In connection with the captioned case there has been speculation that James Earl Ray concocted the alias of Eric Starvo Galt by combining the names of characters from books by Ian Fleming and from a book "Atlas Shrugged" by Ayn Rand. This speculation is based on the fact that in the James Bond books by Ian Fleming there is a character named Ernst Stavro Blofield and in "Atlas Shrugged" there is a character named John Galt, as well as one named Eric Starnes. Ernst Stavro Blofield is a formidable person, John Galt is a "social drop out" and Eric Starnes is described in the book as a "whiner" from a low-class family.

In view of the above and in order that Agents handling this investigation can be alert to the possibility of Ray's utilizing an alias based on characters in Fleming's books, there is set out as an attachment to this airtel a list of various characters in those books for your assistance.



On 5/16/68 TOMMY HIGHNOTE, 232 South Second Street, Jacksonville Beach, Florida, telephonically contacted the Jacksonville Office and indicated that he had some information concerning the shooting of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. On the same date HIGHNOTE was interviewed and he indicated that his full name was THOMAS HIGHNOTE but that he has traditionally used the name of TOMMY. He stated that he has been dating a young lady named HELEN PHELPS who works as a waitress in the Quality Court Motel Restaurant at the junction of Highway 27 and I 75 in Ocala, Fla. He further advised that a week or two after the KING incident he was on a date with PHELPS and after he made some remark about the shooting she noted that her boss, BOB PATTON left for Birmingham, Ala., either the day before KING was assassinated or the same date and that PATTON remarked that he was going to Birmingham to get "that black S.O.B. MARTIN LUTHER KING."

HIGHNOTE stated that this is the only remark that PHELPS made concerning PATTON in regards to the shooting of MARTIN LUTHER KING but that he is aware that PATTON is a businessman from Bessemer, Ala., who is in the real estate business and also is the owner of the Quality Court Motel in Ocala.

HIGHNOTE said that he has been most reluctant to furnish this information to the FBI because he did not want to be considered a "nut or crank" type individual but that after reading the DREW PEARSON column in this morning's paper he thought it was his duty to report this information. He stated that PHELPS if not at work could be contacted at Grandmaw's Playhouse, which is a day nursery run by her father and mother on Old Jacksonville Road (Old 301), Ocala, Florida. He said her telephone number was 629-2315.

The following investigation was conducted by the Jacksonville, Florida, Division:

Numerous suspects and look alike individuals from photographs of the artist's conception of the assassin of Doctor MARTIN LUTHER KING and later photographs of JAMES EARL RAY, were eliminated as being RAY and/or having been in Memphis, Tennessee, April 4, 1968.

During the period, April 9, 1968, through April 12, 1968, all laundries in the Jacksonville Division were contacted in an effort to locate a laundry utilizing the type of laundry mark utilized on the tee shirt and undershorts which may have been used by the assailant of Doctor KING.

As previously reported, a rifle abandoned near the scene of the crime was purchased by an individual using the name HARVEY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER.

On April 9, and 10, 1968, a review was made of the files of the Jacksonville Office, all City Directories, all Drivers License Records, Telephone Directories, Auto Registrations, Voter Registrations, Credit and Criminal Records in the Jacksonville Division, to identify a HARVEY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER. and failed

On April 10, 1968, the files of the Jacksonville Office, State Selective Service Headquarters, State Drivers License and Motor Vehicle Bureau and all City and Telephone Directories, financial institutions, credit and criminal records, and other logical sources, including electric companies in the Jacksonville Division, were contacted negatively regarding the name ERIC STARVO GALT.

On April 11, 1968, the passenger lists of all departing ships from Jacksonville, Florida, from April 4, 1968, through April 11, 1968, were checked through

G. EVERETT PEPPELL, Assistant Port Director, negatively, regarding the names ERIC STARVO GALT, JOHN WILLARD, and HARVEY LOWMEYER. Logical second rate hotels and flop houses, Jacksonville, Florida, were also checked on April 10, and 11, 1968, regarding the above individuals.

As previously reported, investigation at the Economy Rooming House, 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama, shows ERIC STARVO GALT resided Room 14, from August 26, 1967, to October 7, 1967. JOE E. BELL, 2537 Wycliff Drive, Pensacola, Florida, resided in Number 27, from September 18, 1967 through September 25, 1967.

On April 12, 1968, JOE E. BELL, 2537 Wycliff, Pensacola, Florida, advised SA ORVILLE R. SHOOK he had stayed at the Economy Rooming House, Birmingham, Alabama, for one week in September, 1967. He had only two meals at this rooming house and spent all evening at the Veteran's Administration Hospital with a dying cousin. He knew no individual by the name of ERIC STARVO GALT as he did not meet, talk to, or recall any occupants at the Rooming House.

On April 15, 1968, all dance studios in the Jacksonville Division, were contacted with negative results in an effort to ascertain if an individual using the name ERIC STARVO GALT, HARVEY LOWMEYER, or JOHN WILLARD had previously taken dancing lessons at their studios.

On April 17, 1968, the records of the Bureau of Employee's Compensation, U. S. Department of Labor, Jacksonville, covering the States of Georgia, Florida, and South Carolina; Florida Industrial Commission, Compensation Division, Tallahassee, Florida, covering the State of Florida; and Admiralty Claims, Jacksonville Division, were checked for information concerning suspects
