It was determined from physical observation that the ground floor was approximately ten feet by ten feet and contained one studio couch, one portable television set, and one small dresser. A bathroom was located on the ground floor. A spiral staircase led to a second bedroom of identical size, which contained a studio couch, a French Provincial desk, a chair, and a small clothes rack.

A December, 1967, New Orleans telephone book was located in the top center drawer of the French Provincial desk and it was determined that the following pages in the "white section" of the telephone book were "dogeared" in the upper right hand corner:

Pages 47; 373; 375, and 377.

Two sheets of blue Provincial Motel stationery were found at page 47, and both sheets appeared to have indented writing thereon. These sheets were removed by the interviewing Agents in the presence of Miss CARSON.

Nothing else was located in the room other than the two blue sheets of stationery.
