

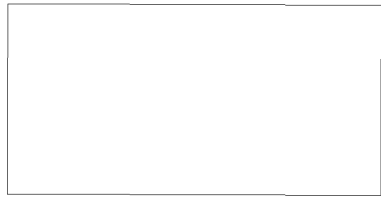

Umar Pugh TP info for murder. BO featured a program about James Earl Ray
& the killing of Martin Luther King which prompted & in
Pugh to talk to him since thought would be housed together in Oklahoma.

Pugh said Oct or Nov 1967 he & Pat Early
robbed some business man at a poker game in Memphis.
Pugh said was at a fish fry & Pat's watch stolen
was later interviewed by FBI in custody in Dallas, TX.

In 2/68 TP & PE went to ~~Memphis~~ gun shop
on west side of river in Memphis, TN
bought 30.06 & 30 cal rifle. (PE now in
Fed pen in AZ.) Pugh wanted to live with to kill
MLK. TP to plan & PE as the sharpshooter because of
shooting experience.

Persons wanted killing Retail Merchants Union in
Memphis, TN. Reason was that local blacks were boycotting
local business of white merchants due to civil rights movement
& MLK was instrumental in movement. Man hired the
mgt of Jerry Lee Cowan who was father of Lewis' boys old
cousin the married, name not told TP. TP was fam w/ this
person since TP per committed other crime for this person.

This mgt then hired TP & PE who then bought the
guns. Both then thought about a few days if TP feared
FBI would be prevented in solving & would be big deal.
Told the mgt & a get word so very contented

James Earl Ray's bro, name not given. DPO said
his bro (JER) would do since just got out of the pen.

After killing, JER was located in another country
w/ a 30.06, \$10,000 & couple of passports. (TP
never told him what happened to the 2 weapons he
& PE purchased prev.)

Elliott asked TP where TP was at when killing
occurred & got angry & said ~~not~~ wouldn't tell Elliott
anything that would implicate him. TP didn't say
if was in Memphis area at time

Only thing JER knows directly is who paid
him in Memphis bro but gives FBI phony name
to protect his brother.

He feels TP was telling truth. Many believe
that justice is done. Why ask others tell to his face rather
truth. Why would want small amount of money to go to his
mother if his information is accurate and used by media.
