Mr. DAVID NEWBERRY, 1746 Carter Avenue, Memphis, Tennessee, telephone 278-4282, telephonically contacted this office at noon, 4/15/68, to advise that the Mexican artist's conception of the killer of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING bore a remarkable resemblance to an old friend of his, one DAVID ALEXANDER MC CLINTOCK with whom NEWBERRY went to school in Pittsburg, Kansas, some years ago.

NEWBERRY stated that MC CLINTOCK had served in the U.S. Navy. He also recalled that MC CLINTOCK had a part of a finger and a thumb missing and also had several tattoos. MC CLINTOCK would presently be about 38 or 39 years of age.

NEWBERRY has not seen MC CLINTOCK for about 10 years. At that time, MC CLINTOCK was living with his mother, whose name NEWBERRY did not know, in Wichita, Kansas. NEWBERRY recalled that MC CLINTOCK was originally from Joplin, Missouri.

NEWBERRY has no reason to believe that MC CLINTOCK is involved in captioned crime, merely furnished the information of the resemblance and for whatever assistance it might be to this Bureau.

On 4/12/68, Mrs. ADDIE ALEXANDER, residing at 1213 Ireland Street in Nashville, Tennessee, telephonically contacted the Nashville RA at which time she advised as follows:

She related she and her two daughters attended the funeral of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. at Atlanta, Georgia, and while they were on the campus where the funeral ceremony was held she observed a white male whom she thought was possibly identical with the killer of Dr. KING. She related that while Vice-President HUMPHREY was at this gathering she was on the lawn of the campus and turned for a moment at which time she observed this man and turned to her daughter, telling her that this man looked like the killer of Dr. KING.

She related that after her remark the man apparently took notice of her and she became petrified that he was going to kill her. At this time a Negro police officer approached the area and she observed the white man leave on foot. She stated she was so afraid that she did not say anything to anyone and after returning to her residence in Nashville and viewing an artist's conception of the killer as appearing in the local papers she felt she should relate this information for whatever value it may contain.

She stated the man's hairline very closely resembles that in the artist's conception as did his physical build. She recalled he was wearing a brown suit which was "very cheap looking". She stated she did not observe him enter a vehicle nor did she observe anyone with him.

The above information is set forth for information purposes in view of the investigation currently under way at Memphis and Atlanta, Georgia.

He said he has now determined that SCHMITZ is staying at the YMCA, 245 Madison, Memphis, Tennessee.

On 4/10/68, an individual, HOWARD B. CASH, 249 Honduras Drive, Memphis, Tennessee, telephonically contacted the Memphis Office, and furnished the following information:

CASH stated that on 4/9/68, that he had attended the funeral of DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING at Atlanta, Georgia, and had participated in the march in that city. He stated that while circulating through the crowd attending the funeral, he overheard two persons talking about the possibility of a policeman shooting DR. KING in Memphis, Tennessee. He stated that these persons had maps, which he thought to be maps of the City of Memphis, and they were discussing how DR. KING was shot on the south side of Memphis, and a white Mustang was later noticed on the north side of Memphis, which answered the description of the Mustang supposedly used as a getaway car.

He stated that these persons were expressing the thought that the PD had been involved, and had given safe conduct to the murderer so that he could get out of Memphis.

He described these individuals as being a white male, and another male whom he described as a black-skinned Negro or a foreigner. This was the extent of the description which CASH furnished.

He stated that these persons were also talking about the militant Negroes taking action, providing the subject in the murder of DR. KING was not apprehended quickly. However, he could not furnish any details about the militant talks.

CASH identified himself as an employee of the Federal Government, and stated that he worked with the Postal Department. At the time of the talk, CASH demanded that the Memphis PD be thoroughly investigated concerning the possibility that a policeman or policemen were involved in the shooting of DR. KING.

On April 8, 1968, Patrolman LLOYD GOODBREAD, Chesapeake, Virginia, Police Department, advised that JOHN WOOLARD, also known as Rusty, is a possible suspect in the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. He described WOOLARD as a white male, in his mid-twenties, who resides on Route 4, Box 203, Washington, North Carolina. He said WOOLARD is an expert hunter and a former baseball player and last Christmas had a Remington .30-06.

Patrolman GOODBREAD advised that he knows of no extremist sympathies on the part of WOOLARD, however, he fits the general description of the assassin of KING. He stated he does not know whether WOOLARD has been in military service but he is believed to have been arrested locally on minor charges and believed to be employed at New Bern, North Carolina.

The following investigation was conducted by SA EDWARD W. LUDEMANN:

AT VANCEBORO, NORTH CAROLINA

On April 9, 1968, Mrs. MOZELLE BARROW, Route 1, Vanceboro, North Carolina, advised that JOHN WOOLARD, also known as Rusty, is her son-in-law and resides with her. She advised that he has eaten every meal at her home for the past ten days and has been in bed at a reasonable hour every night during this period.

By communication dated April 6, 1968, the Memphis Office of the FBI advised as follows:

ROBERT M. COFFEY, Oteen, North Carolina, and DON TAYLOR, 131 Castle Rock Road, Asheville, North Carolina, both with WSKY, Asheville, North Carolina, telephonically advised the Memphis Office that they believed NEIL PARRIS may be identical with the assassin of MARTIN LUTHER KING. According to COFFEY, PARRIS was formerly the manager of Ice Service Stores at Asheville and recently embezzled in excess of \$10,000 in company funds and disappeared. COFFEY and TAYLOR said PARRIS fits the descritpion of the assassin which they read in their paper and because of this they believe he may be identical.

They both advised that PARRIS telephonically contacted his wife from Nashville, Tennessee, on April 3, 1968, stating he was going to give himself up but he has failed to return. COFFEY said that PARRIS has a 1965 white Ford automobile.

The following investigation was conducted by SA ROBERT S. MOORE:

AT ASHEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA

On April 10, 1968, Detective W. E. HANEY, Asheville Police Department, advised that MARCUS NEIL PARRIS was arrested at Asheville on the night of April 8, 1968. HANEY said he verified that PARRIS was in Room 4, Sun Valley Motel, Arden, North Carolina, on April 4, 1968 - April 5, 1968, on a drinking spree.

On April 9, 1968, ALFRED HERBERT HARLEY, ~3216 James Place, Greensboro, advised he is president and owner of Speedline Manufacturing Company, a pipe insulator manufacturer. HARLEY stated he has a private pilot's license and owns and operates his own company aircraft, Number 7512Y, twin Comanche. He said he departed Greensboro at 4 A. M. on Tuesday, April 2, 1968, on company business in his airplane and arrived at St. Louis, Missouri, at 6:30 A.M. on April 2, 1968. He stayed at the Holiday Inn Motel near the airport in St. Louis. He departed St. Louis at 2:30 P. M. on April 3, 1968, and arrived at the Memphis airport at approximately 4 P. M. on that date. He stayed at the Admiral Benbow near the airport and spent Wednesday evening April 3, 1968, with Mr. GRAHAM LOTT, Aviation Material, Incorporated, 4278 Swinnea Road, Memphis, concerning the sale of aircraft. On April 4, 1968, HARLEY called on customers which he identified as Armstrong Contracting and Supply Company, and Industrial Insulator Company in Memphis. He furnished information to the effect that he finished his business early in the afternoon of April 4, 1968, and had planned to fly back to Greensboro; however, upon checking with the Flight Service Station and Weather Bureau at the airport, he cancelled his flight because of bad weather between Memphis and Greensboro. He said although he has a pilot's license, he is not instrument qualified.



ROBERT JONES, Director of Woodrow Wilson Rehabilitation Center, Staunton, Virginia, advised on April 9, 1968, he was in Savannah, Georgia, on the night of April 5 - 6, 1968, at a local bar. He met one LESTER FORSYTH from the State Office of the "Ku Klux Klan," Post Office Box 12, Caldwell, New Jersey. JONES stated that he believed FORSYTH is an exact look-alike of the artist's conception of the unknown subject in the MARTIN LUTHER KING assassination. He said he, JONES, was accompanied by SAMUEL TARLTON, Superintendent, Historical Sites, North Carolina Department of Archives and History, Raleigh, North Carolina.

The following investigation was conducted by SA DONALD M. MURRAY:

AT RALEIGH, NORTH CAROLINA

On April 9, 1968, SAMUEL TARLTON, North Carolina Department of Archives and History, Raleigh, advised he was with BOB JONES of Staunton, Virginia, in Savannah, Georgia, on April 5 and 6, 1968, staying at the Manger Hotel. They visited the lounge in the hotel at 10:30 P. M. on April 5, 1968, and met a man by the name of (FIRST NAME UNKNOWN) FORSYTH, who indicated he was traveling and campaigning for Wallace for President. He indicated the possibility of remaining in Savannah several days concerning this campaign.

TARLTON advised that FORSYTH indicated some connection with the Ku Klux Klan. He did not indicate his residence or where he was staying in Savannah. He appeared to be travel-worn and was alone. He said he was from Newark, New Jersey.

He said that he, JONES, and FORSYTH left the lounge about midnight and visited a hamburger restaurant behind the hotel where they ate. They left FORSYTH in the restaurant. Several policement were observed in and around the restaurant but FORSYTH did not appear to know the officers or any other people in the hotel and restaurant. He said while passing through a parking lot between the hotel and the restaurant, FORSYTH pointed to an automobile, indicated it was his, and

said he hoped rioters did not damage it, noting that he had Wallace Stickers on the bumper. The vehicle is believed to be a late model station wagon, possibly a Chevrolet or Ford, gray or blue in color.

TARLTON described FORSYTH as a white male, twenty-five to thirty years of age, five feet six inches, one hundred fifty pounds, medium build, light pale complexion, blond hair, hairline receding and hair cut close to head or short cut. He stated that FORSYTH was dressed neatly but his clothing looked well worn. He had a Northern accent.

TARLTON said he subsequently observed the artist's conception of the assassin on television and did not feel that FORSYTH appeared to be similar with this conception.

It should be noted that WILBURN accompanied SA JOE H. ROBERTS to Cole's Drug Store where MARTHA MYNATT stated that she felt that she was contacted by WILBURN on Thursday but admitted that it could have been Friday, 4/5/68.

ELEANOR DAVENPORT, another employee at Cole's Drug Store, recalls that WILBURN was at the drug store on Thursday even though MARTHA MYNATT got off duty at the same time on Friday. Mrs. DAVENPORT stated she still felt that WILBURN was there on April 4, 1968, Thursday.

Miss SHARON BRADLEY, 1845 Terrace Avenue, Knoxville, advised on 4/8/68 that WILBURN was in the drug store at the time she heard the radio report that Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING had been shot in Memphis, Tennessee.

During the contact with WILBURN it was determined that he was fingerprinted in connection with his military service. Files of the Knoxville PD reflect WILBURN was arrested on 4/20/63 for drunkenness and he was released without photograph or fingerprints being taken. This case was dismissed. He was also arrested for reckless driving on 2/25/64 and fined \$5.00.

On 4/8/68 it was determined that WILBURN's laundry was left at the One-Hour Cleaners on Friday, April 5, 1968.

It was determined that WILBURN is taking only one class at the University of Tennessee, which is Intermediate French, meeting 1:15 to 2:15 PM, Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

WILLIAM VAUGHAM WILBURN was interviewed at his apartment, 2112 Highland Avenue.

WILDURN advised that he is a graduate student at the University of Tennessee (U-T), working toward a Ph.D and attends class on Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

When asked the question regarding his whereabouts on April 4, 1968, he stated that he was at Knoxville but pointed out that he would not have been in class that day because it was Thursday. He recalled that he awake about 8:00 AM and spent the morning at the U-T Library. He stated that he either ate lunch at Byerly's Cafeteria or Evans' Cafeteria on the way from the library back to his apartment, where he checked his mail and may have taken a nap. During the afternoon, approximately 2:00 PM, he walked to Cole's Drug Store located at the corner of Cumberland Avenue and 17th Street where he purchased some vitamins. He recalled having a conversation with MARTHA MYMATT, a cashier, at the drug store. He stated that they were at the fountain or lunch counter and he was talking jokingly with Miss MYHATT about her drinking habits when another employee made the comment that Miss MYMATT did a better job when she was drinking.

Mr. WILDURN stated that he took his laundry to the One-Hour Cleaners directly behind the Cole's Drug Store, either Thursday or Friday morning. He stated that he does not know the mame of the employee on duty when he left the laundry but recalled that she agreed to have it ready on Monday.

After leaving Cole's Brug Store during the afternoon, WILBURN stated that he returned to his apartment where he took a short nap and then studied in preparation for a Franch examination to be taken during the following week.

At about 7:00 PM on April 4, 1968, WILBURN was in Karns Drug Store, which is located on Cumberland at 19th Street, which is in the same neighborhood where he resides. The cashier, whose name WILBURN could not recall, told him that Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING had just been shot in Memphis, Tennessee. According to WILBURN, this cashier is on duty daily at the store and works during the evening and night.

At one point in the interview Mr. WILBURN stated that he did not desire that this investigation be brought to the attention of anyone in the Sociology Department at U-T since he felt it would hurt his reputation. He also stated that he had previously been in trouble with school officials at the University of Chattanooga where he taught Anthropology during 1964-1965. According to WILBURN, he used scientific findings concerning the size of the brain in Negroes, along with the instances of delinquency, crime, illegitimacy and disease in connection with his classes. This also got him into trouble at the University of Richmond where he was Associate Professor of Sociology during 1965-1966. He stated he incurred the wrath of Dr. E. W. GREGORY, JR., who caused him trouble until he left the school.

It was determined that Mr. WILBURN's car is a 1960 white Comet, 2-door, six cylinder, with radio antenna missing. It bore Knox County, Tennessee, license CK-2907.

During the interview with Mr. WILBURE he stated that he had an arrest record at the Knoxville Police Department for drunkenness during 1963 and passing a stop sign in 1964. He stated that he paid \$5.00 fine for passing the stop sign and the drunkenness charge was dismissed. He also advised he had been arrested for drunkenness at Clarksville, Tennessee.

WILBURN advised that he was at Knoxville on March 29-30, 1968, and was positive that he had attended a class on March 29, 1968, as this date was on Friday.

On April 8, 1968, Mr. WILEURN again accompanied SA JOE H. ROBERTS to the Karns Drug Store, at which time Miss SHARON BRADLEY was interviewed.

On April 8, 1968, Mr. WILBURN advised that he was attending French class at U-T from 1:15 to 2:15 PM on March 29, 1968, and again on April 5, 1968.
