Re teletype from Director to All Continental Offices, 4/14/68, which states as follows:

"ERIC STARVO GALT, the principal suspect, has been reported as having attended dancing schools in Birminghan, New Orleans and California. All Offices should immediately check all dancing schools in your territory for any record of prior attendance at any such schools by GALT and run out any leads developed. GALT reportedly signed up for a one year dancing course in New Orleans in 1964; took dancing lessons for several weeks in Birmingham beginning in September 1967; and took a \$499 dance course from December 1967 to February 1968 at Long Beach, California.

One dance instructor has stated that GALT is "crazy" about dancing but a poor dancer and difficult to teach because he does not remember instructions. He was described as an introvert, who volunteers no information and replies with yes and no answers when asked; did not mingle with other students and made no effort to make friends or converse with anyone.

Another dance instructor stated GALT is a good dancer, displayed slight southern accent, rural characterisites of language and no diction; teeth straight and clean; fingernails clean and neatly trimmed; wore gold ring with dark stone; always neatly dressed with suit and shiny slip on type black alligator shoes with thin soles, black hose and had nervous habit of occasionally pulling at ear lobe. Owner of studio states GALT spoke of Alabama; said he was a merchant-seaman; spoke of being in Mexico but did not speak Spanish and spoke English badly; was socially inept; an introvert and a poor dancer because he would not losen up, smiled rarely and when he did it was a nervous crooked smile; paid cash for lessons taking a wad of bills from pocket.

ERIC STARVO GALT described as 5'11"; 175 lbs.; blue eyes; brown hair; born; place not given.

Textile Marking Machine experts also stated this machine is defective in that it is producing a tape 1 1/16" long instead of 1 1/8" long and is not projecting the tape far enough resulting in cutting off a portion of the first letter. The code used in the Northeast part of the U.S. is as follows:

The first letter O stands for lot number; the first number 2 indicates the day of the week, two being Tuesday; the second letter indicates the first letter of the store name, this is the letter B; the last number is the bundle number, this is 6. Color coding of the tag may designate various things such as a different month or the identity of a store in a chain. Experts also state the use of this system on laundry items is unusual in that the system is normally used on garments being dry cleaned.

The Bureau has instructed that all textile machines using this type tape be located and machines using this code be identified.
