Re San Francisco teletype, dated 6/5/68, and report of SA JOE C. HESTER, dated 6/5/68, at Memphis.

Enclosed for the Bureau are three copies of an FD-892, dated June 7, 1968, reflecting the results of interview of ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL. Two copies each of this FD-302 are enclosed for Kansas City, Memphis, and New Orleans.

Observations of the San Francisco Office Relative to the Interview of ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL

ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL was interviewed during the morning of June 4, 1968, and the interview was continued after a break for lunch. During this entire interview, RUSSELL rambled, was vague, incoherent, inconsistent, and evasive. The entire impression created was that RUSSELL was looking for attention. It is believed that he was not truthful at all times in that any knowledge that he has concerning JAMES EARL RAY could have easily been obtained by reading newspapers and could be spiced by his knowledge of New Orleans where he was arrested in 1967. RUSSELL stated that he knows he has lied on

many occasions, but he was telling the truth now. His story would vary from time to time.

By teletype dated June 6, 1968, the Philadelphia, New York, and Newark Offices were advised that ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL had furnished those offices with inaccurate and unreliable information.

San Francisco does not contemplate a reinterview of RUSSELL at this time unless directed to do so by the Bureau, Memphis, or Kansas City.

New Orleans is being furnished copies of this communication; however, no lead is being set out for New Orleans to conduct specific investigation. It is noted that New Orleans conducted an 88 investigation regarding ROBERT LAWRENCE RUSSELL during 1967 at which time he was using the names JAMES ALEXANDER, and ROBERT LAWRENCE.

On 5/21/68, Mrs. ANN JACOBSON, 434 Robb Avenue, Johnstown, Pa., advised SAR FARL W. CALLOWAY and JOHN S. BUICKES that for the past three weeks she has been doing of donestic work for a DONALD SHAFFEP and a Mrs. NFLEN STANCE, at 446 Somerset Street, Johnstown, Fa. She explained that SHAFFEP and STANCE are not married, but are living together; that SHAFFEP is a local contractor and that he has several employees working for him who meet at the residence of 446 Somerset Street, each morning prior to going out on a particular contracting job.

Mrs. JACOPSON initially denied making any statement to anvone that the "killer of MAPTIN LUTHER KING" was in any way connected with SHAPPER or his contracting group. She then advised that she might have made a statement that SHAPPER could be the killer of MAPTIN LUTHER KING inasmuch as he drinks excessively and has made statements that he could see nothing wrong with KING's assassination. Mrs. JACORSON stated that all of SHAPPER's worker are in their late teens or early 20's; that none of them look like JAMES EARL PAY, but that SHAPPER bears some slight resemblance to the subject.

On 5/22/58, Detective HAPOLD BEPKEYBILE, Police Department, Johnstown, Pa., advised that he is personally acquainted with SHAPPEP; that SHAPPEP has been a fly-by-night contractor in Johnstown for many years; that one of SHAPPEP's employees is his brother, JOSEPH, and that SHAPPEP could not in any way be identical to JAMES HAPL PAY.

SMITH explained the envelopes subscriptions are received in are destroyed. He said the ad of RAY's was published in the December, 1967, issue of Select Magazine.

SMITH said the last issue of Select Magazine mailed to its subscribers occurred on 4/12/68. SMITH said RAY was sent a copy of this issue which apparently was not returned to Select Associates.

The following interviews were conducted at Washington, D. C., on April 8, 1968, by Special Agents JOSEPH C. KELLY and SIDNEY H. ROCHE:

Dr. DAVID MARK ROSENBAUM, Expert, National Resources Analysis Center, Systems Evaluation Division, Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation building, 550 17th Street, Northwest, advised that he is acquainted with one RUSSELL YOUNG, Executive Assistant to the Vice President, Government Communications Division, American Telephone and Telegraph Company, and while in company with Mr. YOUNG sometime during the first, several days of April, 1968, YOUNG remarked to ROSENBAUM that Reverend MARTIN LUTHER KING was possibly going to be killed in Memphis, Tennessee.

Dr. ROSENBAUM said that since the statement had been proven true, in as much as Dr. KING was killed, he felt that he should notify the Federal Bureau of Investigation of this information. He added that he could not suggest the source of MOUNG's information, and that he intended to call Mr. YOUNG and advise him that he had furnished the information to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Mr. WILLIAM RUSSELL YOUNG, Executive Assistant to the Vice President, Government Communications Division, American Telephone and Telephone Corporation, Room 1104, 1730 K Street, Morthwest, telephone 392-5196, stated that he commented earlier in the north of April, 1968, while in the presence of one Dg. DIVID ROSENBAUM, that in view of the feelings and opinious expressed by the Reverend MORTIN LUTHER KING, he predicted that someone would kill

KING at sometime or another. Mr. YOUNG said that it was merely a premonition on his part and he has never heard any information which might lead him to believe that a conspiracy was involved in this killing, nor did YOUNG have the slightest idea when or by whom the murder would take place.

Mr. KENNETH FEWELL, Superinterdent, Friendship Station, United States Post Office Department, 4005 Wisconsin Avenue, Northwest, advised that his records revealed that JIMMY ROGER THOMPSON is employed at this station as a clerk-carrier and that according to employment records THOMPSON was on duty at this location on April 3, 1968, and April 4, 1968, at which time he was due to finish work at 2:00 P.M. on April 4, 1968. He was off April 5, April 6, and April 7, 1968, and reported back to work at 5:30 A.M. on April 8, 1968. Mr. FEWELL stated that he has known THOMPSON as an employee at this location and knows that he has relatives in Chuckey, Tennessee, located near Bristol, Tennessee, and has been known to visit than upon occasion.

Mr. FEMELL described THOMPSON as a white male, about twenty-five years of age, about 210 pounds, five feet ten inches to five feet eleven inches tall, blonde hair, stocky build, characteristics, walks like a small town, country boy and is a sloppy dresser.
