

TINDLE, BAILEY SANDLIN, Insurance Adjuster, 1906 West Colonial Drive, Orlande, Florida, telephonically advised SA VILLES on 4/25/68 that at approximately 8:55 a.m., 4/25/68, he drave up in front of his office and noticed a man sitting in a 1967 or 1968 dark blue, 4-door Chevrolet. He stated the only numbers of the Florida tag he could recall were 7%-15 with rest of numbers unknown and he could not recall how many digits were in the tag number. He advised the Chevrolet was parked in the carport at his office. He said the man who resembled JAMES EARL RAY, pointed a sambnoged revolver at him, and said, "You sin't seen me" and drove east on Colonial Drive to the next street (Vern Drive) where he turned right. It was noted by SA VILEES during the telephone call from SANDLIN that his voice had been unusually hesitant between words and sentences, however, at the time it was believed to be due to excitement.

J. R. SMITH, Detective Bureau, Grlands, Florida Police Department, was immediately informed of the above by SA JAMES B. HAVLEY.

Upon arriving at 1906 West Colonial Drive, BAILEY SEEDLIN was interviewed in person by SAs TINDLE and WILES. As the interview progressed, it became evident through SANDLIN'S behavior and by his own admission that he was under the influence of liquer. He stated that he was an alcoholic and that during the merning of April 24, 1968, his girlfriend, CHARLOTTE HCDANIEL had tried to commit suicide in his apartment at 77 East Amelia, Orlande, Florida. SANDLIN asserted he became upset at this and had been drinking beer and Vodka from the merning of April 24, 1968 through the time the agents contacted him in person.

Every effort was made to ascertain if there was any truth in SANDLIN'S statements, however, he continually changed his description of the suspect and varied the sequence of events as well as the times they were alleged to have occurred.

On April 25, 1968, Mrs. ANN WAGNER,
1904 West Colonial Brive, and Mrs. ALFRED PENKACIK,
1919 West Colonial, who are located immediately
adjacent to SANDLIN'S effice advised that from at least
8500 a.m. until they were contacted by the agents ther

On April 25, 1968, Mrs. MARGARET TAYLOR, widow of Deputy Sheriff PHILIP TAYLOR, 1113 Santa Anita, advised agents she is the secretary to SAMBLIN and that she had received a call from him that morning. She stated he sounded very unusual and she wendered if he had been drinking. She asserted that MANDLIN had previously told her he was an alcoholic and was active in alcoholics amenymous. He has also told her that when he drinks, he has hallucinations thinking he has achieved great success. Mrs. TAYLOR further stated that SANDLIN told her during his phone call that morning that when he arrived at his effice he had been accested by a man in a car in the carport of his office who stuck a gum in his face, According to SANDLIN, this had caused him to be upset.

Mrs. TAYLOR also declared that she talked with the landlord and occupants of the other half of the building, in which MANDLIN'S office is located and Mrs. WILLIAM MURRELL, 1904 West Colonial Drive had advised her that she had arrived at the office at the same time as Shankla and there was no car in the carport at that time. During the afternoon of April 25, 1968, ROMALD E. MEIGLER, Miegler and Associates, Insurance Adjustors, Baland, Florida, telephonically advised SA VILKES he was MANDLIN'S employer. He stated he had gone to MARDLIN'S office a short time previous that same day, in asswer to a phone call from Mrs. TAYLOR where he found SAMPLIN passed out due to drunkedness. He stated be closed the office, took SARBLIN home and put him to bed.

JAMES FULLER, Detective Sergeant, Orlando PD was apprised of the above.

About mid-morning, April 25, 1968, BAILEY SANDLIN, 1906 West Colonial Brive, Orlando, Florida, telephonically advised SA ROBERT C. BALL at the Orlando Resident Agency that he had previously telephoned the Orlando Residence Agency on the same morning and he had been contacted by two agents whose names he could not recall. He related he was recontacting the resident agency since the individual whom he had talked with the previous time had telephoned him and threatened him.

SA RALL contacted the Orlando PD and was met at 1906 West Colonial Brive by Sergeant STRAUB of the Orlando PD and during a short conversation with SANBLIN he stated he was fearful of his life since the previous described individual had threatened to return to his office and to kill him.

Buring the conversation with SANDLIN it was obvious to SA BALL that SANDLIN had been drinking and such opinion was confirmed by Morgoant STRAUB. SANDLIN was shown the identification order for JAMES HARL RAY and stated that the individual depicted thereon rescubled the individual who had threatened him earlier that same day. Due to the obvious intexicated condition of SANDLIN, no further attempt was made to interview him.

Due to the above not forth facts, no further action has been taken.

On 4/26/68, Mrs. JACQUELINE HOFFMAN, Travelodge Motel, W. Tennessee Street, located next door to Dobbs House Restaurant, was exhibited WF #442-A and advised that she had previously observed a photograph of RAY in the local newspaper and to the best of her knowledge no one meeting his description or appearing similar to him has ever stayed at that motel. She advised that all of her maids are aware of his status and she knows they have observed his photograph as he has been discussed amongst the employees at the motel and anyone meeting that description or appearing similar to RAY would have been reported to the FBI and/or local authorities.

It is to be noted that this is a business area and the complete block of this area is individual stores and businesses. The time related in re airtel of approximately midnight or after, would have meant that all of the stores and businesses in the area, with the exception of the Dobbs House and the Travelodge Motel, would have been closed as these are the only two business establishments in the area open after midnight. However, on 4/26/68, WF #442-A was exhibited to employees of numerous businesses in the area without effecting any identification or obtaining any additional information.
