

Dore telephonically contacted HARVEY on 4/2/68 and he said he was in Tennessee and was visiting his mother, Mrs Thomas, who resides in a trailer park in Blountsville, Tenn., and that he would return to Calif. by Easter, which he has not done.

DORE stated that she is not positive but feels that HARVEY is involved in above matter or in some way connected with it. While residing at the above location HARVEY kept all his clothing and personal items in the back and trunk of his '65 white Chevrolet Impala Coupe. Also kept in the trunk was a rifle with a telescopic sight, a pistol and several rounds of ammunition. HARVEY also had several one hundred dollar bills. 
