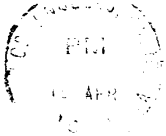

On 4/19/68, ~~Mr. M. P. JONES~~, Postal Inspector, U. S. Post Office, Selma and Wilcox, Hollywood, California, provided the writer with a letter that he received that date from one ~~WARREN "BILLY" WILSON~~, a resident of the Wilcox Hotel, Room 518, 6500 Selma Avenue, Hollywood, California.

The letter indicates that copies were being sent to the FBI, police department and sheriff's office, and states that WILSON believes the picture of GALT that appeared in the local newspapers is "very much" like one ~~BILL SKIPPER~~, a former resident of Mobile and Birmingham, Alabama.

On this same date, the writer interviewed WILSON in his hotel room, which is located across the street from the above-mentioned post office. WILSON is a white male, 46 years old who describes his present employment as "trouble shooter" for the Dobritch International Circus, 1717 North Vine Street, Hollywood, California. He stated that he handles their "legal, press, and credit" problems.

It appeared to the writer that WILSON is a person who has had years of show business experience and although he speaks knowledgeably of show business, it is evident that he may be suffering from some type of mental problem. WILSON states that he has been an undercover agent in the past, has been acquainted with past presidents of the United States, produced numerous television shows, traveled all over the United States, Canada and Mexico doing public relations and promotion work. He added that he calls the FBI office whenever he travels to let them know he is in the area.

WILSON has lived in the Wilcox Hotel since 4/1/68. This is a second-rate hotel. He occupies a small room containing a bed, dresser and chair. He stated that he has a foot locker full of his clippings and that he is presently promoting a restaurant franchise plan that he has originated. The headquarters for this operation is his hotel room.

In October, 1966, he was in Birmingham area, where he was introduced to one BILL SKIPPER. SKIPPER was a motion picture photographer and took pictures of a show that WILSON was producing.

SKIPPER left Alabama in January, 1967 and came to Los Angeles where he had been associated with the Ruth St. Dennis Studio, 3433 West Cahuenga, Los Angeles. WILSON met SKIPPER approximately one month ago in Los Angeles and was told by him not to use the name SKIPPER when referring to him. WILSON said no other name was given to him by which he might call SKIPPER.

After seeing the newspaper photographs of GALT, WILSON decided that he should advise the authorities of these facts. WILSON seemed antagonistic toward SKIPPER.

WILSON said that SKIPPER had a mother who lived in Birmingham on Milner Crescent Street behind a Luthern church. He had an aunt, CALLIE, in the Mary Lewis Nursing Home on Highland Avenue in Birmingham. (WILSON believes this is next to the rooming house in which GALT lived).

WILSON described SKIPPER as follows:

It has now been ascertained that GALT was in prison when WILSON became acquainted with SKIPPER. No further action is recommended at this time.

Offices indices are negative re SKIPPER, and contain a 31-8652-1 reference that appears identical with WILSON. This reference consists of a 2/27/58 letter written by WILSON on "The Citizen", Culter City, California, stationery stating he was involved in a "love triangle". His girl friend had been living with a married man and WILSON wanted him prosecuted. WILSON advised SA MOOREHEAD that he had worked for "The Citizen" as theatrical editor in 1957 - 1958.

Re memo of SA J. CLARE WILLIAMS dated 4/18/68 in which he advises that he received a phone call from Sgt. Ridding, LAPD, who advised that his office had just received an anonymous call from person who advised only that "GALT" can be located at 1220 West 48th Street, LA.

On 4/19/68, a Mr. USHER CRAWFORD, 1230 West 48th Street, and Mr. HOWARD RUSSELL, 1241 West 48th Street, both of Los Angeles, advised after viewing a photo of GALT that no white males resided at 1220 and that they never had seen a person resembling GALT in the neighborhood.

On 4/19/68 MRS MILDRED WATER, 1220 West 48th, Los Angeles, advised that she had lived in this house since 1954. As MRS. WATERS is a Negro, she assumes someone played a practical joke on her. She and the two gentlemen above, all being Negro, expressed a desire for an early apprehension of GALT. She was familiar with the picture of GALT having seen it on TV and in the newspapers. She has seen no one similar to GALT.

Recommended that investigation on this lead be closed.

Facts of complaint
