He stated that DOTYE EVANS, the paramour of the late MARTIN LUTHER KING had been very distressed over the past several days, since the death of KING. DODYE told NEWCOMBE that every hour on the hour for a period of time she had received a telephone call which was that of a male who states each time "YOU KNEW MARTIN LUTHER KING", and then the telephone was hung up.

NEWCOMB stated that the vailed threat extended by the caller of EVANS was visibly upsetting EVANS, and he NEWCOMBE was furnishing the above information for whatever good it may be to the FBI.



There is nothing in the car thus far to show that it has been in California. Trunk is locked and they have not gotten into it as yet. Cannot tell whether it was cleaned out by the unsub or neighbors.

This car was in the possession of ERIC STARVO GALT. This car was purchased in Birmingham on August 30, 1967. It was registered in Alabama and still has Alabama license plates - 1968 - License 1-38993, VIN 6-6T07C190647.

It appears after he spent about six weeks in Birmingham he must have gone west and gone down into Mexico and back up to California, and some time around March 1, 1968, he asked for a renewal of Alabama driver's license. Driver's license and the license on the car both Alabama.

Address 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama, has been given consistently by Galt im Memphis. On April 3 he went from Memphis to Atlanta where he abandoned car following KING shooting. It is suspected he set up GALT identity just for this job. May have given other identity in his travels. We are not sure he is the right man.

The Mustang is a 1966, off white in color, observed driving away from the scene.

Picture of VERNON shown to one of witnesses who saw unsub; it was in a group and he picked him out. Pictures shown to the boarding house in Birmingham and they did not make them. They said they would like to see better pictures of him. There is a certain look-alike appearance.

The blue bag is a Japanese make. Lab said it is a blue zipper bag, Tel-Star type manufactured in Japan. It is a 20" bag and costs \$5.95 to 6.95 in Washington, D. C. Jobber-importer is placed in Kansas City, 2500 Tennessee - United Products. Had a transistor, five numbers scratched out on the case - 00416. Do not know significance of these numbers. May be a prison number.

T shirt size 42, has bottom hem cut off.

Car abandoned last Friday, April 5. Couple of people say it was between 8:30 and 9:00 A.M.

On 4/8/68, MARVIN GILBERT and TONITA GAYE RUBERRY were contacted at their residence, 2009 Evergreen Street, La Verne, California, at the request of Mr. RUBERRY.

These persons furnished the following information:

In the period January 1966 to September 1966, the RUBERRY's resided in a trailer court at 401 Skyland Boulevard in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. They advised that the proprietor of this trailer court was a man by the name of HENLEY GORDON PALMER.

They recalled that during the second night they were at the trailer court that PAIMER provided them with a room in his home rather than have them stay in a trailer because of it being an extremely cold night. The following morning the RUBERRY's had breakfast with PAIMER at his home, which is also located in the area taken up by the trailer court.

During the conversation at the breakfast table the name of MARTIN LUTHER KING was brought into the conversation. The RUBERRY's quoted PALMER as saying "If I did not believe in a hereafter, and I do, I would kill MARTIN LUTHER KING".

When Mrs. RUBERRY asked PALMER if he would actually kill KING he said that he would.

Present at the time was a friend of PAIMER's by the name of MELVIN CRISSWELL. Following the remarks by PAIMER, there was some discussion as to how such a thing could be done. MELVIN CRISSWELL commented that he would do such a thing for a million dollars at which PAIMER remarked that something like this should not be done for money. The RUBERRY's stated that the remarks by CRISSWELL as to how to accomplish such an act were casual in nature and somewhat facetious on his part. They doubted that CRISSWELL was 144-1574-1574

serious in his attitude, and from his conversation believed that CRISSWELL would not be inclined to take PALMER's remarks seriously.

MARVIN RUBERRY related that PALMER always appeared to be an extremely religious type of person, although he was not active in church affairs in the community. It was his impression that he, RUBERRY, would not be surprised if PALMER could have committed such an act as shooting KING if he could have resolved his religious feelings as to the commission of such an act. MARVIN RUBERRY stated that he would hope that PALMER would never have done such a thing because aside from his firm racial prejudices he felt that PALMER basically is a good person.

TONITA RUBERRY stated that she believed PALMER to have been sincere in his remarks regarding KING as to his hatred of KING, although she felt that she would be surprised if PALMER had actually committed such an act as shooting KING.

During the period of their residence at the trailer court, both advised that they had somewhat frequent contact with PALMER. They had no further recollection of any specific statements by PALMER regarding KING, although he made remarks generally regarding the racial situation which were not unusual in that section of the country.

Following the death of MARTIN LUTHER KING, they said that they recalled the remark which had been made by PALMER and felt that the description as read by them in the newspaper account of KING's death appeared somewhat similar to the physical description of PALMER.

Both felt that in view of the tragic thing that had happened to KING, that the information regarding PALMER's remarks should be furnished to the FBI.

Both Mr. and Mrs. RUBERRY stated emphatically that they did not care to be quoted in any way as the source of the above mentioned remark by PALMER to anyone outside of the FBI. Mr. RUBERRY advised that he was born and raised in the midwest but has spend several years in Alabama attending school. Mrs. RUBERRY advised that she was born

and raised in the south. Both stated that their reason for not being quoted as to the above information was that they felt that in view of the tense racial situation in the south there might be some recrimination against them by some unthinking southerner if their names came to light as having furnished information about another southern caucasian such as they had furnished. They advise they have one child 20 months old and they did not care to have anything happen to the child.

The RUBERRY's furnished the following physical description and background regarding PALMER:

At 1:38 PM, 4/12/68, ROBERT LEEDOM, Police Reporter for the "Pasadena Star News," telephonically contacted the writer and furnished the following information with the understanding it was being furnished in the strictest of confidence. LEEDOM indicated his office is located at 525 East Colorado Blvd., Pasadena, California, telephone SYcamore 6-0311, and that he personally resides at 7419 Summitrose Street, Tujunga, California, telephone FLorida 2-2704. LEEDOM indicated he is leaving to visit his son, PATRICK LEEDOM, Apartment 4, 119 Corwin Street, San Francisco, California, telephone 628-8837, and will not be available for further interview for a week or more.

LEEDOM stated that a source of his, whom he would not identify and whom LEEDOM characterized as being reliable based on a year and a half contact with him, had furnished him information concerning above-captioned matter. From conversing with LEEDOM it would appear his source is a Negro. LEEDOM also indicated he was in no position to assess the reliability of the following information:

The source stated that one GEORGE RICHARDSON, aka "GEORGIB BOY," a white male, dark hair, sharp features ("rat face"), who has a brown mole half the size of a dime on his right forearm, is the individual who assassinated MARTIN LUTHER KING in Memphis, Tennessee. LEEDOM could furnish no further identification of RICHARDSON and would not permit his source to be interviewed to obtain further details. According to the source, RICHARDSON is in Memphis, Tennessee, and frequents a pool hall on Chelsea Avenue, possibly near Third or Fourth Street. This pool hall is located in a building described as being in the flophouse area near the Woolf River, is dark fading green. This poolroom has a door in the right side which leads to the second floor. RICHARDSON, according to the source, is known to four

Memphis policemen including one known as "BULL," and the source has stated it is possible the policemen may be involved in the killing with RICHARDSON.

The source has also stated the white car associated with the killing was observed in a used car lot a few blocks from the scene of the killing prior to the murder and that this car has a rust spot on the right rear fender.

LEEDOM stated he has not furnished his newspaper with the above information and is only furnishing the above information in the strictest of confidence and with the understanding that any action initiated based on the above will be done in a discreet manner to avoid jeopardizing his source.
