Galt Apparently Eluded the FBI In California

BIRMINGHAM, Ala.—The FBI distributed wanted posters of Eric Starvo Galt yesterday after the 36-year-old mystery man apparently eluded FBI agents Wednesday in California.

A source said that agents had believed Wednesday, when U.S. Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark announced that a warrant had been issued for Galt's arrest in the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., that they were close to seizing Galt.

When the arrest failed to materialize Wednesday night, thousands of wanted posters, asking for the public's help in locating the suspected assassin of Dr. King, were distributed around the nation.

Exact Location Not Disclosed

The exact location in California where the FBI expected to arrest Galt was not disclosed. Sources said a tip on Galt's whereabouts obviously was wrong or that Galt—if he is in California—eluded authorities.

Galt was charged in Birmingham Wednesday with conspiracy to violate Dr. King's civil rights, and was charged

by the state of Tennessee with murdering the 39-year-old civil rights leader with a single rifle shot on April 4.

An unnamed "alleged brother" of Galt was said in the FBI complaint to be a co-conspirator. No warrant has been issued for the arrest of the brother and the FBI has steadfastly declined to discuss him.

An FBI source indicated yesterday that the tip may have been supplied by the brother. Speculation that the FBI had the brother in custody was denied at FBI headquarters in Washington.

"The FBI has no one in custody in connection with Dr. King's slaying," the bureau said.

Galt is known to have twice mentioned a brother during the last two months.

There was some indication yesterday that the FBI still had not learned whether Eric Starvo Galt is a fictitious name, although the agency was reported Wednesday to have decided that is was.

Although no copies of the first-degree murder warrant filed against Galt were publicly distributed, Memphis police were known to be investigating a report by a night desk clerk at the Rebel Motel in that city that a man registered as Eric S. Galt on April 3 and a white Mustang auto with Mexican tourist stiekers was parked at the motel.

FBI Says He's 'Galt'

Escaped Convict Named In Slaying of Dr. King

WASHINGTON—The FBI announced yesterday that an escaped convict named James Earl Ray, alias Eric Starvo Galt, is the man it is seeking in the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

pictured Ray as a trouble-prone "drifter" and habitual criminal with a long record of erratic and violent behavior.

Galt's true identity was discovered after fingerprints uncovered in the investigation of Dr. King's death were compared with the prints of more than 53,000 persons listed as "wanted" by the FBI.

FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover said in a joint announcement with Atty. Gen. Ramsey Clark that Ray escaped from the Missouri State Penitentiary on April 23, 1967.

Ray, a 40-year-old native of Illinois, had served seven years of a 20-year sentence for armed robbery and car theft in St. Louis.

Photos Released of Ray

The FBI released front and side photographs of Ray that were taken by Missouri prison officials in 1960. They bear a close resemblance to pictures of Galt, taken in 1968, that the FBI released earlier this week.

The convict Ray had close-cropped hair and a leaner face than the Galt photo shows, but the protruding left ear, which the FBI emphasized in its initial description of Galt, appears the same in both photographs.

The FBI's description of Ray was much more detailed than that given for Galt. Ray was said to be about 5 feet, 10 incres tall and to weigh about 163 to 174 pounds. He has blue eyes, brown hair and



a small scar on the center of his forehead and a scar on the palm of his right hand.

The description, however, did not competely match those given by earlier witnesses in the case. These included:

A long-nosed man in his late 20s who was seen in Memphis at a rooming house from which the shot was fired that killed Dr. King.

A 30-year-old, quiet-spoken man who talked about the weather at a Birmingham rooming house last fall.

A 36-year-old "avid dancer" who bought a rifle in Birmingham and who took dancing lessons in New Orleans at the time when James Earl Ray was imprisoned in Missouri.

The witnesses who saw Galt at a Memphis rooming house the day Dr. King was slain said that he was 5 feet, 11 inches or 6 feet tall, slender, weighing 165 pounds, with sandy hair. The oldest estimate of his age was 32 years, the youngest 26. He was said to have a long pointed nose and a Southern accent.

At a Birmingham rooming house where Galt lived for six weeks last fall, he was described as being 5 feet 10 inches tall, weighing 175 pounds, with brown hair and a slightly Southern accent. He was described as being about 30 years old.

Long Arrest Record

The FBI announcement said Ray has a known arrest record dating back to 1949, when he was convicted of burglary in Los Angeles. In 1952 he was convicted of armed robbery in Chicago and in 1955 he was found guilty of forging U.S. postal money orders in Missouri.

He served a jail term in Los Angeles County in 1949 and in the Illinois state prisons at Joliet and Pontiac in 1952-54. He served a term in the Federal Penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kan., in 1955-58.

While he was serving his latest sentence, Ray was confined for a time in 1966 in the maximum security ward at the state hospital at Fulton, Mo.

3 Tries at Escape

Missouri officials said yesterday that Ray made three unsuccessful attempts to escape before he finally got away last April. One attempt came when he bolted from sheriff's deputies who were guarding him during his trial. He was quickly caught and sentenced to 20 years as a habitual offender on Dec. 17, 1959.

He tried to escape again in 1961 and 1966.

The FBI statement said Ray was an enlisted man in the Army from February 1946 to December 1948, when he was given a general discharge due to "ineplness and lack of adaptability for military service." While in the Army he was given a three-month sentence at had labor for being drunk and breaking arrest.

Ray was said to have also used the aliases of James McBride, James Walton, W. C. Herron and James O'Conndr. When the FBI filed formal charges against him Wednesday in the name of Galt, it gave two other aliases, John Willard and Harvey Lowmyer.

Attended Illinois School

According to the FBI, Ray claimed to have been born on March 10, 1928, in an upstate location in Illinois. He said he attended school through the 10th grade in Alton, Ill. Since then, the FBI said, "He has had the reputation of being a 'drifter'."

The identification of Galt as the escaped convict Ray explains some of the strange circumstances about Galt that led to some speculation that he might have established a false identity in contemplation of assassinating Dr. King.

Galt first appeared, according to FBI statements, on Aug. 30, 1967, when he purchased a white Mustang auto in Birmingham. Despite efforts to check on Galt's earlier activities, no trace of him before last fall was ever disclosed.

Hoover did not mention the discrepancies between his statement Wednesday and his latest announcement. FBI officials handed the announcement naming tay to reporters and refused to answer questions.

Thus left open to speculation were these points:

On March 1, an Eric Galt telephoned the Alabama Highway Patrol to ask for a duplicate copy of the driver's license that he had gotten in September 1967. The copy was mailed to a Birmingham address and a bill for 25 cents, which was enclosed with the duplicate, was returned to Montgomery on March 6 along with the 25 cents due.

The FBI had said Wednesday Galt was in California during this time.

✓ In its bulletin on Wednesday describing Galt as an avid dancer, the FBI said he had taken dancing lessons in New Orleans in 1964 and 1965.

Yesterday's bulletin said that Galt, under the name James Earl Ray, had been in prison in Missouri from 1960 until he escaped in April 1967.

Yesterday's bulletin did not mention Galt's "alleged brother," which the FB had said entered into a conspiracy with Galt in Birmingham on March 29, 1963, to deprive Dr. King of his civil rights.

At about 6 p.m. on 4/4/68, while standing on the second floor balcony outside Room 306 of the Lorraine Motel, 406 Mulberry Street, Memphis, Tennessee, Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. was struck in the right side of the face by a single bullet fired from a 30-06 rifle. The bullet severed KING's spinal cord and death was almost instantaneous.

This investigation, predicated upon a specific request from the Attorney General of the United States, disclosed that the fatal shot had been fired from the bathroom of a cheap rooming house located at 422½ South Main Street, Memphis, which bathroom was located at the rear of the rooming house, and had a window overlooking the Lorraine Motel.

At about 3 p.m. on 4/4/68, an individual using the name JOHN WILLARD had rented Room 5-B in the rooming house at 422½ South Main Street and had paid one week's rent. After hearing the rifle shot at about 6 p.m. on that same day, other tenants in the rooming house observed a man presumably identical with WILLARD, fleeing from the rooming house carrying a large package which was subsequently abandoned by him on the sidewalk in front of the Canipe Amusement Co., 424 South Main Street, Memphis. A neighborhood investigation in the vicinity of 424 South Main Street disclosed that the subject had fled from the scene in a white Mustang.

Found abandoned in front of 424 South Main Street was a 30-06 Remington model 760 rifle which was determined to have been Starched

Investigation at Memphis disclosed that an individual had purchased a set of binoculars at the York Arms Company in Memphis on 4/4/68. These binoculars were among the material abandoned with the rifle and recovered in Memphis. Also recovered was a brown and green herringbone bedspread. The items abandoned in Memphis were all wrapped in this bedspread. The blue bag which was inside the bedspread contained numerous items, among which were the binoculars and a set of underwear consisting of a T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirt and shorts are those on which appears the laundry mark which has been a matter of interest in this case.

A search of motel records in the Memphis area disclosed that an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT had spent the night of 4/3/68 at the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, and was driving a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama License Livestigation at Birmngham disclosed that this automobile had been purchased by ERIC S. GALT on August 30, 1965, from a private person in response to a newspaper ad. He paid a total of \$1995 cash. While in Birmingham he furnished the address of 2608 South Highland Avenue, Birmingham. This is also the address which appeared on a driver's license issued to him by the State of Alabama. The driver's license identifying data listed his birth date as July 20, 1931, his height as 5'll", his weight as 170 and his eyes blue and hair brown.

The automobile in question, the white Mustang bearing the Alabama tags mentioned above, was recovered in Atlanta on 4/11/68 and determined to have been abandoned there prior to 9 a.m. on 4/5/68.

In connection with the evidence submitted by Atlanta, Birmingham, and Memphis, identifiable latent prints were recovered. It was on the basis of these latents that identification was made of JAMES EARL RAY. In handling future leads, all offices should be particularly interested in securing an identifying number, military, police, or FBI, in connection with suspects so that the necessary check can be made through the Identification Division.

On 4/17/68, AUSA R. MACEY TAYLOR, Birmingham, authorized the filing of a complaint charging ERIC STARVO GALT with a conspiracy to violate Section 241. Title 18. U. S. Code. and

recommended bond in the amount \$50,000. On that same date, SAC JOSEPH H. GAMBLE filed a complaint before USC MILDRED F. SPRAGUE, Birmingham, and warrant was issued that same date.

At about 6 p.m. on 4/4/68, while standing on the second floor balcony outside Room 306 of the Lorraine Motel, 406 Mulberry Street, Memphis, Tennessee, Dr. MARTIN/LUTHER KING, JR. was struck in the right side of the face by a single bullet fired from a 30-06 rifle. The bullet severed KING's spinal cord and death was almost instantaneous.

This investigation, predicated upon a specific request from the Attorney General of the United States, disclosed that the fatal shot had been fired from the bathroom of a cheap rooming house located at 422½ South Main Street, Memphis, which bathroom was located at the rear of the rooming house, and had a window overlooking the Lorraine Motel.

At about 3 p.m. on 4/4/68, an individual using the name JOHN WILLARD had rented Room 5-B in the rooming house at 422½ South Main Street and had paid one week's rent. After hearing the rifle shot at about 6 p.m. on that same day, other tenants in the rooming house observed a man presumably identical with WILLARD, fleeing from the rooming house carrying a large package which was subsequently abandoned by him on the sidewalk in front of the Canipe Amusement Co., 424 South Main Street, Memphis. A neighborhood investigation in the vicinity of 424 South Main Street disclosed that the subject had fled from the scene in a white Mustang.

Found abandoned in front of 424 South Main Street was a 30-06 Remington model 760 rifls which was determined to have been

sold to one HARVEY LOWMEYER on 3/30/68 by Aeromarine Supply Co., Birmingham, Alabama.

Investigation at Memphis disclosed that an individual had purchased a set of binoculars at the York Arms Company in Memphis on 4/4/68. These binoculars were among the material abandoned with the rifle and recovered in Memphis. Also recovered was a brown and green herringbone bedspread. The items abandoned in Memphis were all wrapped in this bedspread. The blue bag which was inside the bedspread contained numerous items, among which were the binoculars and a set of underwear consisting of a T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirt and shorts are those on which appears the laundry mark which has been a matter of interest in this case.

A search of motel records in the Memphis area disclosed that an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT had spent the night of 4/3/68 at the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, and was driving a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama License ...

Investigation at Birmngham disclosed that this automobile had been purchased by ERIC S. GALT on August 30, 1968, from a private person in response to a newspaper ad. He paid a total of \$1995 cash. While in Birmingham he furnished the address of 2608 South Highland Avenue, Birmingham. This is also the address which appeared on a driver's license issued to him by the State of Alabama. The driver's license identifying data listed his birth date as July 20, 1931, his height as 5'll", his weight as 170 and his eyes blue and hair brown.

The automobile in question, the white Mustang bearing the Alabama tags mentioned above, was recovered in Atlanta on 4/11/68 and determined to have been abandoned there prior to 9 a.m. on 4/5/68.

In connection with the evidence submitted by Atlanta, Birmingham, and Memphis, identifiable latent prints were recovered. It was on the basis of these latents that identification was made of JAMES EARL RAY. In handling future leads, all offices should be particularly interested in securing an identifying number, military, police, or FBI, in connection with suspects so that the necessary check can be made through the Identification Division.

On 4/17/68, AUSA R. MACEY TAYLOR, Birmingham, authorized the filing of a complaint charging ERIC STARVO GALT with a conspiracy to violate Section 241, Title 18, U. S. Code, and



Reverend A. D. WILLIAMS KING, 1005 Southwestern Parkway, Louisville, Kentucky, pastor of the Zion Baptist Church, 2200 West Walnut Street, Louisville, Kentucky, was interviewed in the office of his church. He furnished the following information:

He is the brother of the late Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

Late on the night of April 3, 1968, Reverend A.

D. WILLIAMS KING arrived in Memphis, Tennessee, and registered in the Lorraine Motel for the purpose of assisting his brother in connection with the brother's efforts to settle the sanitation strike then in progress in Memphis. He had several contacts with his brother on Thursday, April 4, 1968. During the morning of April 4, 1968, he was in the company of his brother when the brother held a strategy meeting in Room 306 of the Lorraine Motel concerning the action to be taken by his brother and his associates with respect to efforts to obtain a suitable settlement to the sanitation strike. This meeting lasted several hours in the morning.

On the afternoon of April 4, 1968, Reverend KING was with his brother and other individuals at the Lorraine Motel for several hours. This was not a business meeting but rather a social gathering. This gathering ended shortly before 6 p.m. April 4, 1968, when the participants had decided to go to dinner. Reverend KING had taken several sleeping pills during the gathering and went to his room and fell asleep. Sometime shortly thereafter, exact time not remembered, he was awakened and told that his brother had been shot and had been taken to a hospital. Reverend KING immediately felt in his own mind that his brother was dead although as yet no announcement of death had been made. For several minutes Rev. KING felt extreme bitterness, but then when he became rational, he reasoned that whoever had done such a deed had to be mentally "sick" and the bitterness left Reverend KING and he remembered a passage

in the Bible in which JESUS CHRIST, during his agony and death, called upon His heavenly father to:

Father, forgive them for they know not what they do.

Reverend KING then realized that if his Christian upbringing was what he feels it to be, he had to feel the same way about the shooting of his brother.

Reverend KING further commented that the murder of his brother has only served to make him see more clearly that violence is not the answer to the Negroes' problem.

Reverend KING stated that during the several contacts he had with his brother on April 4, 1968, his brother gave no indication that he had received any information indicating an attempt on his life would be made on that date. On the contrary, his brother seemed to Reverend KING to be overly jubilant in that he, the brother, felt that he was making progress in obtaining a desirable solution for the sanitation strikers in Memphis, Tennessee.

Reverend KING advised that after his arrival in Memphis, Tennessee, late on April 3, 1968, until after the shooting of his brother, he, Reverend KING, had left the Lorraine Motel on only one occasion, that being around noon, April 4, 1968, when he, in the company of Mrs. LUCRETIA WARD of Louisville, Kentucky, who was also staying on that date at the Lorraine Motel, went to a nearby dry cleaning establishment and drugstore to make some purchases. On this occasion, they were gone from the motel but for a short time and Reverend KING observed nothing unusual or indicative of any indication that harm might befall his brother on that date.

Reverend KING further commented that prior to his above visit to Memphis, Tennessee, he had last personally seen his brother in Washington, D.C., in February, 1968, exact date not recalled. However, he frequently telephonically was in contact with his brother and during none of these contacts did his brother indicate to him that any open threat upon his life had been made. However, Reverend KING

commented that he knew his brother lived with the thought in mind that efforts might be made to assassinate him and Reverend KING feels such an effort did occur in Birmingham, Alabama, several years ago, when first Reverend KING's home was dynamited and about 20 minutes later, the motel at which his late brother was then staying was also dynamited.

Reference is made to previous memos to all SAs in this matter.

The following additional information is being furnished your for your future guidance:

JAMES EARL RAY, aka Earl James Ray, W.C. Herron, Earl James, James McBride, James O'Conner, James Walton, James Walyon, and "Jim", a UFAC fugitive, 00: Kansas City, has been positively identified through fingerprints as the subject in instant case. RAY, an inmate of the Missouri State Penitentiary, Jefferson City, Mo., escaped from that institution 4/23/67. Investigation indicated RAY concealed himself in a breadbox and escaped from a truck making a delivery to an auxiliary farm. RAY was serving twenty years on a charge of Armed Robbery-1st Degree, and for Operating a Motor Vehicle Without the Owner's Consent.

On 7/20/68, Federal complaint was authorized by AUSA WILLIAM A. KITCHEN, Western District of Missouri, Kansas City, Mo., and filed before USA, Jefferson City, Mo. charging RAY with violation T. 18, Sec. 1073, USC. A warrant was issued.

RAY for the most part has been a "loner" and little information is known re any associates or accomplices.

On 3/7/55, however, RAY and WALTER TERRY RIFE, burglarized a U.S. Post Office at Kellerville, Ill. and stole 66 blank MOs which they passed during 3/55 in numerous states with the result that both were sentenced in USDC,

The records also indicate that he received treatment for gonorrhea and syphilis while in the military.
