RUTH WILLIAMS, Clerk, Gala Merchandise Corporation, 376 South Los Angeles Street, Los Angeles, California, was shown photographs of JAMES EARL RAY. She stated that the individual in these photographs does not appear to be the same individual that she saw on 4/20/68.

FRED MITTWER, Manager, Gala Merchandise Corporation, 376 South Los Angeles Street, Los Angeles, California, was shown photographs of JAMES EARL RAY. He said that the individual in the photographs does appear similar to the individual that he observed on 4/20/68, with RUTH WILLIAMS. He said that this individual went into the second door of the Midnight Mission located at 396 South Los Angeles Street, Los Angeles. MITTWER said that he has not seen this individual subsequent to 4/20/68.

ALFRED G. MORRIS, Clerk, California State Department of Employment, located at the Midnight Mission, 396 South Los Angeles Street, Los Angeles, was shown photographs of JAMES EARL RAY and asked if these appear similar to any individual with whom he has had recent business contact, particularly on 4/20/68. MORRIS said that this individual does not appear similar to any individuals that he knows or has had recent business dealings with. MORRIS said that he will advise the Los Angeles Office immediately if he sees any individual coming into that State Employment Agency fitting the description of JAMES EARL RAY.

At 5:15 P.M., 5/8/68, Supervisor AL HIGGINS, San Francisco advised the writer telephonically that a Resident Agent at San Jose, California, had advised that Sergeant ROBERT MALONE, Santa Clara County Sheriff's Office, claimed to have been in Los Angeles on official business and on 4/30/68 and 5/6/68 had been at the St. Moritz on Valley Boulevard, Rosemead, California, between 5:00 and 6:00 P.M. on both occasions. At one time he saw the bartender talking to an individual known as JAMES who looked like the new (Los Angeles) photograph of JAMES EARL RAY. He was described as white, male, American, age 35, average height, 175 pounds, dark complexion.

Lead was given to SAA ALBERT A. HUSTEDT telephonically at 5:25 P.M., 5/8/68. He will cover.

He said that no individual identical to RAY has been in the Rabbit's Foot Bar subsequent to RAY's departure in mid March 1968. He said, in particular, that no such person was in the bar on 4/19/68. *4/20*

JAMES E. MORRISON, bartender, Rabbit's Foot Bar, 5623 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles, said that he was familiar with the appearance of JAMES EARL RAY, aka Eric Starvo Galt, and that no such person has been in the Rabbit's Foot Bar subsequent to the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING and in particular on 4/19/68. *4/20*

For information Birmingham referenced Bureau airtel included a letter from BETTY SPARKS, Fontana, California, in which she stated that an old man, who has second sight, told her the man who killed Dr. KING was still in Memphis, Tennessee, within three blocks of the murder cite, that his name is HAYES, and that he had a slight limp in his right leg.

BETTY SPARKS, 13128 Whittram Avenue, Fontana, California, advised SA JACK-E. DE VANE, 5/9/68, that within three or four days after Dr. KING was murdered she had attended a second hand auction at Chino, California. While there, she met an old man, identity, address, and present location unknown, who told her in conversation regarding the KING murder that he had had a vision shortly thereafter and in his vision saw the man within three blocks of the place of the murder. Further the nam had a slight limp in his right leg and was going by the name of HAYES.

Mrs. SPARKS stated she had not reported this until 5/1/68, when she had directed a letter to the Bureau setting forth these facts. She said that she would have no way of identifying the old man, whom she had talked with, whom she described as being approximately 80 years of and quite feeble.





Dear Sir:

Seems as tho I should keep still about this, but something tells me I should write your office about the Killer of Dr King- I did phone your office yesterday about this, but feel I can express myself better in a letter --

On the Morning of April 10th, 1968 about 9 or 9:30 AM, I was standing in the door of the Texaco Station at the corner of Central Ave., and Beach Blvd waiting for the Mechanics there to Service my Car, In walks this real weird man, he walked as if in a trance looking expressionless, looked almost like a sphinx he looked straight ahead, had on a cap and asked for the Keys to the mens room, as I am a native of L A can quickly pick any accent from another part of the country, he sounded like any native Californian or for that matter maybe the middle west, but definitely none other, than these two regions. He was well dressed as I said he had this cap on, a pull over Grey Shirt and lighter colored trousers, he was about 6 Ft tall he had on boots which may have made him appear taller weighed about 175#, and seemed a well built man, but when I saw this character cold chills ran up my spine and something told me to be very careful of this man, so I acted as if I paid no attention, he stayed in the mens room only a very short while, came out hung the keys exactly as they were, I mean very neat, and correct Then as he turned his back I watched him (He never drove his car into this station) it was pointed North off Beach Blvd., which is also Hiway #39- Now this car was something else-it didn't fit the man, the car was an old maybe 1952 or 1953 Chevy 2 Dr, which was in a bad way, he had a lot of trouble getting it to go but finally did and that was the last I saw of him, the License was Calif.GUD -656- I gave this info. the next day, all they say is, they cannot trace the #, but they were still trying to do so, right before him on Hiway 39 North was La Habra Heights, I don't see how his car could have made it over thos Heights, I think then he must have turned East and headed out to Pomona and the Desert Country via the Diamond Bar Canyon Road, and is now around the Desert Country of Calif, Oh yes the man I saw had brown hair and blue eyes (which seemed almost closed) his hair of course was mostly hidden with that funny cap.

Mr. KENNETH R. MC BANE, 641 Galen Drive, La Habra, California, advised SA's FREDERICK L. BIGGERS and FRANCIS J. O'HARA on 5/9/68, that he is an employee of the U.S. Government, being a clerk at the U.S. Post Office, La Habra, California. He stated that on the morning of 4/10/68, at approximately 9:00 or 9:30 a.m., he was having some work done on his automobile in the Texaco Station at the corner of Central Avenue and Beach Boulevard in La Habra, California. While there a young man driving a very old Chevrolet, possibly a 1952 or 1953 model, two-door sedan, parked his automobile near the service station on Highway 39 heading north. He got out of the car and walked to the service station and asked for the keys to the rest room. He was in the rest room approximately one minute, hung the keys of a nail inside the service station, walked back to his car, and left. Mr. MC BANE stated that this car was in very poor condition and that he had difficulty starting it.

MC BANE described this individual as being approximately 34 years of age; 6'2"; 160 pounds; brown hair, cut very short in a crew type cut; very palid complexion; and as wearing a dark pullover sweater with tight pants and boots. Mr. MC BANE stated that this individual was also wearing a cap very low on his forehead, appeared to be fervid, and to be very dangerous.

MC BANE stated that although he is 65 years of age, he has a very sharp mind and a photographic memory and a special talent for recognizing people from photographs.

MC BANE was shown wanted flyer 442-A and upon examining it closely stated that he was not sure that the person he had seen in fact did resemble the photograph of JAMES EARL RAY taken in 1960.

The Bureau has designated Memphis as office of origin in this case.

You were previously advised that leads in this Top Ten Fugitive case must be handled within 24 hours. The Atlanta, Birmingham, Chicago, Houston, Jackson, Kansas City, Los Angeles, New Orleans, St. Louis, and Springfield Offices are to prepare the results of their investigation to date in report form, not as an insert. At such time as the amount of investigation in these field offices does not appear to warrant individual reports, advise the Bureau and office of origin that inserts being prepared in future in lieu of reports, UACB.

All other offices will record the results in appropriate form and transmit 15 copies of each to the office of origin for inclusion in reports submitted by the Memphis Office. Should investigation increase in any such area warranting submission of individual report, do so and advise the Bureau and Memphis.

Mr. GLENN A. PLATZ, 722 South Broadway, Room 4, Santa Maria, California, visited the Santa Maria Resident Agency on 5/7/68, and stated that some time ago he wrote to the Post Office Department and advised that he had some information which might be of interest to the FBI in connection with the KING case.

Mr. PLATZ advised that he was employed for about two months in 1966 as a maintenance man at the Sovereign Hotel and Apartments, Santa Monica, California, but that he was unable to recall the exact dates of his employment. He stated that when he observed the name and photograph of ERIC STARVO GALT in the newspaper shortly after the murder of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, it "rang a bell", and he feels sure that he saw GALT sometime in the past, and it was most likely at the Sovereign Hotel. However, that it was possible that he had seen GALT in Hollywood, or elsewhere in the Los Angeles area, since he remained in the Los Angeles area until the early part of 1967, when he moved to San Clemente, California.

Mr. PLATZ stated that he is aware that GALT has been identified as JAMES EARL RAY, and that he would like to suggest the possibility that RAY has grown a beard and joined the "hippies", and is hiding out with the "hippies". Further that he had no additional information which he thought might be of interest to the FBI.

She had never met this uncle, and was not certain how he spelled his last name until approximately one week ago when she called her sister, DONNA LARSON, in Ogden, Utah. LARSON told her that the correct spelling of the uncle's last name is JACKIE WRAY, and that this man had been incarcerated in one of the midwestern state prisons. LARSON further advised MANN that this uncle died over ten years ago. MANN noted that she has told many of her friends about this uncle, and how at one time she thought his name was spelled JAMES RAY.

No further investigation re MANN and uncle is warranted.

Several photographs of JAMES EARL RAY were displayed to SCHLOTZHAUER at which time he advised he was unable to state that instant photos were identical with individual he saw driving a late model white Wildcat Buick on 5/7/68 along Victory Boulevard in Canoga Park. SCHLOTZHAUER explained that the license number he furnished when telephoning the FBI Office on 5/7/68 as Louisiana license number 96G-616 was not altogether correct. He further noted that he had written down the license number he observed on aforementioned Buick, but that he had misplaced the piece of paper on which he had written the license number. He therefore pointed out he is not sure whether the license number 96G-616 is correct or not, noting that he furnished this number merely by memory.

In view of SCHLOTZHAUER being unable to identify photos of RAY as identical to person driving above mentioned Buick, and fact he was unable to furnish correct license number of instant Buick, it is recommended that no further action be taken in this matter.

Miss COHEN advised that about 2 years ago she wrote to a friendship club at P.O. Box 3802, Downey, Calif. That organization sent her about 10 or 15 names to contact for companionship. She stated she never became friendly with any of those persons. She met only 1 or 2 of the men whose names she received, but that she only saw them once. She became disgusted, and threw away the names. She stated she was contacted again by the club, and was furnished more names which she threw away.

Records of the San Quentin Penitentiary reflect that KENNETH LEE WADE, FBI #56 81 23 B, was received at San Quentin Penitentiary on 9/19/67 to serve a five year to life sentence for armed robbery committed in the Los Angeles, California area.

The following interview of KENNETH LEE WADE was conducted by SAs DALE F. NORTON and MICHAEL T. GEARY:

KENNETH LEE WADE advised that he served a sentence in the Missouri State Penitentiary (MSP) at Jefferson City, Missouri from 1958 through 1965, where he was confined as a result of having been convicted of a robbery charge in St. Louis, Missouri. He advised that he knew RAY from about 1960 until 1965.

WADE advised that he served about one year of his sentence and then escaped, and after being recaptured, was

returned to MSP and served from 1962 to 1965. He advised that RAY came to MSP with a man by the name of ~~RAY PRUITT~~. WADE stated that he and PRUITT were fall partners. He advised that both he and PRUITT were convicted at the same time but that PRUITT fought the conviction and did not enter MSP at the same time that he, WADE, did.

WADE advised that PRUITT and RAY may have met while both were in the City Jail in St. Louis, Missouri. WADE stated PRUITT knows RAY better than he does.

He advised that when PRUITT and RAY arrived at the penitentiary, that he, PRUITT and RAY all lived in "K Hall", and that because RAY and PRUITT were friends, he and his friends accepted the two of them and that PRUITT in effect, was RAY's sponsor. WADE advised that he and RAY worked in the bakery. WADE was a pastry cook and was fairly good.

WADE examined the photographs and drawings of RAY and stated that the drawing of RAY in which his eyes were open is not a good likeness in that it completely changes the appearance of RAY's eyes which are smaller and more slanted. WADE advised that his group in the prison consisted of the following individuals:

- (1) JAMES EARL RAY
- (2) RAY PRUITT
- (3) BOBBY BURNS
- (4) GLEN SHURNICK or SHERNICK (PH)
- (5) WADE

He advised that they, the five of them, had "a little thing going for them" in that they were selling amphetamine pills and other stimulants to inmates at the prison.

He stated that while he was confined to the penitentiary, that they had a semi-riot at the jail as prison authorities sought to integrate the prison and as a result, a few Negroes were stabbed and that the jail was not integrated while he was there.

WADE stated, "I had a beef with a Negro over a debt about amphetamine powder. This beef was in 1962. I 'piped him', that is I hit him with a pipe a few times. He was hospitalized. This beef wasn't over RAY. This clique had a thing going for it."

He advised that he figures that they made about \$1,000 a month or more selling these pills each month. He advised they paid a guard \$100 to bring the jar in and after expenses, cleared about \$1,000 a month.

WADE stated that RAY is a very quiet individual. He stated he did not know what RAY's opinions were of Negroes.

He advised RAY had a friend who sent him some narcotics. He advised he did not know any more than this about that matter.

WADE advised that RAY was close-mouthed and never discussed anything with anyone, particularly he would not discuss any ideas or plans he had about escaping.

He described RAY as having a quick temper and a violent temper, but believed that RAY was in sufficient control of himself not to let his quick and violent temper unmask him. He said it was his opinion that if somebody got into an argument with RAY about something that RAY would control his emotions so as not to attract attention to himself, but he stated RAY was the type that would and could lay for the guy and later give him a good working over.

WADE stated, "I do not believe RAY would go to booze." He advised it was his belief that RAY liked narcotics but not hard stuff, and that he would probably just use the stimulant type. He advised that RAY could handle narcotics "real good."

He stated he did not believe that RAY at this time would engage in the sell of narcotics in view of the fact that he is an escaped convict.

WADE later stated, "RAY doesn't like Negroes. I believe

RAY is capable of killing KING. RAY could plan it." He added it was his speculation "he must have had help." He stated, "I don't believe RAY killed KING. I couldn't see RAY getting into that bag as he was an escapee."

WADE advised that he never met any of RAY's family or friends from the outside while they were in jail and RAY never met any of his family or friends from the outside either. He stated, "I have no idea where RAY may be. I have no knowledge of RAY's outside connections. I believe RAY could have saved about a good sum of money from his share of the profits of the sale of amphetamine." He advised in the event RAY was going to escape he believes the other people in the clique would loan or give RAY as much money as they had available to them. He advised that RAY used to read about foreign countries in his cell. He advised that PRUITT, who was a cell block mate, worked in the library and would bring the books to RAY. He advised that BURNS and SHURNICK each got 75 years so they are still in MSP. He advised he does not know where PRUITT is.

He advised that he is presently confined as a result of some robberies which he committed in the Los Angeles area with HAROLD KLEMP, DONALD BUSSMEYER and SAM MASSY.

He advised that all four of them had been in MSP at one time or another and he believed that KLEMP, BUSSMEYER and MASSY might know RAY. He advised that KLEMP is in Folsom Prison, BUSSMEYER is in Mc Neil Island and SAM MASSY went insane and is confined in some mental hospital in the State of California.

This RCMP report noted that possibly these women were identical to RITA STEIN and MARIE MARTIN.
