JONES, Pure Oil Company Dealer, Americus, Georgia, advised he sold gas to an individual on April 16, 1968, who closely resembled 1968 photo of JAMES EARL RAY. Mr. JONES described the car he believed the person to be driving as well as furnishing a physical description of this individual. He also stated that he believed the individual purchased gas on a temporary Pure Oil Credit Card, which he believes expires in August or September, 1968. He also advised that the credit card slips were purchases on April 16, 1968, and had already been forwarded to the Pure Oil Company Retail Department, Palatine, Illinois.

On April 26, 1968, Mr. CLYDE E. PHODES, Accounting Department, Pure Oil Company, Palatime, Illinois, was telephonically contacted by SA RENE J. DUNAINE, at which time he advised that the package of credit card slips mailed in by Mr. JONES on April 17, 1968, would already be in the Balance process, Accounting Department, and would take until ****least April 30, 1968, to locate. He said it is possible that he would be able to locate the credit card slips mailed in on April 22, 1968. He requested that he be furnished with the Transmittal Slip number used by JONES in submitting the credit card transactions.

On the same date, Mr. RHODES was furnished with the following transmittal numbers:

The foregoing were obtained from the Atlanta Division in contact with Mr. R. B. JONES. Mr. RHODES advised that he had located all of the credit card slips submitted on April 22, 1968. A review of these slips did not reveal any

In a continuing review of Pure Oil Company records, in conjunction with Mr. RHODES and THOMAS DAVINI by SA ROBERT F. PEVAHOUSE on April 29 and 30, 1968, located the list of credit card invoices submitted by Mr. JONES on April 18, 1968. Credit card purchase number 0882579109 was made by Lt. Col. WILKERSON, however, the invoice itself could not be located and the address was not yet in file. The charge for credit card number is another company credit card and the ticket has already been separated elsewhere. No further effort will be made to locate this card in view of the comments made by Mr. JONES. It should be noted that this review did not reveal any purchase made on a temporary Pure Oil Credit Card.

The following anonymous letter was received in an envelope postmarked Hartford, Connecticut, April 20, 1938, addressed to Federal Bureau of Investigation, FBI, 450 Main, Hartford, Connecticut.

"On the morning of April 6th, Saturday, I boarded a 2R School-Middle Bus on Kalakaua Ave in Waikiki, Honolulu for the Bishop Museum, on Kalihi Street. About four or five blocks before that a young girl got on, sat down, began asking questions of the Bus driver. Suddenly I heard mutterings from a man across the aisle from me (who was working a cross-word puzzle) I looked over, he smiled a sort of silly smile of disgust, shook his head at the girl, obviously thought her questions of the driver ridiculous. I looked again at his profile thinking how very much he looked like the drawing of a man, I had seen in the morning paper, who was being sought as a suspect for the murder of Dr Martin Luther King. I stared at the contour of the face--a rather long nose (not as full a face as the picture I have since seen). I only saw the profile which certainly resembled the Artist's drawing. He turned to see me staring, folded his paper and left the Bus. I watched him walk up the hill to the right of the Main Street (may have been King Street we were on) There seemed to be some large bldgs. up on the hill--perhaps a Hospital?

"This has worried me ever since-so here it is for what it may be worth to you. The possibility of a hunt in Hawaii which I pray does not prove to be false."

At Honolulu, Hawaii

On April 26, 1965, RICHARD TOM, Office of Superintendent, Honolulu Rapid Transit (HRT), advised as follows:

On the morning of April 6, 1968, there would have been seven regular drivers assigned to the School-Middle Street route. TOM explained that he would cause the records of HRT to be checked that evening to determine the identities of the regular drivers assigned to that route on April 6, 1968, and he believed that all of them could be contacted the following day as they came off duty from 12:45 to 1:15 p.m. TOM also stated that he would post wanted flyers on subject where they could be observed by all drivers.

Concerning the description of the vicinity where suspect was alleged to have departed from the bus, TOM pointed out that this would undoubtedly refer to the intersection of Lanakila and School Streets. Malukia Hospital can be seen from the bus at this site. However, there is an extensive housing area in the vicinity.

On the same date, Mrs. QUEEN VIEIERA and STAN MATSUNAGA were contacted at the front office of Maluhia Hospital. They viewed a wanted flyer of subject with negative results. They stated the flyer would be posted at the time clock for all employees to observe. MATSUNAGA stated that the visiting hours at the hospital are normally from 12:00 noon to 6:00 p.m. However, on April 6, 1968, a Saturday, Mrs. LUCILLE MC GUIRE was the only employee on duty at the front desk. MATSUNAGA related that subject could not have been an employee at the hospital inasmuch as this is a city hospital and there is an extended residence employment requirement.

On April 27, 1968, Mrs. LUCILLE MC GUIRE was contacted at Maluhia Hospital and reported she had observed no one answering the description of suspect.
