DEWEY advised he had nothing additional to add concerning this matter, other than that which he had previously stated in the above FD - 71.

On 4/24/68 Mr. GERHARDT MUELLER, Salesman, New Car Department of instant company advised, after viewing a photo of JAMES EARL RAY, aka, that the JAMES WOOD who purchased an auto from him recently was definitely not the individual shown in the FBI wanted flyer as JAMES EARL RAY. MUELLER stated that the individual who purchased the auto from him had a large round bald spot in the middle of his forehead and had no facial resemblance to the MURKIN suspect.

In view of the above no further action is being taken in this matter.

Writer received call on above date from man who refused identify self stating did not want to become involved. Advised that he served time at Leavenworth Penitentiary, Kansas during the same period of time murder suspect EARL RAY was there, which caller believed to be 1955.

Continued that about four months ago or so he accidentally bumped into RAY down in the San Pedro area and at that time, caller gave RAY his address and telephone number. Stated that he has not seen or heard from ~~RAY~~ RAY until earlier today when he received a call from him. RAY advised he was "hot as a cow pistol", needed some "bread" and that he was in San ~~Pedro~~ Pedro where he intended on staying in a mission there.

Caller stated he advised RAY he did not want to get involed with him and that he would not help him and then hung up. Caller refused to provide any further info and hung up.

Short time later, this same individual called writer again and stated that he had been thinking about the call he had just made and thought he had better furnish his name and address or writer might possibly not believe him and think his call just another one from a "nut". Caller identified self as CHARLES CALVIN BOOKMAN, address 980 South Figueroa, the Belmont Apts., Apt. # 201. BOOKMAN suggested that FBI Agents might want to come to his aptment and interview him re his story, that he would be in the apartment all night.

Indices checked and files located possibly ident to BOOKMAN 66- 3380 and 76-232. Files reflected individual with BOOKMAN's name was CI of Richmond Office around 1952 and that this office considered BOOKMAN a reliable informant who had furnished good info in the ~~pp~~ past. 76 case reflected BOOKMAN arrested by FBI, Los Angeles for parole violation.

Supervisor NOLAN advised and requested SA AIKEN and another agent be dispatched to interview BOOKMAN.

NOLAN also stated that Long Beach RA's be advised to stand by to check for possible check of mission's in San Pedro area, pending outcome BOOKMAN's interview.

Writer received subsequent calls from BOOKMAN who stated that he was not lying, was afraid that RAY might show up at his apartment and wanted to talk to an agent as soon as possible. Writer advised him that agent would be arriving shortly.

SA AIKEN and SA GALLOWAY conducted interview of BOOKMAN and info obtained from this contact furnished NOLAN. Per NOLAN's requests, writer contacted Richmond Office re info additional they might have re BOOKMAN. Richmond office advised that BOOKMAN was closed out as an informant 1954 because of fugitive status and arrest by FBI, Los Angeles on this charge. Stated that file reflects BOOKMAN considered good source of info and that all info that he furnished where it was possible to check it out was verified and none was disproven as false. File did not reflect ~~subject~~ BOOKMAN's whereabouts since 1954.

Writer contacted SOG, Ident Division, Supervisor CATTERAL who was requested to check BOOKMAN under his FBI# 892 355 in effort to verify whether he was incarcerated in Leavenworth Penitentiary during period subject RAY was there, 1955 to 58. CATTERAL called back and advised BOOKMAN was placed in the U.S. Penitentiary, Lewisburg, Pa., 11/15/55 for PV, subsequently transferred to Federal Medical Center, Springfield, Mo. and then on 8/28/56 was transferred to Leavenworth.

SA DURKIN' Long Beach RA advised ^{was} ~~was~~ at LAPD, San Pedro Division and had determined that all missions and flophouses San Pedro area were closed up tight and further that because of this fact and lateness of hour, it would be difficult to conduct check of such places without burhing the whole area. Check of area more feasible early morning hours.

NOLAN advised. Stated that sufficient personnel should be dispatched early AM hours 4/20/68 to conduct thorough check of all missions and flophouses in appropriate areas San Pedro, that he would be in ~~office~~ office early to coordinate and Supervisor STILLING should be requested to coordinate action San Pedro.

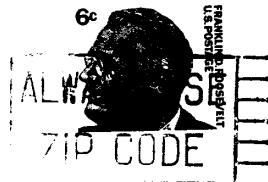

Seems as tho I should keep still about this, but something tells me I should write your office about the Killer of Dr King- I did phone your office yesterday about this, but feel I can express myself better in a letter --

On the Morning of April 10th, 1968 about 9 or 9:30 AM, I was standing in the door of the Texaco Station at the corner of Central Ave., and Beach Blvd waiting for the Mechanics there to Service my Car, In walks this real weird man, he walked as if in a trance looking expressionless, looked almost like a sphinx he looked straight ahead, had on a cap and asked for the Keys to the mens room, as I am a native of L A can quickly pick any accent from another part of the country, he sounded like any native Californian or for that matter maybe the middle west, but definitely none other, than these two regions. He was well dressed as I said he had this cap on, a pull over Grey Shirt and lighter colored trousers, he was about 6 Ft tall he had on boots which may have made him appear taller weighed about 175#, and seemed a well built man, but when I saw this character cold chills ran up my spine and something told me to be very careful of this man, so I acted as if I paid no attention, he stayed in the mens room only a very short while, came out hung the keys exactly as they were, I mean very neat, and correct Then as he turned his back I watched him (He never drove his car into this station) it was pointed North of Beach Blvd., which is also Hiway #39- Now this car was something else-it didn't fit the man, the car was an old maybe 1952 or 1953 Chevvy 2 Dr, which was in a bad way, he had a lot of trouble getting it to go but finally did and that was the last I saw of him, the License was Calif.GWD -656- I gave this info. the next day, all they say is, they cannot trace the #, but they were still trying to do so, right before him on Hiway 39 North was La Habra Heights, I don't see how his car could have made it over those Heights, I think then he must have turned East and headed out to Pomona and the Desert Country via the Diamond Bar Canyon Road, and is now around the Desert Country of Calif, Oh yes the man I saw had brown hair and blue eyes (which seemed almost closed) his hair of course was mostly hidden with that funny cap.

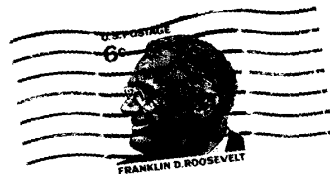

I do not know if this is worth your attention but I cannot get it out of my mind.

Yesterday at about 3pm, on my way home from Riverside to Pomona, I observed a Dark Green Mustang with a Tennessee license plate travelling at a high rate of speed west on the San Bernardino Freeway. Inside were two young men, both with light hair. I did not see their faces, so have no idea if either of them resemble the man who is being sought in the slaying of Martin Luther King.

The license plate of this car was white and the first two letters were either AV or AR, followed by a number. On the bottom of the plate was the name "Shelby" which I assumed to be a county in Tennessee.

This is the first time I have ever seen a Tennessee license plate in California in this time of year, hence my concern.
