William Bradford Huie has written a third article for "Look" magazine. The article appears in the issue dated April 15, 1969, but this issue was circulated on April 1, 1969. A review of the article reveals that James Earl Ray allegedly registered at the Travelodge Motel, Five Points, Birmingham, Alabama, on March 29, 1903; at a motel near Florence, Alabama, on April 1, 1968; and at a motel near Corinth, Mississippi, on April 2, 1968. It is to be noted that Ray, using the name Earvey Lowmyer, negotiated the purchase of a rifle at the Aeromarine Supply Company, Dirmingham, Alabama, on March 29 and 30, 1968. On April 3, 1968, he was registered at the Rebel Motel in Memphis, Tennessee.

In an effort to establish whether or not Ray was in contact with any individuals immediately prior to the assassination, appropriate investigation should be conducted by the Birmingham and Jackson Offices. It should be understood that there is to be no indication made whatsoever that the following investigation has any connection whatsoever with the case involving James Earl Ray.

Birmingham and Jackson Cifices should make inquiries of the motels in or near the cities indicated above to determine the identifies of individuals registered during the period March 29 to April 3, 1968. Efforts should be made to identify all individuals listed, as well as

obtaining descriptions and registrations for the automobiles of such persons. A review of such records might indicate whether any one individual might have accompanied Ray or been in contact with him during this period. Pertinent or questionable registration records should be obtained if possible for examination by the FBI Laboratory.

Memphis should insure that the Bureau is kept currently advised of pertinent developments in this case, particularly all aspects of court action since the death of Judge Battle on March 31, 1969.

On 7/1/69, DOUGLAS RALPH MC EWEN, Aka, Tom Mc Ewen who is presently at Wayne County Jail, Richmond, Indiana, requested to see SA Donald H. Kidd. MC EWEN advised further that while at Oxford, Mississippi, he had met another inmate known as MUGH POLK of Vance, Mississippi, who was now serving time at Atlanta, Georgia, for either a post office or bank burglary. On one occassion POLK informed MC EWEN that the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING was not what it appeared to be. POLK advised MC EWEN that on one occassion he (POLK) had been approached to kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, but he had refused to do this. Allegedly, KING was suppose to have been murdered in the State of Mississippi.

MC EWEN also advised that JAMES EARL RAY did not actually kill MARTIN LUTHER KING, but someone from the State of Mississippi

did.

Ray Called U.S. 'Victim'

HAMMOND The attorney for James Earl Ray says he will request a hearing this week which could lead to a new trial for the convicted killer of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

The trial would produce evidence that the federal government was behind King's slaying at a Memphis motel two years ago, lawyer J. B. Stoner of Savannah, Ga. claims.

Stoner and Ray's brother, Jerry William Ray, were in U.S. District Court here Friday for the sentencing of a reputed Ku Klux Klansman on charges of assaulting a federal officer.

Stoner heads, and Ray is a member of, a white-supremacy group based in Savannah.

Stoner says the petition for a postconviction hearing will be filed Monday or Tuesday in the Shelby County Criminal Court at Memphis.

HE AND Ray planned to drive to a maximum security prison at Petros, Tenn., near Knoxville, during the weekend to get James Earl Ray's signature on the petition.

Stoner says the petition will be based on Ray's "inhumane" treatment while Ray was in the Shelby County Jail for nine months after his arrest in London in June 1968.

Rev. King was assassinated April 4, 1968 as he stood on the balcony of the Lorraine Motel.

The killer fired the rifle shot from the bathroom window of a flophouse across the street and fled, touching off the most intensive manhunt in modern American history.

Stoner says James Earl Ray was kept under constant surveillance by two guards, a closed-circuit television camera and sound devices.

Lights were kept on so that Ray would not know whether it was night or day, Stoner claims.

He says Ray was also deprived of legal counsel because his first two lawyers had contracts with author William Bradford Huie to publish exclusive information on Ray.

Stoner says the government has been the "main force working to keep him (Ray) from getting a new trial" since is guilty plea "under coercion" and contiction without a hearing March 10, 1969.

THE GOVERNMENT fears if Ray s granted another trial facts will come out showing the government's part in killing King, Stoner says.

Ray was quickly sentenced to 99 years in prison and sent to the Tennessee state prison at Nashville the next day where he was held until about two weeks ago.

Stoner cites "certain agencies and officials of the federal government" as responsible in the plot.

He says King was heavily guarded by FBI agents while in Memphis because the government planned to kill him.

"There definitely was a conspiracy and they needed someone to cover up for those who were really guilty, so the federal government selected Mr. Ray to be the one," Stoner says.

Stoner says he is also looking into a link between King's death and that of his brother, the Rev. A. D. King last year in a supposed swimming-pool drowning.

or comment. "There are still some circumstances surrounding this investigation that need to be looked into," said St. Lawrence. He said the youth, from

Athens, Ala., had worked for Stoner's party for about a month.

The detective **s**aid youth was a member of the National Socialist White People's Party-one of the names used by the American Nazi Party.

ALL PERSONNEL ON THE TASK FORGE ARE AUTHORIZED TOTAL ACCESS TO OUR FILES PERTAINING TO KING'S ASSASSINATION, OUR INTELLIGENCE INVESTIGATION OF KING AND ANY FILES RELATING TO BASIS FOR THESE.

INVESTIGATIONS. THIS WILL INCLUDE COVER PAGES OF COMMUNICATIONS CONTAINING IDENTITIES OF SOME FBI SOURCES AND INFORMANTS WHO WERE NOT AFFORDED SYMBOL NUMBERS AT THAT TIME AND INDIVIDUALS WHO EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED CONFIDENTIALITY.

TO DATE THE TASK FORCE HAS REVIEWED FBIHO AND WFO FILES CONCERNING THE ASSASSINATION OF KING CAPTIONED THURKIN, BUREAU FILE 44-33861. TASK FORCE MEMBERS HAVE TRAVELED TO MEMPHIS, MILWAUKEE, KANSAS CITY, OMAHA, SAN FRANCISCO AND LOS ANGELES AND REVIEWED MURKIN AND INTELLIGENCE INVESTIGATION FILES OF THOSE OFFICES. FUTURE TRAVEL BY THE TASK FORCE IS PLANNED FOR ATLANTA, BIRMINGHAM, CHARLOTTE, CHICAGO, NEW ORLEAMS, NEW YORK, SPRINGFIELD AND ST. LOUIS.

AFTER ABOVE TRAVEL IS COMPLETED AND KING RELATED SECURITY FILES AT FBIHG ARE REVIEWED, THE TASK FORCE WILL HAVE SEEN THE MAJORITY OF SERIALS IN OUR FILES RELATING TO THE KING INVESTIGATIONS. HOWEVER, SINCE IT IS THE GOAL OF THE TASK FORCE TO REVIEW KING RELATED FILES IN EVERY FIELD OFFICE, IT WILL BE
