On 4/24/68, Mrs. JOHN HARVEY, Manager, Biscayne Apartments, 3211 South Vernon, advised that VICK PARKER, who had been renting Apartment 108, was evicted on 4/22/68. She advised he moved in on 12/1/67, with JERRY FREELAND, whose mother HELEN FREELAND lives in Dallas. Neither PARKER nor FREELAND left a forwarding address when evicted. HARVEY was shown an Identification Order concerning RAY and advised there was no similarity whatsoever between either FREELAND or PARKER and RAY. She advised both boys are about 20-22 years old.

On 4/24/68, LINDA FREELAND, 607 North Franklin, Apartment 201, telephone WH 6-9246, advised her brother is JERRY FREELAND and JERRY, who was recently evicted from an apartment on Vernon Street, has come to live with her and their mother. She advised upon seeing a photograph of subject RAY and an Identification Order, that she knew of no one identical to that photograph. She advised she would have her brother get in contact with the FBI as soon as possible.

On 4/24/68, JERRY FREELAND telephonically advised he had viewed the photographs of RAY and the Identification Order and knows of no one that could be identical to RAY. He advised he knows VICK PARKER's friends fairly well, having lived with PARKER for several months, and does not think any one of them resembles RAY. When advised of the circumstances under which the individual was seen by an anonymous caller driving the car PARKER rented, FREELAND stated he thought it was possible that someone viewing PARKER from a distance and not getting a real good look at PARKER could find a slight resemblance between PARKER and the photograph of RAY.
