At 5:35 p.m. on 4-18-68 DR. W. STEEL LIVINGSTON, D.V.M., 5845 Sepulveda Blvd., Van Nuys, Calif. telephonically contacted SA JAMES MC CAULEY at the Van Nuys RA. He advised that he had just been at the bar at the Carriage Inn, Burbank and Sepulveda Blvds, and upon emerging from the mens room he had seen a man who appeared to him to be identical to ERIC GALT's photo. He had watched the suspect and had seen him go outside and sit in a beige colored Ford, license WJV 819 for a while, and then reenter the bar or coffeeshop. He described the suspect as a MC, 30, 6', 200, wearing dark suit.

Immediate investigation by SA MC CAULEY resulted in location of mentioned auto in the parking lot at the Carriage Inn. In the coffee shop was observed a man generally meeting description as given. 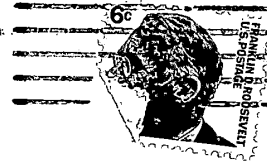
