MISSY FOX, 4402 44th Street, Ashland, Kentucky, wrote a letter to the Chief of Police, Lafayette, Indiana, advising as follows:

On 4/20/68 she traveled by New York Central train from Chicago, Illinois to Cincinnati, Ohio. She has a very strong reason to believe that RAY was on the train. The man was suspicious looking and said nothing to his companion. The man believed to be RAY and the other man traveling with him got off the train in Lafayette, Indiana. They were met by a woman driving a light or creamy brown Rambler station wagon, about a 1963 or 1964 model.

Chief of Police has advised that the PD has not been able to identify the car or obtain any other leads as to the identity of the person getting off the train. A display of RAY's photograph at the NYC Station met with negative results.

Louisville interview MISSY FOX, Ashland, Ky., and display photos to her to determine how positive she is of subject's identification. If a positive identification is made, obtain further details she may have that may assist in locating subject and set out appropriate leads to identify and interview the conductor of the train.

The following investigation was conducted by SA LEONARD A. WISSMAN on 4/25/68, at Elkhart, Indiana:

JOHN ANDREWS, newscaster, WTRC Radio Station, advised he had arrived at Joe and Eddie's Tavern, East Jackson Boulevard, shortly after midnight on 4/25/68, and noticed two individuals sitting next to the wall at the northwest end of the bar. He noted that when the conversation shifted to MARTIN LUTHER KING, these two individuals appeared to become nervous and whispered to one another and then left abruptly. Before this had happened, he had thought to himself that the one individual resembled photograph of RAY which he had seen previously and after they left in a gray car, heading east towards Bristol, Indiana, he mentioned to the owner of the tavern, known to him as EDDIE, of the feeling the one individual resembled RAY. It was his impression that EDDIE was acquainted with these individuals and did not seem to be concerned about the matter; however, he thought he should report the matter to the FBI.

EDWARD BOLLERO, part-owner, Joe and Eddie's Tavern, East Jackson Boulevard, advised he recalls the incident wherein JOHN ANDREWS had mentioned to him that an individual sitting at the northwest part of the bar resembled Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING's assassin, JAMES RAY. BOLLERO advised that he told ANDREWS that this could not be because he was well acquainted with both of these individuals. BOLLERO stated one individual who ANDREWS claimed to resemble RAY, is GUY ENOS, night foreman, Taylor's Sales, and he has known this individual for eight years. He advised ENOS' companion was DICK OREM, night supervisor, Taylor's Sales, and he has personally known OREM for approximately eighteen years.

The following investigation was conducted by SAs HERBERT T. BRADSHAW and WILLIAM R. LISTON:

On May 6, 1968, Mrs. RUTH HARNEY, 601 East Adams Street, Muncie, Indiana, advised as follows:

All the information which she has furnished by letter to FBI Headquarters, Washington, D.C., was obtained by her and her daughter, Mrs. BARBARA WALLEN, St. Johns Street, at Daleville Road, Daleville, Indiana, by use of a ouija board, a device which mystically spells out words when questions are asked of it. Also, she stated that at about the time of the Pueblo incident, she began hearing signals over her television set which sounded like Morse Code being transmitted, and she thought the Russians were doing this.

Mrs. HARNEY's letter to the Bureau was orally acknowledged and she was asked not to furnish additional letters to the Bureau based on information she obtains from her ouija board.

In view of the foregoing, no further investigation should be conducted concerning information furnished by Mrs. HARNEY.

On 5/3/68 Mrs. RUSSELL STEPH advised that she received a telephone call from a boy she knows as PAUL DIAZ or DIEZ who used to date her daughter. The call was received in December, 1967, one day after PAUL left Indiana to return to Texas which is his home. PAUL is a Mexican who worked for a company constructing a highline at Milltown, Indiana. She said he is twenty-one years of age, very dark, about 5'10", and well built. They have not heard from him since the telephone call. She observed the photo of RAY and stated there is no resemblance.

2. 12/15/67 from Sanderson, Texas, to number 633-4609, Milltown, Indiana. Milltown telephone directory reveals this number is issued to EDNA GREEN, Milltown, Indiana. On 5/3/68 Mrs. EDNA GREEN advised she received a telephone call in December, 1967 from one PAUL GUADARRAMA, Box 295, Sanderson, Texas. She said

GUADARRAMA roomed with her while employed by the Irby Construction Company, Milltown, Indiana, and left the day before she received the telephone call. He stated he was returning to his home in Texas to go back to school. Mrs. GREEN observed the photo of RAY and stated there is no resemblance between the photo and GUADARRAMA.

On 5/3/68 DAN SMITH, Assistant to the Superintendent, Irby Construction Company, Milltown, Indiana, advised that the only person of Mexican decent he had employed was PAUL GUADARRAMA, DOB [REDACTED] home address box 295, Sanderson, Texas. GUADARRAMA was employed from 1965 until 12/14/67 when left giving no reason. His social security number is [REDACTED] He was about 5'7", 160 lbs., short dark hair, well built. He was a weight lifter and very stocky through the chest. SMITH stated his complete personnel folder could be located at the Irby Construction Company home office at JACKSON, Mississippi. SMITH stated that because of his hard to pronounce last name, GUADARRAMA, sometimes was known as DIAZ. SMITH stated GUADARRAMA does not bear any resemblance to the photo of RAY.

A review of the telephkone directory for Mexico, Indiana reflects telephone number 317-872-4551 is listed to MARVIN L. JONES, Mexico, Indiana.

JERRY BARGERHUFF, Vice-President, Mexico Branch, Peru Trust Company advised JONES is Vice President at the main office of the bank at Peru, Indiana.

First Sergeant JOHN RUSIE, Peru Sub Post 3-A, Indiana State Police, Peru advised he resides at Mexico and is familiar with JONES. He considers JONES as an honest person.

MARVIN L. JONES advised phone 872-4551 is his home phone. He stated the only persons who receive calls at that number are his wife and himself. He stated the call from Beaumont, Texas to his home on 12/16/67 is totally unrecalled by himself and after a check advised it is also unknown to his wife.

Sgt KEN HARRISON and Chief of Police LARRY YODER, Peru Police Department both stated they know JONES and can testify as to his character. They state he is a truthful, honest person.

Investigation determined that Tell City, Indiana telephone number Area Code 812-547-3141, belongs to J. ROBERT CLARK, 1339 14th Street, Tell City, Indiana.

On 5/3/68, JAMES ROBERT CLARK, owner of Clark's Service Station, North Main Street, Tell City, Indiana, advised that his home address is 1739 14th Street, Tell City, and his home telephone number is 547-3141. CLARK advised that he did not know who might have called him from West Texas, on 12/17/67, but advised that it may have been his son, DON KEITH CLARK. He stated his son, DON, went to San Diego, California, around this time to spend Christmas with some relatives there.

DON KEITH CLARK, 1306 9th Street, Tell City, Indiana, advised that he left Tell City en route to San Diego, California, on 12/15/67. He stated he arrived in San Diego on 12/18/67. He recalls making one collect telephone call from Weatherford, Texas, and advised that he took interstate highway 20 and 10, west out of Fort Worth, to El Paso. He recalls making another telephone call from somewhere around Pecos or Midland, Texas, but he cannot remember where. He stated that he called every evening from 12/15/67 to 12/18/67, and that all these calls were made to his father's home, telephone number 547-3141, in Tell City.

CLARK viewed a picture of the subject JAMES EARL RAY, and advised that other than having seen the photograph in the newspapers, he did not recognize the individual.

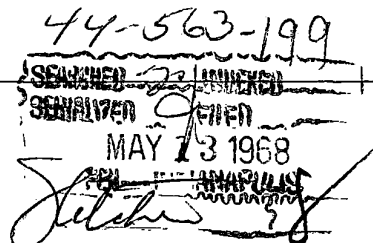

This speculation is based on the fact that in the James Bond books by Ian Fleming there is a character named Ernst Stavro Blofield and in "Atlas Shrugged" there is a character named John Galt, as well as one named Eric Starnes. Ernst Stavro Blofield is a formidable person, John Galt is a "social drop out" and Eric Starnes is described in the book as a "whiner" from a low-class family.

In view of the above and in order that Agents handling this investigation can be alert to the possibility of Ray's utilizing an alias based on characters in Fleming's books, there is set out as an attachment to this airtel a list of various characters in those books for your assistance.
