He described CODDARD as a white male, 30 years old, 6'1", 210 lbs., brown hair and brown eyes.

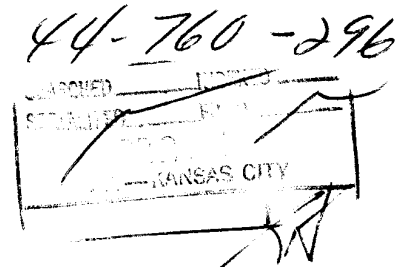
