Mr. KNOWLTON said that on the day of the funeral of MARTIN LUTHER KING, he had returned home from Palm Springs, California, and had observed a gray Corvette convertible having Texas License/Plates LRZ 756, parked on the street near his residence. He said he observed that this vehicle had a small black flag on the antenna for two or three gays after this. KNOWLTON said that on 4/26/68, he observed that this vehicle now had Oklahoma License ---KK 305 . KNOWLTON said that he had observed a white male Who apparently lived in the Page Apartments across the street enter this vehicle.

After viewing photographs of JAMES EARL RAY on wanted flier Number 442-A, Mr. KNOWLTON said that the individual he had observed in the car did not appear to be identical with JAMES EARL RAY.

Mrs. ALTA PAGE, 425 West Regent, Inglewood, California, manager of the apartments at this address, informed that the wner of the 1966 corvette sting-ray apparently was Mr. and Mrs. RUSSELL CONNER who have resided in Apartment 7 at this address since February, 1968.

Mrs. PAGE stated that the CONNERs have two automobiles, one of which is a 1961 or 1962 blue Chevrolet convertible which had Georgia license plates. Mrs. PAGE said that she really knew very little about the CONNERs but recalled that when they rented the apartment, Mr. CONNER indicated that he had been sent out here by some company to go to school and Mrs. CONNER apparently intended to obtain a secretarial position. She recalled that when the CONNERs moved to this address, they brought two Hondas with them and what furniture they had they had transported in a U-Haul rental trailer. 

Mr. LAWRENCE ALLEN, 14052 McClure Avenue, Paramount, California was interviewed by the writer and SA E. RHEAD RICHARDS on 4/30/68, at which time he advised as follows:

He stated that on 4/14/68 he picked up a hitch hiker in Tucumcari, New Mexico, and brought him to the Los Angeles Area, arriving in Los Angeles on 4/15/68.

He described the hitch hiker as a white male, 5'8"-5'9" in height, weighing 170 lbs. He stated that the hitch hiker had brown wayy hair, which was worn long. He was wearing wash and wear slacks. The hitch-hiker advised him that his automobile experienced mechanical difficulty in Tucumcari, and that he had to hitch hike to Los Angeles where he expected to find a job. ALLEN stated that he let the hitch hiker out of his car in the Lancaster area, and the man purchased a bus ticket to Los Angeles at the Greyhound bus station.

Allen described the hitch hiker as a personable sort of person, who was an easy conversationalist. He told ALLEN that he at one time was in the U.S. Army, stationed in Germany. He had a card board box in his possession that contained his changes of clothing. He also gave ALLEN approximately 30 rounds of 30-30 ammunition.

The ammunition was examined and found to be armor piercing ammunition, with a black USA color code. He also gave ALLEN several M-1 rifle clips.

ALLEN stated that he obtained some 8 mm movie photos of the hitch hiker. He was shown photos of JAMES EARL RAY, and advised that he did not believe that the hitch hiker was identical with him. He was given a photograph of RAY to compare with the hitch hiker's photo, when the film was processed. ALLAN stated that he would call the writer if the photos he made appeared to be similar with RAY.

In view of the above, it not felt that the hitch hiker was in fact RAY. It is recommended that no further investigation be conducted in this phase of the MURKIN matter
