MORRIS CARMEDELLE, Owner and Manager of the Canal Bank Inn has previously advised that **BILLINGS** resided in Apartment 6, 315 Laurossini St., Westwego, La., from May, to December, 1965, and this apartment was rented by **ENIS HEAD**. **CARMEDELLE** made no mention of the name **BEN BLACKWELL**, who is the individual with whom **BILLINGS** states he resided.

BILLINGS advised he was to take **BARBER** to Guy's International Bar to meet a man named **(FNU) FURIES**, or **FERRIES** (phonetic). It is felt that **(FNU) FURIES** or **FERRIES** is possibly identical with **DAVID FERRIN**, now deceased, who was a principal in **DA JAMES GARRISON**'s probe of the assassination of President **JOHN F. KENNEDY**.

In view of this information and **BILLINGS** past history of mental illness, New Orleans is conducting no further investigation concerning **CARLOS LEE BILLINGS**.

As the result of investigation previously conducted JUNE TAYLOR on May 24, 1968, voluntarily appeared at the Columbia, South Carolina Federal Bureau of Investigation Office and advised as follows:

She is presently NORMA JUNE SPELLMAN and her maiden name was JEFFCOAT. She has been married five times and is also known by the following names:

NORMA JUNE HUTCHINGS
NORMA JUNE EDWARDS
NORMA JUNE TAYLOR
NORMA JUNE CABEEN
NORMA JUNE SPELLMAN

She is presently employed as a waitress at the Starlight Lounge, Assembly Street. In early 1965 she was living at 2930 Chestnut Street, Columbia, South Carolina, with her friend, JOHNNIE BLACKWELL, who was then employed at The Lounge on Lady Street, Columbia, South Carolina. She was then employed at the Red Rooster, Columbia, South Carolina. During this period she, TAYLOR, met a white male known to her only as SONNY BILLINGS. BLACKWELL was then dating an individual who reportedly had just been discharged from the Army by the name of BARBER (First Name Unknown). BILLINGS lived at the above address with JUNE TAYLOR for about one or two weeks during which period she dated him four or five times. During this period BILLINGS and BARBER reportedly left Columbia, South Carolina in a red Chevrolet convertible which car belonged to BILLINGS. They reportedly went to New York or somewhere up North to take BARBER home and after several days BILLINGS returned alone to Columbia, South Carolina. BARBER only visited Columbia, South Carolina, on one occasion after this and she saw him at The Lounge in Columbia. SONNY BILLINGS after above mentioned trip, left Columbia, South Carolina, for six or eight months and returned for one weekend.

JUNE TAYLOR said that during this period she does not recall ever knowing two men by the name of JAMES and EDDIE and she could furnish absolutely no information concerning such individuals. She does not recall ever visiting a VFW Club in Columbia, South Carolina, with BARBER and BILLINGS and she could furnish no information concerning BARBER having sticks of marijuana in his possession. She does not recall ever knowing an individual who owned a 1964 or 1965 Continental and she could furnish no information whatsoever concerning the attempt to purchase a machine gun or a conspiracy to murder MARTIN LUTHER KING.

Photographs of JAMES EARL RAY were shown to her and she was unable to identify this person as anyone known to her.

She advised she and JOHNNIE BLACKWELL have never double-dated with BILLINGS and BARBER.

HIS CONDITION WAS CHARACTERIZED BY STRONG, UNCONTROLABLE TENDENCIES TOWARD REGRESSION AND FUROR ACTIONS, PATHOLOGICAL DEPENDENCIES ON HIS FAMILY AND WIFE, DEPRESSIVENESS, INTOLLERANCE TO ANXIETY AND PREDECINTRAPSYCHIE STRESS. HE WENT AWOL BECAUSE OF HIS OWN NERVOUSNESS AND BECAUSE OF EMOTIONAL DEMANDS BEING MADE ON HIM BY WIFE AND PARENTS. Mrs. DOROTHY MEYER, Ann Arbor Street, Saline, Michigan, was interviewed and furnished the following information:

A tape of an anonymous telephone call received by Deputy Sheriff RAY STOCK, Coconino County, Arizona Sheriff's Office on April 20, 1968, was played for Mrs. MEYERS. She was of the opinion that the first part of the tape wherein the anonymous caller was speaking of a "Spanish girl" sounded like her brother DAVID LINDSEY WILSON. She indicated that although the remainder of the tape sounds very much like her brother, DAVID WILSON, the anonymous caller used a number of words that she does not remember her brother using. For this reason she was unable to definitely ascertain if the anonymous telephone call was made by her brother DAVID WILSON.

On 4/26/68, Mrs. LENA FAUCETT, Rt. 1, P. O. Box 240, Clarksville, Va., advised SHEILEY JEAN BALDRIDGE is her daughter. She stated that to her knowledge SHEILEY JEAN has never traveled to Fla. at any time and she has never heard her mention an ERIC RAY or EARL RAY. She stated her daughter is having some marital difficulties with her husband, ELMERT BALDRIDGE. She said SHEILEY JEAN visited her in December, 1967, and left in January, 1968, to return to Texas but she has not heard from her since that time. She said she had no idea of her whereabouts until BALDRIDGE called her about 4/23/68 and told her he received a letter from SHEILEY JEAN postmarked Saltville, Va. Mrs. FAUCETT advised she has no people in Saltville, Va., and did not know why her daughter would be in that section of the state. Mrs. FAUCETT further advised that Sgt. BALDRIDGE told her not to worry about SHEILEY JEAN because he had the FBI and Red Cross looking for her and they would find her soon. DUMAINE, at which time he advised that the package of credit card slips mailed in by Mr. JONES on April 17, 1968, would already be in the Balance process, Accounting Department, and would take until at least April 30, 1968, to locate. He said it is possible that he would be able to locate the credit card slips mailed in on April 22, 1968. He requested that he be furnished with the Transmittal Slip number used by JONES in submitting the credit card transactions.

At Honolulu, Hawaii

On April 26, 1968, RICHARD TOM, Office of Superintendent, Honolulu Rapid Transit (HRT), advised as follows:

On the morning of April 6, 1968, there would have been seven regular drivers assigned to the School-Middle Street route. TOM explained that he would cause the records of HRT to be checked that evening to determine the identities of the regular drivers assigned to that route on April 6, 1968, and he believed that all of them could be contacted the following day as they came off duty from 12:45 to 1:15 p.m. TOM also stated that he would post wanted flyers on subject where they could be observed by all drivers.

Concerning the description of the vicinity where suspect was alleged to have departed from the bus, TOM pointed out that this would undoubtedly refer to the intersection of Lanakila and School Streets. Maluhia Hospital can be seen from the bus at this site. However, there is an extensive housing area in the vicinity.

On the same date, Mrs. QUEEN VIEJERA and STAN MATSUNAGA were contacted at the front office of Maluhia Hospital. They viewed a wanted flyer of subject with negative results. They stated the flyer would be posted at the time clock for all employees to observe. MATSUNAGA stated that the visiting hours at the hospital are normally from 12:00 noon to 8:00 p.m. However, on April 6, 1968, a Saturday, Mrs. LUCILLE MC GUIRE was the only employee on duty at the front desk. MATSUNAGA related that subject could not have been an employee at the hospital inasmuch as this is a city hospital and there is an extended residence employment requirement.

On April 27, 1968, Mrs. LUCILLE MC GUIRE was contacted at Maluhia Hospital and reported she had observed no one answering the description of suspect.
