During 1967 and 1968, JERRY LEON MABRY, Jr. has appeared at the Chattanooga Resident Agency on numerous occasions. His speech was very incoherent and almost on each occasion left some type of "junk mail".

An acquaintance of MARRY, JOHN L. BOND, Jr., a local businessman on April 15, 1968, advised MABRY is mentally incompetent and he, BOND, is presently in the process of attempting to have him re-committed to a mental institution.

At 8:18 PM on April 15, 1968, ISIAH MacNEIL MARSH telephonically contacted the Columbia, South Carolina, Federal Bureau of Investigation Office and immediately began cursing and sounded as if he was under the influence of intoxicants. After talking incoherently for several minutes, this individual finally said he killed "KING" and that law enforcement agencies were stupid for not finding him. He said he would sign papers to this effect.

MARSH gave his home address as 1316 Bonner Avenue, Columbia, South Carolina, said he was unemployed and just robbed and stole. He said he robbed banks and stole cars and the last car he stole was April 13, 1968, at the "Dixie-Do" (phonetic), which car he sold for one thousand dollars profit.

During the telephonic conversation with MARSH, a woman's voice could be heard fussing in the background and MARSH said he only called so the FBI could get on his trail and he could prove they would be unable to catch him. During this conversation MARSH was very belligerent and continued using offensive language.

On April 16, 1968, Captain HARRY SNIPES, Columbia, South Carolina, Police Department, advised as follows:

He has twenty-nine arrests for ISIAH MacNEIL MARSH, a white male, born \_\_\_\_\_\_. This individual is described as five feet three inches tall and weighing

about eighty pounds. Captain Snipes said that the first arrest was on June 10, 1942, and his most recent arrest was on June 28, 1967.

He said these arrests consist of thirteen for disorderly conduct, one for housebreaking and larceny of an auto, one for forgery, one for resisting arrest, seven for being drunk, two for driving under the influence, three for drunk and disorderly conduct, and one for lunacy in 1962, which charge was dismissed and he was released.

Captain Snipes said that Marsh is well known to the Columbia, South Carolina, Police Department as a mentally ill person who is always calling up and admitting serious crimes which he did not commit. He said that Marsh is unable to hold employment due to his condition and that he usually calls this department when under the influence of intoxicants. He said that he would pay absolutely no attention to anything that Marsh related to him or the Columbia, South Carolina, Police Department as in all probability it was entirely false.

On April 16, 1968, Mrs. Gussie Marsh, 1316 Bonner Avenue, Columbia, South Carolina, advised as follows:

She resides at this address with her sons, Isiah MacNeil Marsh and Earnest Marsh. Earnest Marsh is retired from the United States Army, weighs about two hundred pounds, and owns the house at this address.

Isiah MacNeil Marsh was born is about five feet three inches tall, a white male, weighing about eighty pounds. When Isiah Marsh was about ten years old he was hit by an automobile and remained unconscious in a hospital for two weeks. Since then he has been under a doctor's care and always taken medicine to prevent epileptic seizures. He has absolutely no education, cannot read or write, and because of this is unable to hold a job very long. Mrs. Marsh said she is eighty-four years of age, has a heart condition, and that she is very concerned about Isiah Marsh because his

brother Earnest frequently beats on him for doing what he does.

She said that about 8:00 o'clock PM on April 15, 1968, Isiah Marsh was apparently drinking after taking strong tablets for his physical condition when she heard him talking over the telephone, apparently with the FBI at Columbia. She said that anything he said should be completely disregarded as he has not left Columbia, South Carolina, in years and she has been with him every night and day during the past month. She said he is not capable of robbing anything and that the "Dixie-Do" he referred to is actually a dog she owned at one time which Isiah was very fond of. She said that he has never been in a mental institution but that she is seriously considering having him committed to the South Carolina State Hospital. Marsh said that while Isiah was talking with the FBI she was fussing in the background, trying to get him to hang She said that he, in the past, has telephonically contacted the office of United States Senator Ernest F. Hollings in Washington, D. C., and left word for Senator Hollings to call him. She said that she discourages his doing such things but that he does them when she is not with him. She said that on one occasion someone from Senator Hollings' Office in Washington did return such a Mrs. Marsh said that she knows her son is emotionally disturbed and that "he always does these crazy things when he has a combination of beer or liquor with his tablets." She said that he is presently under the care of Dr. William Pitts, 1400 Barnwell Street, Columbia, South Carolina.

She described Isiah Marsh as follows:



Mrs. DAVID WILSON (EDNA), was contacted at the residence of her sister, Mrs. JOE HERNANDEZ, 2 Woodland Circle, Flagstaff, Arizona, and advised as follows:

She last heard from her husband, DAVID WILSON, on May 10, 1968, when he telephoned her from Grand Junction, Colorado, and told her he was coming home. In this conversation, her husband said he had been in recent contact with his employer at the Continental Body Shop in Phoenix, Arizona, and had been assured that he could resume his former job. He told her he would be reappearing in Flagstaff, the following weekend for the purpose of picking her and the children up for return to Phoenix with him.

Mrs. WILSON advised that, since that telephone call, she has not heard any more from her husband. She said he never reappeared in Phoenix as promised and never resumed his former job as far as she knows. She said she telephoned his employer, HARVEY WALD in Phoenix, and learned he had not been in contact with DAVID WILSON for, approximately three weeks. She said he had absolutely no idea where his present location is and she is worried and in need of support. She said she will definitely contact the FBI upon hearing any word of his whereabouts or upon having any further contact with him.

Mrs, WILSON advised that, in her May 10, 1968 conversation with her husband, he referred to the tape recording of an anonymous telephone caller taken by the Coconino County Sheriff's Office on April 19, 1968. She said that, in this reference, he made the statement, "it sure sounds a lot like me doesn't it?" She said they discussed this possibility and, during the conversation, he strongly implied that he knew it was his own voice on the tape. She said, however, he did not absolutely state that he made the telephone call in question.

Mr. Chuck Walker, 3993 Highway 51 South, Memphis, Tenn., telephonically contacted the Memphis Office stating that he had spoken with another agent on a number of occasions last week in regard to an individual whose actions he considered to be somewhat suspicious and who he thought might possibly be involved in the King killing.

He stated that he had previoustly furnished the name of a D.C. Newman Ito the FBI because Newman is his bookkeeper and had left town 2 or 3 days after King had been killed. When he left he took with himm some books and papers belonging to Walker and Walker felt this was suspicious behavior. Walker also stated that he has been reading the newspapers and recalls that Galt had worked on the Miss. river and advised that he believes that Newman had operated a tow boat on the river about 3 or 4 years ago for a Frank Galiardi.

Walker also stated that he thought it was suspicious that Newman told him that he did not have to file his tax returns this year until June 1. Walker stated that the other agent had asked him to call back if he should hear anything further about Newman. / Walker advised that Newman is back in town and that he has spoken with Newman's wife who said that they had been on a short vacation.

Walker stated that he is planning to speak with Newman in the near future concerning his business records and that if he learns anything that would be of interest to the FBI he will promptly contact us.
