King's Slaying

The slayer of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. in Memphis last week has not been arrested, despite the massive effort of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and law enforcement agencies throughout the country to run him to ground. Of course the public is not actually aware of the progress being made either in identifying the killer or in determining his probable present whereabouts.

Until a suspect is arrested and evidence accumulated to establish his guilt, there will naturally be broad speculation indulged in by the public in this country and elsewhere.

We shall not be at all surprised, when the murderer is caught or even identified, if it is found he is linked to the world conspiracy of the Communists. None could appraise with more vicious accuracy the reaction to Dr. King's murder than the Reds bent on world con-

quest through the internal destruction of this country.

While the Warren Commission concluded that in the case of Lee Harvey Oswald his assassination of the then President John F. Kennedy was a one-man operation carried out in the absence of any conspiracy, we submit that a lack of evidence on this point does not necessarily justify ruling out the likelihood that Kennedy's assassin was motivated by persons unknown. Certainly the commission accumulated adequate evidence of Oswald's previous association over a long period of years with world Communism.

Thus, while certainly there is the possibility that King's murderer was a fanatical segregationist or Negro-hater, a theory that the slaying was Communist-inspired, or perhaps Communist-executed, fits perfectly into the pattern of the history of Communism during half a century.

He stated that the system referred to above is his own system and is not suggested by Textile Marking Machine Company of Syracuse, New York, for their machines.
