CANNON could not and would not give specific details with respect to his relationship with JACKSON, was disorganized in his thought pattern in all references made to JACKSON, and failed to reveal his address or specific location. CANNON also failed to disclose his own personal address and would identify himself only with the use of a duplicate general type Civil Defense Identification Card bearing Number NO 3128 and a Civil Air Patrol Identification Card and Social Security Number [redacted].

On 4/22/68, the writer contacted Mr. ROBERT C. CANNON and Mrs. BERNICE M. CANNON, parents of ROBERT CLYDE CANNON, residing 2114 Camden Ave., Jacksonville, Fla., telephone 359-1297. Both Mr. and Mrs. CANNON advised that they had recently returned from the Jacksonville PD where ROBERT had been incarcerated and charged with possession of a weapon described as a blank starter's pistol. ROBERT CANNON, their son, was and has been retarded for some time and frequently delivers stories of various nature to authorities including Jacksonville PD relative to roles in which he, ROBERT CANNON, tries to make himself an important figure. ROBERT is currently a suspect in an arson of a local school and other small minor offenses in addition to a previous conviction for auto theft. Both parents were certain that their son, ROBERT, had no connection or knowledge with the Fugitive JAMES RAY.
