Killer Must Be Apprehended Alive-

THE CONFUSING REPORTS issued by law-enforcement officials investigating the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King are disquieting. More and more the killing of Dr. King begins to look like the work of a conspiracy. If ex-convict James Earl Ray was the killer, as the FBI says, where did he get the money he so freely spent? He had no visible means of support. What was his motive?

It is important that Ray be captured alive. If he isn't, we are likely to be haunted by the same kind of questions that are still unanswered in the assassination of President Kennedy. By describing Ray as "armed and extremely dangerous" in a public announcement, the FBI has decreased the chances of apprehending him alive.

In an editorial over the weekend, The Atlanta Journal said: "We regard it as imperative that James Earl Ray... be taken into custody alive and closely protected therefter. If this is the killer, every possible step

must be taken to see that he is not silenced before he talks."

The feeling is growing that Attorney General Ramsey Clark prematurely ruled out a conspiracy theory. Later, in its warrant for the arrest of Galt (or Ray) the FBI charged him with conspiracy without disclosing the scope or nature of it.

This week *Time* magazine reported that a Memphis man "told *Time* and the FBI that he had overheard a local businessman giving an unknown triggerman urgent orders to kill King on the balcony of his motel, and even specifying the price for the job (\$5,000), and the pickup point for the fee." The FBI declined to comment on the report.

KING CASE AGAINST THE FINGERPRINTS OF THE OVER 53,000 PERSONS FROM WHOM "WANTED NOTICES" HAVE BEEN POSTED IN THE FILES OF THE FBI"S IDENTIFICATION DIVISION LED TO THE DETERMINATION THAT GALT AND MAY ARE IDENTICAL.

MR. HOOVER SAID THAT RAY, WHO IS 40 YEARS OF AGE, WAS REPORTED MISSING FROM THE MISSOURI STATE PENITENTIARY AT JEFFERSON CITY, MISSOURI, SINCE APRIL 23, 1967. CONFINED FOR A TIME IN THE MAXIMUM SECURITY WARD AT THE STATE HOSPITAL
AT FULTON, MISSOURI.

ACCORDING TO MR. HOOVER, RAY HAS A KNOWN ARREST RECORD
DATING BACK TO 1949. PRIOR TO THE 1960 CONVICTION FOR WHICH HE
RECEIVED, THE 20-YEAR TERM, RAY HAD BEEN CONVICTED OF BURGLARY IN
LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA, IN 1949; ARMED ROBBERY IN CHICAGO,
ILLINOIS, IN 1952; AND FORGING UNITED STATES POSTAL MONEY ORDERS
IN MISSOURI IN 1955.

HE HAS SERVED TERMS IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY JAIL IN
1949; IN STATE PRISONS AT JOLIET AND PONTIAC, ILLINOIS, IN 1952-54;
AND IN THE FEDERAL PENITENTIARY AT LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS, IN 1955-58.


