On 4/24/68, RUTH JOHNSON, Lee Carter Personnel Agency, Room 909, 530 West Sixth Street, Los Angeles, advised that on 4/15/68, an individual using the name ORLANDO SHUMBATA appeared at her agency. SHUMBATA expressed interest in attending a travel agents school runned by the agency and stated he had learned of this through an advertisement in the paper. SHUMBATA stated that he wanted to work at a travel agency, and JOHNSON informed SHUMBATA that the enrollment fee would be \$100. He agreed to attend this school and paid \$100, paying with four \$20 bills and two \$10 American Express Traveler's Checks. SHUMBATA filled out an enrollment card on 4/15/68 and listed the following employers:

January, 1964 - March, 1965

District Manager, Minneapolis Star Journal, Minneapolis, Minnesota, sold newspapers, paid \$100 per week;

March, 1965 - January, 1967

Warner Brothers, Burbank, California Studio Actor at \$300 per week, left because he was seeking a no-option contract;

January, 1967 -February, 1968

Douglas Air Craft, Santa Monica, California Production Department, \$75 per week, left seeking better position.

JOHNSON stated that SHUMBATA when asking about employment with a travel agency wondered if he would have

to be bonded. He also wanted to know if when being bonded, the individual had to be fingerprinted, and he also expressed interest in becoming a purser on a steamship line.

JOHNSON stated that he has appeared at the agency on 4/18, 4/19, 4/22, and 4/23/68, and has asked for the return of his \$100 because he has not been enrolled in any such school. JOHNSON stated she has delayed giving him the money, explaining fictitiously that the owner had to sign the check before his money could be returned. JOHNSON stated she has repeatedly asked SHUMBATA for an address or a phone number where the money could be mailed to him; however, he has declined to give her this information. JOHNSON stated that SHUMBATA on his enrollment card listed his height as 5'7", his weight as 170 pounds, and age as 40 years old. She stated that she agrees with this information. She also added that on every occasion, he has appeared at the agency, he has worn a plaid sportcoat which fits too tightly and long baggy black pants, a yellow dectole shirt and a small brimmed black hat. JOHNSON has also noticed that SHUMBATA's hair is dark brown, cut very short and is greying around the temples.

She advised she checked employment records at Douglas Aircraft, Santa Monica, California, and learned there was no record of SHUMBATA as ever having been employed by that firm.

She checked a Wanted Flyer No. 442A of JAMES EARL RAY and said the photographs do not closely resemble SHUMBATA. She added that with the information appearing in the newspapers regarding RAY, she believed that SHUMBATA might be identical to RAY. She stated that she is suspicious of SHUMBATA because he will not furnish her a phone number or address.

JOHNSON advised she does not want to become involved in any identification of SHUMBATA. It was suggested that she inform SHUMBATA when he next appears at the office to appear the next day between 10:00 and 10:30 m. to pick up his \$100, and thereafter SHUMBATA could be questioned by Bureau Agents before or after SHUMBATA leaves her office.

On 4/25/68, JOHNSON was recontacted and she advised SHUMBATA had not appeared at her office on 4/24/68.

EDGAR EUGENE BRADLEY, 12208 Emelita Ave., North Hollywood, Calif., the man District Attorney GARRISON of New Orleans accuses of complicity in the assassination of President KENNEDY, called the Van Nuys Resident Agency this morning to report that he had heard on the radio that the FBI was seeking a blond in connection with its manhunt for JAMES EARL GRAY. BRADLEY said he wanted to furnish the following information for whatever it might be worth.

In 1963 or 1964, CAROL ADELOTT, 6542 Fulton St., Van Nuys, Calif., a petite blonde, was posing as a friend of his and once mentioned in a conversation with him about that time that she was expecting a friend from the East Coast named RAY and that she was going to have a date with him.

BRADLEY had no further information concerning this RAY and never heard about him again from ADELOTT. He said ADELOTT is a former s trip-teaser, is acquainted with many people who have criminal records, and that JAMES EARL RAY is the type of person she would know. BRADLEY also added that ADELOTT is the person who "framed" him in connection with GARRISON's investigation of the KENNEDY assassination, the details of which he has previously furnished this office.

On 4/18/68 MRS. ALVIN SLAGHT, 425 South B Street, Lompoc, California, advised the ROBERT J. LUPO returned from Montana to Lompoc, California, about three weeks ago and has been staying at the Lompoc Motel waiting his entrance into the Navy. She specifically recalled that LUPO was with them in their living room when the news of KING's murder was first announced on television. She also specifically recalled that he visited at their house on April 3, 4, and 5, 1968. She described him as a friend of her husband and a person with a brilliant mind and the actions of a child. He has put all his guns up for sale on consignment at Pico's Sporting Goods. Lompoc, and now has only a 12 gauge shotgun for hunting. She described him as a white male, 25 years, 5'll", 170 pounds, stocky build, black hair brown eyes. He still resides at the Lompoc Motel. She added that he was previously a patrolman for the Lompoc PD for a short period.

On the same date BILL WILLIAMS, patrol and identification officer, Lompoc PD, advised that LUPO was a rookie patrolman for a short period several years ago but his behavior was too erratic and he was fired. WILLIAMS stated that he has seen LUPO in the Lompoc area several times in the past three weeks.

On 4/24/68 Sally Carr, PCI, advised she had been at the Sultan Rm., St Grancis Hotel, L.A., on 4/22/68. She arrived at approximately 4:30 pm and found Louis Lomax there. He had allegedly been there for 2 - 2½ hours talking with several people (identity unk), but including Charles Stein who was believed in a hotel room at the time. Lomax had also talked with the bartender, Joe (lnu) and had given him his private phone number. Joe, who is close to the informant, related that Lomax had offered him 350,000 if he could obtain certain unt. information.

Lomax left at approx. 5 pm and Frank Rhonick (pho), investigator for the District Attorneys Office, arrived shortly afterward. Rhonick talked with Joe and made reference to a house they had allegedly located the day before. (Informant formerly cooperated with the D.A.!s office and asked that her cooperation with the FBI be strictly concealed).

The informant remained in the background during the entire period, but recalls either Lomax or Joe talking of Maria, Rita, and Jeri. She said she could add nothing more but would attempt to recontact Joe tonight, 4/24/68, in an effort to obtain more specific information.

On 4/25/68 HARRIETT S'HMALZ was interviewed in her residence by SAs J. CHARLES HERRIMAN and SAMUEL W. NORTH, Jr. at 309 South Alexandria Avenue, Apartment 216, Los Angeles, California, telephone number 386-6923).

SCHMALZ advised she is a graduate student at the University of Soutthern California (USC), Los Angeles, having come to Los Angeles from her native of Texas during June, 1967.

SCHMALZ stated she had been in only one bar since coming to Los Angeles, namely, an unrecalled tavern on Santa Monica Boulevard, Hollywood. She said she had definitely not been in the Rabbits Foot Bar, 5623 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles, nor had she ever heard of this bar.

SCHMALZ noted that she had never heard the name ERIC STARVO GALT or any other of the aliases listed on Wanted lyer #442-A. SCHMALZ viewed photos of suspect JAMES HARL RAY on W.F. #442-A and slick finish photo of RAY taken in 1968, stating she had never seen anyone resembling RAY in the Los Angeles Area or anywhere.

SCHWALZ commented that MARTIN LUTHER KING was probably the most important wegro leader in American history, but in so stating, showed no emotion or unusual admiration for KING.

In view of above no further action appears necessary in this matter.
