On 4/22/68, Mr. GLENN HOENIG, 602 Gray Ave., Wildwood, owner and operator of the Family Diner, advised in 1957 or 1958, he employed as a cook and dishwasher for a short period of time a parolee from the Illinois State Prison at Menard, Ill., one HARVEY LOWMYER. According to HOENIG, LOWMYER only worked for him for a short period of time and this was at his night club that he, HOENIG, operated at Chester, Ill.

HOENIG advised he believes LOWMYER was serving a sentence for "armed robbery" when he was paroled.

He recalled that LOWMYER indicated he had a sister in El Cajon, Calif. HOENIG was of the opinion that LOWMYER went to California after leaving his employment.

According to HOENIG, he never had any further contact with LOWMYER after he left his employment in Illinois. He advised, however, the Illinois State Prison System should have a file regarding LOWMYER.

HOENIG described LOWMYER as a white male, 25 to 26 years of age in 1957, small, no distinguishing features. He stated he believes that LOWMYER was single.

For assistance of Agents handling leads in this case, the following background information is furnished:

At about 6 PM, on 4/4/68, while standing on the second floor balcony outside Room 306 of the Lorraine Motel, 406 Mulberry St., Memphis, Tenn., Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., was struck in the right side of the face by a single bullet fired from a 30-06 rifle. The bullet severed KING's spinal cord and death was almost instantaneous.

This investigation, predicated upon a specific request from the Attorney General of the United States, disclosed that the fatal shot had been fired from the bathroom of a cheap rooming house located at 422 1/2 South Main St., Memphis, which bathroom was located at the rear of the rooming house, and had a window overlooking the Lorraine Motel.

At about 3 PM, on 4/4/68, an individual using the name JOHN WILLARD had rented Room 5-B in the rooming house at 422 1/2

South Main St., Memphis, Tenn., and paid one week's rent. After hearing the rifle shot at about 6 PM on that same day, other tenants in the rooming house observed a man, presumably identical with WILLARD, fleeing from the rooming house carrying a large package which was subsequently abandoned by him on the sidewalk in front of the Canipe Amusement Co., 424 South Main St. A neighborhood investigation in the vicinity of 424 South Main St. disclosed that the subject had fled from the scene in a white Mustang.

Found abandoned in front of 424 S. Main St. was a 30-06 Remington model 760 rifle which was determined to have been sold to one HARVEY LOWMEYER on 3/30/68, by Aeromarine Supply Co., Birmingham, Ala.

Investigation at Memphis disclosed that an individual had purchased a set of binoculars at the York Arms Co. in Memphis on 4/4/68. These binoculars were among the material abandoned with the rifle and recovered in Memphis. Also recovered was a brown and green herringbone bedspread. The items abandoned in Memphis were all wrapped in this bedspread. The blue bag which was inside the bedspread contained numerous items, among which were the binoculars and a set of underwear consisting of a T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirt and shorts are those on which appears the laundry mark which has been a matter of interest in this case.

A search of motel records in the Memphis area disclosed that an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT had spent the night of 4/3/68 at the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tenn., and was driving a 1966 white Mustang bearing Ala. license 1-38993. Investigation at Birmingham disclosed that this automobile had been purchased by ERIC S. GALT on 8/30/67, from a private person in response to a newspaper ad. He paid a total of \$1995 cash. While in Birmingham he furnished the address of 2608 S. Highland Ave., Birmingham. This is also the address which appeared on a driver's license issued to him by the State of Ala. The driver's license identifying data listed:

DOB Height Weight Eyes Hair

5' 11" 170 lbs. Blue Brown

The automobile in question, the white Mustang bearing the Ala. tags mentioned above, was recovered in Atlanta on 4/11/68, and determined to have been abandoned there prior to 9 AM on 4/5/68.

In connection with the evidence submitted by Atlanta, Birmingham, and Memphis, identifiable latent prints were recovered. It was on the basis of these latents that identification was made of JAMES EARL RAY. In handling future leads, all offices should be particularly interested in securing an identifying number, military, police or FBI, in connection with suspects so that the necessary check can be made through the Identification Division.

On 4/17/68, AUSA R. MACEY TAYLOR, Birmingham, authorized the filing of a complaint charging ERIC STARVO GALT with a conspiracy to violate Section 241, Title 18, U. S. Code, and recommended bond in the amount of \$50,000. On that same date, SAC JOSEPH H. GAMBLE filed a complaint before USC MILDRED F. SPRAGUE, Birmingham, and warrant was issued that same date.

JAMES EARL RAY, age 40, was reported missing from Missouri State Penitentiary at Jefferson City, Missouri, since 4/23/67. He had been received at that institution 3/17/60, to serve a 20 year sentence following conviction in St. Louis for armed robbery and illegally operating a motor vehicle. He has served terms in Los Angeles County Jail in 1949 and State Prisons at Joliet and Pontiac, Ill., in 1952 - 1954 and in the Federal Penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kansas, 1955 - 1958.

RAY, under the name **GALT** took dancing lessons in Birmingham during September and October, 1967, and in Long Beach, Calif., from December, 1967 to February, 1968. He left Los Angeles 12/15/67, and drove his white Mustang to New Orleans. He left New Orleans December 19, 1967, and arrived back in Los Angeles 12/21/67. In the Los Angeles area this year GAULT took a course at a School of Bartending and was graduated on 3/2/68.

RAY's last known whereabouts were in Atlanta, Ga. area, 4/5/68.

The Bureau has instructed all leads must be covered within 24 hours and all leads must be set forth by telephone or teletype.

The main file on King contains the following threats:

Jackson office, by teletype, 9/17/66, entitled "UNSUB; ALLEGED PLAN TO KILL REVEREND MARTIN LUTHER KING, GRENADA, MISSISSIPPI, RACIAL MATTERS," reported that the Reverend Emmett Barfield, Pastor, First Presbyterian Church, Grenada, Mississippi, who requested his identity be concealed, claimed an attorney in his parish told him two white residents of Grenada planned to assassinate King on 9/19/66, at Grenada. These men allegedly wanted to retain the attorney should they be charged.

Sam Holloway Bowers, Jr., aka Sam, Imperial Wizard, wkkkom, reportedly made a statement at a Klan meeting near Harrisville, Mississippi, on 11/15/64, that two men had requested his permission to shoot King. Bowers reportedly told the men not to take any chances and stated that any American citizen would consider it his patriotic duty to shoot King if given the opportunity.

Bureau airtel 5/15/67, captioned "ALLEGED OFFER OF \$100,000 BY WHITE KNIGHTS OF KU KLUX KLAN, JACKSON, MISSISSIPPI, TO ANYONE WHO KILLS MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. - VICTIM, RACIAL MATTER," refers to information received from

the Dallas office that one Donald James Nissen, FSI Number 570320A, then an inmate of the County Jail, Sherman, Texas, reportedly knew of an offer of \$100,000 to kill King which had been made by the KKK.

Bureau files indicate that on 4/28/67, JN 265-R (PROB) advised that L. C. Blalock, owner of Curley's Place, winona, Mississippi, had indicated that one Julio Romeo of Jacksonville, Florida, would pay the source \$100,000 cash to kill King. At the time this information was received, Jacksonville was unable to identify Romeo and Bureau files were negative on Blalock and Romeo. All offices conduct logical investigation to determine if above persons and incidents are implicated in King's death.

Although subject Ray has been identified as the assailant, you should conduct investigation to determine if any of the above might be implicated as a conspirator.

According to HOENIG, LOWMYER only worked for him for a short period of time and this was at his night club that he, HOENIG, operated at Chester, Ill.

HOENIG advised he believes LOWNYER was serving a sentence for "armed robbery" when he was paroled.

He recalled that LOWMYER indicated he had a sister in El Cajon, Calif. HOENIG was of the opinion that LOWMYER went to California after leaving his employment.

According to HOENIG, he never had any further contact with LOWMYER after he left his employment in Illinois. He advised, however, the Illinois State Prison System should have a file regarding LOWMYER.
