He came to San Leandro in December, 1967, and established his present business known as Diamond Fence Co., 14494 Wickes Blvd., San Leandro.

He is active in experimenting with gold dredging combined with skin diving, and spends some weekends in the Sierra stream areas searching for gold, or conducting experiments along those lines.

He also had interest in speculative investment in businesses in the Oroville area, which are in a depressed state due to departure of the workmen engaged in building the now completed Oroville Dam. He believed such property could be purchased cheaply and held until business picks up, insuring an excellent profit. He has abandoned this idea, at least temporarily.

"Mr. ROBERT SIMS, Assistant Postal Inspector in Charge, Chattanoogi, Tenn. this date advised SA M. JAY HAWIINS that he has been informed by a postal inspector in Birmingham, Alabama that a letter is in possession of the postal inspectors there addressed to ERIC S. GAULT, 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, bearing a return address of Modern Photo Book Store, 166 Fifth Avenue, New York, New York 10010. bears a metered postmark of 4/30/68. Mr. SIMS telephonically contacted Mr. ROBERT HICKEY, Postal Inspector in Charge, New York, and informed him that he was instructing the postal inspector in Birmingham to forward this letter registered airmmail to the attention of Mr. HICKEY and that Mr. HICKEY would hold the letter in the event agents wish to examine it before it was returned to the sender. Mr. SIMS advised that since the letter was first class it could not be opened. Mrs SIMS advised that the above information was being furnished on a highly confidential basis inasmuch as he has no authority to disclose this type of information to the FBI, and that any investigation which may be made as a result of this information must be conducted in such a manner that it cannot be attributed to its source. This information is being furnished for any investigation deemed advisable by New York."

The following investigation was conducted by SA JOHN F. SHANLEY on 5/4/68 at New York:

The address 166 5th Avenue, NYC, is a mail operation for Modern Photo Bookstore, which company is actually located at 915 Broadway, NYC. Mr. SEYMOUR USLAN, President, advised that American Photo Bookstore is a division of American Photographic Book Publishing Company, Inc. (Amphoto), which is also located at the same address. The company specializes in supplying photography books.

NY 44-1609 Mrs. RUTH KOENIG, Manager, Order Department, Amphoto, searched her files and located a coupon clipped from Modern Photography Magazine, which coupon requested that book number 633 be sent to ERIC S. GALT, 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama. The coupon indicates that a money order in the amount of \$8.95 was enclosed. Mrs. KOFNIG stated that this coupon was presumably clipped from the September, 1967 issue of Modern Photography. Book number 633 distributed by Modern Photo Bookstore, is titled, "Focal Encyclopedia of Photography". The book jacket for this book describes it as a one-volume photographic library. It consists of 2,000 entries written by 197 experts from 23 countries and covers every aspect of photography: photographic science, industrial photography, cinematography, portraiture, equipment, history, and current activities of workers in foreign countries. Mrs. KOENIG located a letter, which is set forth in full as follows: "9-26-67 "Dear Sir: "I recently order a Book from your store titled FOCAL ENCYLOPEDIA-No. 633 for \$8.95. "If you have not allready mailed the book (PLEASE DO NOT MAIL IT) I am moving and will shortly send you my correct address Thanks "Eric S. Galt "2608 Highland Ave "Birmingham Alabama" 2025 RELEASE UNDER E.O. 14176

NY 44-1609 Mrs. KOENIG stated that during a routine review of the company's files, it came upon the coupon and accompanying letter of ERIC S. GALT. The company did not believe that it had shipped the requested book to GALT prior to receiving his letter. As a follow-up the company wrote to GALT by letter dated 4/29/68, asking him what action he wished the company to take regarding the \$8.95. The letter is set forth in full as follows: "April 29, 1968 "Mr. Eric S. Galt "2608 Highland Avenue "Birmingham, Alabama "Dear Mr. Galt: "In going through our records we note a request of yours stating your intention to move from the above address, and to please withhold sending the book you ordered (Focal Encyclopedia \$8.95) until further notice. The following investigation was conducted at Williamsburg. Va., by SA H. CURTISS BURRELL:

On 5/3/68 Mrs. WYOLENE POINTER, Superintendent Office, Eastern State Hospital, Williamsburg, Va., furnished their file on PRANK HENRY NILES, patient # 43520. A review of this file revealed the following information:

NILES was committed at Eastern State Hospital on 1/17/68 under a regular commitment by Special Justice DANIEL GRINNAN, City of Richmond, Richmond, Va.

He was diagnosed as being a psychoneurotic reactive depressive reactive.

He was allowed one pass, which was issued for the period of 4/24-26/68, when he listed his destination as being 6150 Wilson Boulevard, Arlington, Va. He has missed no scheduled roll calls at Eastern State Hospital.

Very little background information has been acquired by Eastern State Hospital. On several occasions they have sent personal background questionnaires to Mrs. CECILIA HOPE LEWIS at 5099 Tinelawn Avenue, Chattanooga, Tennessee. They have received no replies 44-696-26/ from Mrs. LEWIS.

Their files revealed that NILES was confined at the St. Joseph Hospital, 205 West 29th St., Lorain, Ohio, from 6/28/67 to 8/11/67.

NILES is described as a white male, born 131 pounds, 5'9" tall, blue eyes, gray hair, with mustache.

The admitting doctor was W. H. BATTE.

His attending physician is Dr. MARTIN PALMAZ.

Interview of Dr. PALMAZ revealed that NILES is an alcoholic currently assigned to the Alcoholic Vocational Rehabilitation Section of the Eastern State Hospital. It is noted that this area is not secured at all times. Dr. PALMAZ advised that NILES is a definite racist but has had no violence exhibited toward any of his fellow Negro inmates. Dr. PALMAZ described his feelings as being merely a general prejudice. He is described as being very polite but in definite need of a great deal of activity to keep his mind occupied. Dr. PALMAZ advised that he has a very deep-seated hostility toward life in general and that things need to go his way at all times. Dr. PALMAZ considers him to have definite suicidal tendencies. Dr. PALMAZ advised he has never heard NILES make any comments regarding any of the racial or Nazi leaders in the United States.

Dr. PALMAZ noted that NILES wrote a letter to the Social Security Administration recently in regard to his Social Security account, number , which he felt was delinquent.

It was noted that since March 30, 1968, NILES has been allowed to work at the Howard Johnson's Restaurant, off the Eastern State Hospital's grounds, in Williamsburg, Va. Since that time and to date, he has worked five and six days a week, 40 hours per week, and is paid \$58.

On 5/3/68 JAMES HAMILTON, Manager, Howard Johnson's Restaurant, Williamsburg, Va., was interviewed and advised that NILES was employed at his restaurant from 3/30/68 to the present time. He noted that he was at all times on duty during the period 4/3-6/68. His days off during the instant period were April 2 and 9, 1968. HAMILTON advised that NILES is very well liked and gets along well with all the Negro help.

It was noted that NILES returned to the Eastern State Hospital after his work days during the instant period and at all times during his period of employment at the Howard Johnson's Restaurant. He has missed no roll calls at Eastern State Hospital.

No further investigation being conducted concerning NILES at Norfolk.

On 4/29/68, ROY E. STEVENS, 1121 Dutch Valley Road, Knoxville, Tennessee, appeared at the Knoxville Office advising that he felt he had information of value on the captioned matter. He stated that ROBERT GROVER DUKE had escaped from Tennessee State Penitentiary, Ft. Pillow, Tennessee, on 4/7/67, and has not been located to date. He pointed out that DUKE had been convicted in Anderson County, Tennessee, with killing three people in 1954, one of whom was JOHN P. STEVENS, Clinton, Tennessee, brother of complainant. He said that, at time of escape, DUKE had apparently gone down the Mississippi River by boat in order to effect his escape.

He pointed out that subject RAY of captioned matter escaped approximately the same time as did DUKE and for this reason he felt there was a connection between DUKE and RAY. He felt further that possibly KING's murderer had escaped from Memphis, Tennessee, also located on the Mississippi River in the same matter DUKE had escaped from Ft. Pillow. STEVENS was questioned as to any specific information he had which would associate DUKE and RAY and advised that he had It was pointed out to him that RAY had been in a Missouri State Penitentiary at the same time DUKE was in a Tennessee State Penitentiary and that, prior to escape, there could not have been any association. Complainant is an elderly man, appears to be senile, and as information furnished has no basis for fact, no further action is contemplated, however, the above is being made a matter of record.



JAMES EARL RAY, also known as Eric Starvo Galt, Harvey Lowmyer, John Willard, James McBride, James Walton, W. C. Herron and James O'Conner.

James Earl Ray, a Missouri prison escapee, sought under the alias Eric Starvo Galt in connection with the gunshot slaying of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., is one of the FBI's "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives." FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover ordered the special addition of Ray to the "Top Ten" list to insure widespread dissemination of Ray's photograph and description to

speed his location.

Ray has been intensively sought since the murder of Dr. King on April 4, 1968, as he stood on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel. An exhaustive FBI fingerprint search, comparing latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against fingerprints of over 53,000 persons on whom wanted notices were posted,

determined that Galt and Ray are identical.

A Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, under the alias of Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a citizen. Ray, who escaped on April 23, 1967, from the Missouri State Penitentiary, is also sought for unlawful flight to avoid confinement for robbery. His long criminal record also includes convictions for burglary and

forging U.S. Postal Money Orders.

A white American, born in Alton, Illinois, on March 10, 1928, Ray is 5'10'' tall, weighs 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and short brown hair. He has a nervous habit of tugging at an ear lobe and his left ear protrudes noticeably. Known as a "loner" and "drifter," Ray has worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher. He has taken dancing lessons and completed a course at a school

of bartending.

Consider Ray armed and extremely dangerous. Report any information concerning him to the nearest FBI office.

The writer immediately proceeded to the motel and presented photographs of the subject to CLARENCE S. PAINE, Manager and Mr. ED DOUGLAS, Assistant Manager, both individuals advised they had not had any tenants who resembled any photographs of the subject.

Shortly thereafter IKE ROGERS appeared with three junior patromen who advised the individual they referred to resided in room 105. Mr. ROGERS advised this room was occupied by Mr. GLENN COWDEN, brother of HERSCHEL COWDEN, owner and operator of Nichols Printing Company, 513 S. Central. Mr. PAINE said GLENN COWDEN is employed by the Nichols Printing Company, has been a guest of the motel for several months and does not resemble the photographs of the subject.

On the morning of 5-8-68, the writer personally observed Mr. GLENN COWDEN at the Inn - Towner Motel. COWDEN did not resemble the photographs of subject RAY.
