In order to cover the possibility that subject may have died since commission of the crime, the U. S. Census Bureau and Department of Health, Education and Welfare were contacted and they advised that no central records of unidentified deceased are maintained by those agencies. ## WANTED BY THE FBI



JAMES EARL RAY, also known as Eric Starvo Galt, Harvey Lowmyer, John Willard, James McBride, James Walton, W. C. Herron and James O'Conner.

James Earl Ray, a Missouri prison escapee, sought under the affias Erie Starvo Galt in connection with the gunshot slaying of civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., is one of the FBI's "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives." FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover ordered the special addition of Ray to the "Top Ten" list to insure widespread dissemination of Ray's photograph and description to speed his location.

Ray has been intensively sought since the murder of Dr. King on April 4, 1968, as he stood on the balcony of a Memphis, Tennessee, motel. An exhaustive FBI fingerprint search, comparing latent fingerprints uncovered in the Dr. King case against fingerprints of over 53,000 persons on whom wanted notices were posted, determined that Galt and Bay are identical.

determined that Galt and Ray are identical.

A Federal warrant, issued at Birmingham, Alabama, on April 17, 1968, charges Ray, under the alias of Galt, with conspiring to interfere with a Constitutional Right of a citizen. Ray, who escaped on April 23, 1967, from the Missouri State Penitentiary, is also sought for unlawful flight to avoid confinement for robbery. His long criminal record also includes convictions for burgiary and forging U.S. Postal Money Orders.

A white American, born in Alton, Illinois, on Ray is 5'10" tall, weighs 163 to 174 pounds, has blue eyes and short brown hair. He has a nervous habit of tugging at an ear lobe and his left ear protrudes noticeably. Known as a "honer" and "drifter," Ray has worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher. He has taken dancing lessons and completed a course at a school of bartending.

During the night of 3/11/68, several pieces of luggage were stolen from their car, and this matter was reported to the Chattanooga PD.

Mr. and Mrs. VANDE VUSSE both are of the opinion that the man who stayed in Room 202 of the Holiday Inn at Chattanooga on the evening of 3/11/68 bears a strong resemblance and may be identical with JAMES EARL RAY, whose picture they observed in recent edition of Life Magazine.

John Eugene Gawron was interviewed by St. Louis Office and advised he taught Ray to be a burglar. He stated that on or about 6/23-24/67, he read in the Chicago "Tribune" of a \$50,000 bank burglary in a southern state and recalled that he and Ray cased the same bank in 1958 or 1959, but did not rob the bank at that time because he injured his leg. A few days after reading this article Gawron claims he was visited by a man whom he refuses to identify and whom he believes he introduced to Ray in 1959. This man told Gawron he and others had robbed the bank, displayed a valise full of money and gave Gawron \$250. About six weeks ago this man again visited Gawron and allegedly indicated to him that Ray and one or more other persons had been involved with him in the bank robbery.

Based upon available information, the Chicago "Tribune" and the Eureau's bank robbery files have been reviewed without finding any reference to a robbery such as Gawron described. Gawron has now been reinterviewed and he denies having any contact with Ray since Ray's escape. Regarding the southern bank robbery Gawron previously alleged Ray was involved in. Gawron now states that this could have occurred in July, 1967, instead of June, and was in a city on the east bank of the Mississippi River. Each office receiving this communication should make a review of their records to determine if such bank robbery or any other robbery coming within the jurisdiction of the Bureau occurred. On May 11, 1968, JACK BOYCE telephonically advised that he and two companions, BOB SHELTON and KEN CAYCE, had been in the Lucky 13 Tavern on 9th Street in Chattanooga this morning at approximately 10:00 a.m. He had observed two men sitting together one wearing gray work clothes, in his late 20's, medium height and stocky build and light colored hair. The other man was in his early 30's, approximately 5'10" tall, 150 pounds, with black color hair and dressed in a dark brown suit, white shirt and tie. said that the man strongly resembled the person who was sought in connection with the shooting of MARTIN LUTHER KING.

BOYCE said that he and his friends were students at the University at Sewanee, Tennessee and were visiting in Chattanooga this weekend and could be reached through his girl friend KATHY LOVINGOOD, telephone number 266-9642.

On the same date, Miss ELLEN LEDFORD, Bar Maid, Lucky 13 Tavern, #6 W. 9th Street, telephone 266-9231, advised SAS CREAL and DONALD L. STOUT that three college students had been in the tavern earlier this morning and at the same time, a Yellow Cab Company driver called "BO" had been in the tavern accompanied by a white male wearing a dark brown suit, white shirt, and tie.

Photographs of JAMES EARL RAY on IO #4182, were displayed to Miss LEDFORD and she stated that she did not believe the person with "BO" was identical with RAY.

PAUL GRAY, Manager, Yellow Cab Company, advised that "BO" was BERT BOWLES who resides in a side apartment in the apartment building on the southeast corner of 9th and Duncan Avenues.

On the same date, BERT BOWLES and his companion were located at the Post Office Grill, 9th and Georgia Ave. by writer and Detective PAT ROWE of the Chattanooga Police Department. The companion identified himself as JAMES MELVIN SWADER, 109 Lafayette Road, Chickamauga, Georgia, 44-696-303



possibility of latents or any other information that could be glessed that would relate to other data in this case. The envelope has been handled by numerous persons, and City Editor WILLIAM TRONAS advised that the ticket has been handled by quite a number of persons on his staff. The pertinent examination would seem to be whether or not JAMES EARL RAY left a latent print on this ticket.
