SUBJECT: MURKIN

At 1:12 PM, 10/7/68, SAC ROBERT G. JENSEN of Memphis telephonically advised that on Tuesday, 10/8/68, three representatives from Shelby County, State of Tennessee, are due to depart Memphis, Tennessee at 7:30 PM on American Airlines Flight 299 and are scheduled to arrive in Los Angeles on the same date at 10:18 PM Los Angeles time. SAC JENSEN stated these three individuals are intimately acquainted with the above-captioned case and will be responsible for the prosecution of JAMES EARL RAY. He continued they have traveled to various parts of the country interviewing prospective witnesses and have been assisted with Bureau approval in handling their responsibilities. He identified the individuals as follows: Deputy Attorney General ROBERT DWYER, Deputy Attorney General JAMES BEASLEY, and Investigator JOHN CARLISLE.

Mr. JENSEN stated that these individuals will be in Los Angeles for approximately two to three days and hope to interview between 18 and 20 prospective witnesses. JENSEN stated it has been customary practice for these individuals to meet briefly with the SAC if he is available and then be turned over to the Agent most conversant with the case. The offices have made available space for them to interview the witnesses and also have set up the appointments to assist them since in this manner Agent time, effort and travel expense will be kept to a minimum. The Bureau has approved of this procedure.

He stated the above individuals plan to travel to Mexico to interview prospective witnesses there; however, no definite plans have been made since they do not know how long their task will take in Los Angeles. However, JENSEN requested that Los Angeles endeavor to assist them in any reservations for their travel to Mexico. 0

SAC JENSEN requested that Los Angeles endeavor to meet these individuals upon their arrival in Los Angeles on the evening

of 10/8/68 and obtain suitable reservations, preferably in close proximity to the Los Angeles Office so that they can handle their responsibilities. He requested one double room with twin beds and one single room.

JENSEN concluded by stating that a confirmatory teletype including the witnesses to be interviewed would be forthcoming.

FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Dr. RUSSEL HADLEY, 7080 Hollywood Boulevard, was interviewed and furnished the following information:

Dr. HADLEY stated that the information he would furnish concerns a patient and therefore he considers it of a confidential nature. He stated that prior to making this information public or prior to his testifying to it he first would need a release from the patient.

JAMES EARL RAY utilizing the name of ERIC S. GALT appeared at Dr. HADLEY's office on February 19, 1968, at 11:30 a.m. for consultation. He furnished his address as 5533 Hollywood Boulevard, Los Angeles, California, telephone 464-1131 and date of birth as [REDACTED]. He listed his nearest relative as CARL L. GALT, 2608 Highland Avenue, Birmingham, Alabama. GALT stated he had been referred to Dr. HADLEY by the Los Angeles County Medical Association.

Dr. HADLEY stated he performed a nasal tip reconstruction for an elongated nasal tip on GALT in his office on March 5, 1968. A local anesthetic was used. On March 7, 1968, GALT returned to Dr. HADLEY's office to have packs removed from his nose. On March 11, 1968, he again returned and the sutures were removed from his nose by Dr. HADLEY.

GALT was scheduled to return in six weeks for a final postoperative checkup but failed to keep the appointment.

Dr. HADLEY stated he personally saw GALT on each visit. He continued that GALT was quiet and pleasing in manner, unassuming and composed. Dr. HADLEY stated that GALT paid \$200 in cash for the surgery on the date of the operation, March 5, 1968. Dr. HADLEY stated that the surgery he performed on GALT did not alter his appearance to any degree.

This information consisted of the facts that ~~W~~ADLEY had a first appointment with GALT on 2/19/68 for consultation. On 3/5/68 ~~W~~ADLEY performed a nasal tip reconstruction for an elongated nasal tip on GALT in his office. On 3/7/68 packs were removed from GALT's nose and on 3/11/68 sutures were removed. GALT was scheduled to return in six weeks for a postoperative checkup but failed to keep the appointment.

Here is some information I feel you may be interested in and I wish to report it in the hope it will be of value to you, but also hope you will not make my name public.

On the evening of Sunday June 2nd 1968 my niece, ^{her} husband and children from Illinois came to visit me on their vacation.

On Monday the next day, June 3rd, they felt too tired from their trip to do much sight seeing around Atlanta, but suggested they would like to go to the airport in the evening to see the Jets come in and take off; a past time enjoyed by many people.

That evening of June 3rd when we walked into the main upper lobby of the airport building about 7 PM Atlanta time, we heard a loud voice coming over the airport loud speaker calling Cerrano - Cerrano. It was repeated several times asking the party to come to one of the ticket counters. My friend who lives with me looked at me and I at her both thinking what an odd name with both first and last names the same.

We went immediately to the observation platform and enjoyed seeing the children enjoying the sights. As I was seated on one of the benches 3 men pushed by me rather rudely, so I took special notice of them. One, a thin slender, blonde about 5ft 5 inches long thin face with very light complexion. A second man short-about 5 ft, round face dark hair but looked american, and a taller man about 5ft 9- thin, dark brown hair and dark skin who looked foreign to me. Their countenances looked evil to me and they seemed to be in a hurry. I jumped up from the bench to find the children not knowing what 3 men were up to. Then I saw them enter (the 3 men) the inner glassed in portion of the observation platform and pointing towards the Eastern air lines planes. The thought crossed my mind and I wondered whether they were plotting to hi-jack a plane. Then they disappeared.

About ten minutes to 9 PM we left the platform going back thru the main lobby to the parking lot to get our car. Again when we entered the lobby we still heard the name Cerrano Cerrano being called and repeated several times. I kept wondering to myself what was the significance of that name.

The next morning Tuesday June 4th when we heard that Robert Kennedy had been shot by a man whose name was SIRHAN SIRHAN, I still could not shake off the feeling of the night before. Then when a clear picture of Sirhan was shown on the news on TV I saw that of one of the 3 men seen at the airport evening.

Perhaps I should have reported this before but I am not one to get myself involved either and tried to forget it. But this morning when reading the Atlanta Constitution on page 7 an account of Earl Ray (Kings murderer) telling a news man about a Blonde Latin man who had made different kinds of arrangements

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for him. I thought could this be the same blonde man I saw at the airport and a part of some type of conspiracy? It is since reading this mornings paper that I felt urged very strongly to report what I had heard and seen at the airport on the night of June 3rd 1968.

I shall be glad to discuss this with you but believe I have given all the important details. I would appreciate very much also that you not give me any publicity in this matter. I am not easily scared and have no fear of the wrong element. I have reported things before to the FBI here in Atlanta and respect your good judgment.

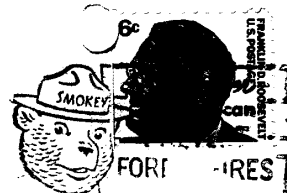

CLARENCE BROWN, retired, 1740 Loma Vista, Riverside, California, telephone 686-4098, advised this date that on Sunday afternoon at 4:00 pm, 12/22/68, he was watching KTLA Channel 2 at 4:00 pm, entitled "NEWS MAKERS", in which an individual named HUIE, who is writing the story of the life of JAMES EARL RAY, was being interviewed. Mr. BROWN advised he recognized HUIE to be identical with an individual he had known in 1926 whose name at that time was HUEY. Mr. BROWN advised he served with this individual on the US BRECK in Norfolk, Virginia. He stated that HUEY at that time was particularly active in the recruitment of individuals into the Ku Klux Klan and had, in fact, attempted to recruit him. He stated he was aware that he was able to recruit several members of the crew of the US BRECK into the Ku Klux Klan.

Mr. BROWN advised that HUEY was being interviewed by MAURY GREEN and PAUL UDELL and he felt that he should bring to the attention of the FBI the fact that the HUEY he had known who was the person he observed on the news program was originally from Waycross, Georgia and was, at least in 1926, completely anti-Semitic, anti-Negro and anti-Catholic.

BROWN advised that the nature of the discussion on the news program had to do with the fact that HUEY was writing the story of RAY and supposedly obtained his information through RAY's attorney. He also indicated that he had a contract with "Look" magazine to publish this story in the February, 1969 issue.

BROWN was asked as to how he felt he could identify a man last seen 40 years ago, and he stated that from the nature of the speech and the facial features, he was positive that the man who was being interviewed was, in fact, the HUEY he had known in 1926.

her 600 pesos (\$48 U.S.) and was to get more money from the bank. She said she went to a person called "CHICO" PEREZ in the main restaurant of the Posada Vallarta, and asked him to write a letter to GALT apologizing and stating that she could not see him again.

Continuing, ELISA ARELLANO said that she recalled that GALT only had two or three drinks during the time she spent with him, and recalled that he had a screwdriver or a vodka and tonic. She said he did not smoke, and she never saw him smoking marijuana. He told her that he had gone to Yelapa several times and he seemed to have a lack of energy, and it appeared to tire him to carry on a conversation. She described him as a complete introvert. She said he did not like noisy crowds or sounds, and stated that he did not like children. One of his favorite expressions was that he was very tired, and she thought that he might be a mental case. She said that he had no scars on his body and appeared to have thin legs with a heavy upper trunk.

On June 6, 1968, ELISA ARELLANO advised the third source, after examining photographs of the Subject wearing sunglasses and the photograph taken in California in early 1968, that she recognized both of these photographs as being the same individual whom she knew in Puerto Vallarta, but that in the California photograph he appeared heavier than when she knew him.

On April 21, 1968, the third source advised that IRMA MORALES, the prostitute who was formerly employed at the Casa Susana in Puerto Vallarta, had been identified as MANUELA AGUIRRE MEDRANO. She was born on [redacted], at Rancho San Isidro, Jalisco, which is in the municipality of Atotonilco, Jalisco, Mexico.

At Atotonilco, Jalisco, Mexico

On April 22, 1968, MANUELA AGUIRRE MEDRANO advised the third source that she was formerly employed at the Casa Susana in Puerto Vallarta, Jalisco, as a

prostitute. She identified a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY as the individual known as ERIC GALT whom she had met one night at the Casa Susana. She said she could not be certain of the date, but thought it might have been about October 24, 1967. She recalled that during this first visit, GALT spent the evening with another prostitute called "La Chilindrina."

The next day, GALT came to the house looking for "La Chilindrina," who was out of town. He then began his friendship with MANUELA and, she stated, slept with her nearly every night for the next several days during his visits to the house.

She recalled that GALT was very methodical and had allowed himself 100 pesos (\$8 U.S.) for drinking money and another 100 pesos each day for a girl. She recalled that he drank beer during the daytime and gin at night. She said he invited her to go to Mismaloya, a nearby beach, and that, after postponing the trip for two or three days, they did go to Mismaloya with RODIMIR BISCARA, the bartender. She described GALT's automobile as a white automobile with Alabama license plates, and as having a red interior with reclining seats. She said this was a two-door automobile, but she could not remember the make. She said that after swimming, drinking beer and having a seafood lunch, they began the return trip to Puerto Vallarta at about 4 p.m. About half-way along the distance from Mismaloya to Puerto Vallarta, GALT stopped the car and took what appeared to be a new Polaroid camera from an ice chest in the back. He said that this was one of the first rolls of film in the camera and that there were only two pictures left. He mentioned that the camera had cost him a little less than \$80. He took a photograph of MANUELA seated at the steering wheel of the car with her skirts up. This photograph was bad and he destroyed it. A little farther on, they stopped at a place called Punta Negra, where GALT took another photograph which was also bad, and he tore it up. She recalled that this was a Saturday and that they arrived back at the Casa Susana about 5 p.m. and GALT departed saying that he would not return that night.

On the next day, a Sunday, MANUELA stated that GALT arrived at the Casa Susana about 9 p.m. She believed that this might have been on October 29, 1967. GALT drank with MANUELA and noted that there were four Negroes and some white people seated at a nearby table. These were sailors from a yacht or private boat which had stopped at Puerto Vallarta.

She said that one Negro was very tall and another was short and fat, about five feet four inches tall. The latter was very drunk, and the whole group was rowdy and having a good time. GALT appeared angry at the Negroes and said insulting things concerning them. He said he hated Negroes. He left his table, said something insulting to the short Negro and returned to his table. All of the individuals at the other table appeared to be talking about GALT.

MANUELA AGUIRRE said that GALT then went to his car and came back to the table. He went again to the table where the Negroes were seated and insulted them and returned to his own table. He asked her to feel his pocket and she felt what appeared to be an automatic-type pistol. She believed it to be something similar to a Walther .380 automatic. GALT said he was going to kill them. The tall Negro came to GALT's table and said something in a peaceful manner, but GALT replied in an insulting manner. The tall Negro then returned to his table and took the shorter Negro in his arms and took him out of the house. GALT wanted to go after them, but MANUELA told him this would not be a good idea since it was about 10 p.m. and the police, were scheduled to visit the house momentarily. GALT said he wanted nothing to do with the police.

MANUELA AGUIRRE said that GALT visited the house again on the following day and told her that he would not see her for several days. He said he wanted to rest and would only sleep and eat. He next returned on what MANUELA recalled as a Thursday of the same week and told her that he planned to move to the "Tropicana" Hotel. He spent more than 200 pesos (\$16 U.S.) for drinks and left about midnight.

Enclosed for Los Angeles Office are 2 copies each of Pages 12, 13, 14, and 15 of the report of SA JOE C. HESTER dated 8/22/68, at Memphis, which pages reflect an interview with MANUELA AGUIRRE MEDRANO, a Mexican prostitute.

It is now believed that the Negroes with whom the subject RAY had the altercation were possibly from the cruise ship "Italia," which makes regular excursion trips from Los Angeles to various West Coast Mexican ports.

LOS ANGELES DIVISION

AT LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA Will attempt to identify and interview the Negro crewmen of the "Italia" in an effort to obtain a detailed story of their disagreement with RAY. You should note that the State Attorney General would like to have these seamen testify as to any racial bias exhibited by RAY in his discussion with them. Their testimony is desired for the purpose of establishing a motive for the murder of KING.

Los Angeles is requested to expedite this as this case goes to trial 3/3/69. Your results should be furnished in appropriate FD-302's.

On the following day, according to MANUELA AGUIRRE, GALT arrived between 8 and 9 p.m. and she, MANUELA, was drunk and said that she did not want to go to bed with him. GALT remained to drink at one of the tables and there was a photographer present, causing MANUELA to request that a photograph be taken of GALT with her. GALT did not want his photograph taken, but she insisted. He told her that he planned to go to Yelapa on Saturday or Sunday, and that he did not like to go out in Puerto Vallarta on Saturday or Sunday because there was so much noise and so many people around.

She said that GALT arrived at the house between 8 and 9 p.m. on the following Monday. He invited MANUELA for one drink and was very serious and impolite. He was angry with her for her actions on the previous Friday. He asked her to marry him and she refused. She said that he had previously asked her to marry him. He said that if she would not marry him he was going to invite out some of the other girls. He spent the rest of that evening with ARCELIA and went to bed with ARCELIA.

MANUELA AGUIRRE said that she saw GALT again about three days later, but did not talk with him. She said she did not believe that he saw ARCELIA or any of the other girls again, and that she herself did not see him again.

She recalled that GALT drank gin or whatever other drink the bartender at the Casa Susana served him. He did not smoke, and sometimes stated that he did not smoke anything except marijuana. She stated, however, that she never saw him smoke marijuana.

MANUELA AGUIRRE said that GALT spoke practically no Spanish and the bartender interpreted for him. She said that GALT had an old pair of sandals that he liked very much and which he said had been bought in Europe. She said she told him to throw the sandals away and buy new ones, but he did not want to get rid of them. She recalled that he definitely could not dance.

LEVISON ADVISED CORETTA KING'S SECRETARY TO CONTACT DAVIS IN A FEW DAYS TO SEE IF HE HAS RECEIVED THE TAPE.
