HERRALD SAID HAWKINS IS ABOUT FORTY YEARS OF AGE AND CLOSELY FITS DESCRIPTION OF KING ASSASSIN. HAWKINS UNDERWENT PSYCHIATRIC TREATMENT IN FLORIDA FOLLOWING RELEASE FROM ARMY FIFTY-SEVEN OR FIFTY-EIGHT. REASON FOR TREATMENT NOT KNOWN BY HERRALD. HERRALD SAID CIRCUMSTANCES OF CLOSE RESEMBLANCE IN DESCRIPTION, PAST PSYCHIATRIC PROBLEMS, AND FACT THAT HAWKINS SAID HE WAS ON THE RUN INDICATED THE POSSIBILITY THAT HE IS KING ASSASSIN.

SINCE RELEASE FROM ARMY IN LATE FIFTY-SEVEN OR EARLY FIFTY-EIGHT HAWKINS HAS RESIDED WITH BROTHER, BERNARD HAWKINS AT RFD NO. ONE, BOX EIGHTEEN, WELLBORN, FLORIDA. HERRALD RECEIVED LETTER FROM HAWKINS POSTMARKED WELLBORN, FLORIDA, FEBRUARY TEN, LAST.

HERRALD SAID DURING NINETEEN FIFTY-FIVE THROUGH NINETEEN
FIFTY-SEVEN, HAWKINS WAS A SERGEANT FIRST CLASS IN THE REGULAR
ARMY STATIONED AT HEADQUARTERS COMPANY, SEVENTY EIGHT ELEVENTH
ARMY SERVICE UNIT IN FRANKFURT, GERMANY, AND WAS IN THE ADJUTANT
GENERAL'S CORP. HE IS BELIEVED TO HAVE SERVED IN KOREA PRIOR TO
THAT TIME. HERRALD DESCRIBED HAWKINS AS A WHITE MALE, ASE
APPROXIMATELY FORTY, FIVE FOOT NINE TO FIVE FOOT TEN, SANDY BROWN

MIAMI IMMEDIATELY MAKE APPROPRIATE IN-QUIRIES INCLUDING CHECK OF CREDIT, CRIMINAL AND LOCAL VA HOSPITAL RECORDS AND COORDINATE WITH JACKSONVILLE.

JACKSONVILLE IMMEDIATELY ATTEMPT TO LOCATE FLORIDA DRIVERS
LICENSE FOR DAVID HAWKINS AT TALLAHASEE, FLORIDA, AND OBTAIN THEREFROM DATE OF BIRTH. JACKSONVILLE WILL ALSO MAKE APPROPRIATE INQUIRIES AT WELLBORN, FLORIDA, TO DETERMINE WHEREABOUTS DURING THE
PERTINENT PERIODS OF THIS CASE. SUGGEST DIRECT APPROACH TO BROTHER
IF POSSIBLE. JACKSONVILLE WILL FURNISH HAWKINS' DATE OF BIRTH TO

He is a retired sergeant in the U.S. Marine Corps, having served 30 years.

He had been at Nina's Lounge located at 2947 Overton Crossing Road, Memphis. There was an individual in the lounge, name not known to him, who claimed that he was in the U.S. Marine Corps and was on leave and was then enroute to Vietnam. This individual, from his general appearance and haircut, did not appear to HAWKS to be a Marine.

This individual fit the general description of the composite picture which had been shown in the Memphis newspapers regarding instant case. He did not know the man's name, but according to a waitress at the lounge, this individual apparently was a stranger in this lounge and was drinking beer and apparently was becoming intoxicated.

He furnished the following description of the unknown individual:

At 1:15 PM, instant date, Mr. TOM HUTTON, Chuck Hutton Dodge Co., 1170 Union, Nemphis, Tenn., telephonically contacted this office and advised that on 4-11-68 two of his salesman, CHARLES MC COLLUM and E. N. TRACY had sold a 1960 Mercury station wagon to a MR. CUTLER for \$270.00 cash.

CUTLER came to the dealership earlier in the day, left a \$20.00 deposit on the car stating that he was getting the rest of the money from Denver and/or Chicago via Western Union. He asked of the car would make it to Sioux Falls, S.D. CUTLER told the salesmen that he sold encyclopedias and made about \$40,000.00 per year, also indicated he was 40 years old and has a daughter who recently graduated from college in Denver. CUTLER was dressed in an Allied Van Lines uniform.

HUTTON has been informed by his salesmen that CUTLER does not resemble the photos of ERIC STARVO GALT published in todays paper, nevertheless they feel he may have some connection with the killing of Dr. KING particularly in view of the highly unlikely story he told them.

HUTTON does not feel there is a connection with captioned matter and furnished the above for evaluation.

HUTTON's files contain a more complete record of above mentioned sale. They were not available to him at the time he called this office.

On 4/15/68, Mrs. BARBARA DIEHL, 3239 Route 225, Rootstown, Ohio, phone 947-2559 (Atwater), which is located about halfway between Youngstown and Akron, Ohio, furnished the following information which she requested be kept confidential:

She stated that after the killing of KING on 4/4/68, she and other members of her family observed sketches of the subject in Ravenna and Akron papers. They observed what they believe is a striking resemblance to her former son-in-law TOMMY RAY WHITE, who divorced her daughter, PATRICIA ANN WHITE, who is making her home with her at present. They stated at first all of them who knew her former son-in-law treated the matter as a joke but the more they have thought about the act, the more they are of the opinion that he could be the man being sought for the KING murder.

She stated her daughter separated from WHITE in June, 1966, and he secured a divorce from her in Jefferson County, Alabama. He was last in Portage County, Ohio, from 3/18-22/68, when a hearing was held relative to the custody of the child of the marriage, namely age 3. She stated on this occasion WHITE apparently had no car with him and either arrived in the area by bus, plane or train. She stated that the last she knew, he drove a 1965 White Ford but she does not know what he is driving at present.

She stated her former son-in-law is definitely psychotic and always carried a loaded gun in his car when he lived in the Portage County area for a time. When they asked him why he carried a gun, he would state he carried it to "kill niggers". She stated that although he never professed to be a member of the Klan, he indicated that many of his close friends were Klan members and expressed a deep seated hate for Negroes. He threatened to kill her daughter on many occasions and that was why she separated from him. She stated when in Portage County, Ohio, in March he told them he had married a girl whose maiden name was SHARON HENDERSON, a woman with three children by an unsuccessful marriage. 

HUNDRED FIFTY YARDS SOUTH OF INTERSECTION OF HIGHWAY SEVENTEEN ABOUT ELEVEN MILES NORTH OF CITRONELLE. ROGERS STATED HE RECALLED SEEING A SIGN NEAR THIS DIRT ROAD WHICH READ 'MOBILE FORTYTHREE MILES." ROGERS STATED HE TURNED AROUND AT THE INTERSECTION OF HIGHWAY SEVENTEEN AND WENT BACK TO THE DIRT ROAD WHERE HE SAW THE RAMBLER GOING AT A HIGH RATE OF SPEED OVER THE HILLS IN AN EASTERLY DIRECTION ON THIS DIRT ROAD. ROGERS STATED JUST PRIOR TO HIS LEAVING SPANISH FORT HE HAD OBSERVED A SKETCH OF THE SUSPECT WHO KILLED DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING IN MOBILE, ALABAMA, NEWSPAPER. HE STATED THAT THE MAN DRIVING THE ABOVE MENTIONED RAMBLER AUTOMOBILE BORE A VERY CLOSE RESEMBLANCE TO THAT SKETCH. ROGERS DESCRIBED THE DRIVER OF THAT CAR AS A WHITE MALE, ABOUT THIRTYFIVE YEARS OF AGE, BLACK OR BROWN HAIR, RECEDING HAIRLINE AND A THIN FACE. HE SAID THIS MAN HAD DARK CLOTHING HANGING IN THE BACK

The newspaper article mentioned in reBuairtel appeared in the 4/6/68 edition of the "Arizona Daily Star," as Tucson, Arizona, daily newspaper. The article concerning Dr. JOHNSON appeared on page 1; the article and composite sketch of Unsub appeared on page 2 of the same paper. On 4/6/68 Det. Sgt. LAWRENCE BIETSCH, Missing Persons Bureau, Tucson PD, advised SA RAYNER P. PETERS, JR., that as a result of the above two articles appearing in the same edition of the morning paper the Tucson PD received several calls from local citizens that date concerning the similarity of appearance and description of the missing 2 - Bureau (Enc. 2) M W SERIALIZED B. PX 44-371 RPP/gle Dr. JOHNSON and Unsub. This matter has been followed closely with Sgt. DIETSCH And on 4/16/68 he summarized the results of the investigation by the Tucson PD and other local agencies to locate Dr. JOHNSON as follows: Dr. JOHNSON was born 8/4/22 at Twin Falls, Idaho. In early childhood the family moved to Glendale, California, and in 1936 they moved to Phoenix, Arizona. They moved to Tueson, Arizona, during Dr. JOHNSON's high school years. He finished high school in Tucson and finished his pre-med studies at the University of Arizona, Tucson. Upon completion of pre-med studies he entered the U. S. Army during World War II and was based at Fort Riley, Kansas, for a while. The Army later sent him to Medical school at Columbia, in New York, where he graduated in 1947. He interned at Baylor Hospital, Seattle, Washington, and at King County, Hospital, Seattle. He then returned to Tucson where he was a resident doctor at St. Mary's Hospital. In 1950 he and several other doctors formed a clinic in Tucson until 1960 when he became dissatisfied with this group and set up his own office as a specialist in internal medicine. He enjoys an excellent reputation in the community as a doctor and as an individual. Investigation has disclosed no political or racial activities of any kind and he his not known to have expressed any strong feelings concerning either political or racial matters. Sgt. DIETSCH said that since the appearance of the above articles 4/6/68, Mrs. JOHNSON has been interviewed concerning the possibility that Dr. JOHNSON might be considered a suspect in the KING case. She has advised interviewing Tucson Police officers that she knows of no statement or actions on the part of Dr. JOHNSON at any time in the past which would lead her to believe that he could be remotely connected with the KING case. Mrs. JOHNSON has told Tucson Police officers that Dr. JOHNSON "started taking pep pills" in about 1960 and Sgt. DIETSCH advised that other investigation indicates that Dr. JOHNSON has used narcotics at various times for a number of years. 2025 RELEASE UNDER E.O. 14176

PX 44-371 RPP/gle Mrs. JOHNSON advised Tucson Police officers that at the time of his disappearance, Dr. JOHNSON had been despondent for some time over ill health. He had a heart attack in 1958 and has recently been under the care of another Tucson physician for heart problems. Sgt. DIETSCH advised that the car Dr. JOHNSON was driving when last seen is a white 1967 MGH-GT two-door hardtop with Apizona license NAA-664. When first reported missing, Dr. JOHNSON had last been seen at 8:20 a.m., 3/29/68 when he left his office in Tucson to go to St. Joseph's Hospital in Tucson to confer with other doctors on a case. He did not return to his office and apparently has contacted no one since then. On 4/6/68 Dr. S. R. KEMBERLING, Tucson physician, after seeing a newspaper article concerning Dr. JOHNSON's disappearance, told Sgt. DIETSCH that he and his wife had seen Dr. JOHNSON 63/31/68 at the parking lot of St. Joseph's Nospital in Tucson. He said he and his wife both are well acquainted with Dr. JOHNSON and are positive of the identification. They waved at Dr. JOHNSON who acknowledged their greeting. Dr. JOHNSON was sitting in his white MGB sports car and appeared to be in good health and spirits. As of 4/16/68 this is the last report of Dr. JOHNSON's whereabouts. Sgt. DIETSCH said their investigation had developed that Dr. JOHNSON disappeared suddenly for several days in November, 1967, and was found only after he had wrecked his Austin Healy sports car near Benson, Arizona. When found he was believed to be under the influence of some type of narcotics. Sgt. DIETSCH said Dr. JOHNSON had been reported as a missing person on that occasion. Intensive investigation by the Tucson PD and other local law enforcement agencies to locate Dr. JOHNSON continues. The desert area of southern Arizona is being searched in view of the possibility that Dr. JOHNSON might have driven into the desert and either suffered a heart attack or committed suicide. 2025 RELEASE UNDER E.O. 14176

PX 44-371 RPP/gle Close liaison is being maintained with the Tucson PD concerning their investigation to locate Dr. JOHNSON. Any developments will be immediately reported to the Bureau and Memphis. Sgt. DIETSCH pointed out that in showing Dr. JOHNSON's photograph to any possible witnesses in the KING case, it should be borne in mind that at the time of his disappearance, 3/29/68, his hair was cut in a short crewcut style, which according to acquaintances was a noticeable feature of Dr. JOHNSON. Although there have been no facts developed to indicate that Dr. JOHNSON, by his background, profession, or actions, would normally be considered a likely suspect in this matter, investigation to date has not completely eliminated him. The general similarity between his description and that of Unsub, the date of his sudden disappearance and the fact he was driving a white sports car when last seen would appear to make him worthy of consideration as a suspect in this matter. Exhibition of Dr. JOHNSON's photograph to pertinent witnesses and other appropriate investigation being left to the discretion of Mamphis. 2025 RELEASE UNDER E.O. 14176

Dr. Johnson Missing For One Week

City police are searching for a 46-year-old Tucson physician who has been missing for one week after failing to keep an appointment at St. Joseph's Hospital.

Dr. Robert B. Johnson, of 100 Calle Encanto, was last seen March 29 when he left his office at 1311 N. Country Club Rd. He told his nurse he would return two hours later.

Officials at St. Joseph's said Dr. Johnson apparently never made it to the hospital.

The doctor is described as 5-feet-10, weighs about 175 pounds, and has a small scar on his forehead. He has brown eyes, graying hair worn in a crew cut and medium complexion.
