come forth with the revelation concerning "RAOUL", the nebulous figure named by convicted assassin JAMES EARL RAY, who claims he was set up. GLANKLER advised that when the revelation is made public, the Shelby County Attorney General's Office is prepared to fully discredit it.

Henceforth, 60-day updates will be discontinued in the matter, and no further investigation/reporting will be conducted. In the event pertinent information is developed, the Bureau will be advised.

Dear Mr. Coffee:

I am writing you concerning the matter of James Earl Ray v. State of Tennessee. As I understand events that have received media coverage, the firearms evidence in the shooting death of Dr. Martin Luther King has been recently reexamined by a team of experts. The results of this reevaluation of the evidence has raised a number of issues concerning the fatal bullet taken from Dr. King and the suspected murder weapon.

In 1968, the FBI Laboratory examined the weapon and compared it to the fatal bullet removed from Dr. King. Because the fatal bullet lacked sufficient microscopic marks of value for identification purposes, it could not be determined whether or not this bullet was fired from the submitted rifle. Also examined in 1968 were five unfired cartridges found with the rifle. It was concluded that the lead component of the bullet from one of the cartridges found with the rifle was similar in composition with the lead component of the fatal bullet.

Should your office deem it desirable in the interest of the case, the FBI Laboratory could re-examine the firearms evidence in this matter. A compositional examination could be conducted utilizing ICP-AES (Inductively Coupled Plasma-Atomic Emission Spectroscopy) that would be state-of-the-art and provide qualitative and quantitative analyses of the bullet lead. Such examinations are necessarily destructive in nature, requiring that non-contaminated lead be obtained by cutting into the lead core of each bullet from the nose or base areas. By looking at more elements in the lead, the ICP-AES examinations would provide more information than the single-element approach available in the 1968 analysis. The destructive nature of the examination must be weighed against the value of the examination and preserving the evidence in its present condition.

The fatal bullet from Dr. King has been microscopically compared to test bullets fired from the recovered rifle during the original 1968 FBI Laboratory examinations, again by a five-member panel for the House of Representatives Select Committee on

Assassination, and most recently by a three-panel of firearms examiners. All three examinations have resulted in the same conclusion and there is no validated, alternative technique available that would better serve to compare a fired bullet to a weapon.

## Court Filing Blocks Renewed King Probe

MEMPHIS, Aug. 18—A special prosecutor appointed today to look into the 1968 murder of the Rev. Martin Luther King Jr. will hold off starting work until an appeals court rules on an objection raised by state prosecutors.

They filed an emergency appeal of Judge John Colton's action, claiming he had no authority to name University of Memphis law professor Mike Roberts as a special prosecutor. The Tennessee Court of Criminal Appeals ordered the investigation halted until a hearing Aug. 29.

"He's basically going to convene his own little grand jury, I guess," prosecutor John Campbell said of Roberts. "He's going to take evidence and then seal it. . . . I don't really know where he's going on it."

Some investigation has been done in another courtroom regarding claims by confessed killer James Earl Ray that he did not kill King.

Prosecutors have been fighting that probe, claiming any actions in the case must be brought before the division of the state criminal court that is presided over by Colton because Ray made his guilty plea there in 1969.

Colton has demanded the documents from the other investigation, in Judge Joe Brown's court.

Roberts, meanwhile, would have the authority to subpoena witnesses and take sworn statements but must await the appeals court decision.

Although Ray pleaded guilty to the murder, he has claimed almost since his plea that he did not kill King.
