On 5/3/68, Mr. GEORGE W. CRAWFORD, Custodian at the Rossville High School, advised that he resides at 808 Indian Avenue in Rossville, Ga., and has for the past 25 years. He said he knows no one named LEWIS SHEPPARD, JR. advised he has never owned a 1953 Chrysler and stated that he knows of no one named SHEPPARD who has resided in that neighborhood.

On the same date, GBI Agent PAUL GRIFFIN, who resides at 801 Indian Avenue, advised that he has never known anyone named SHEPPARD residing in that neighborhood.

On 5/3/68, the records of the Chattanooga, Tenn. PD as searched by Clerk KAREN HANNAH, revealed the only record identifiable with a LEWIS SHEPPARD reflects that a LEWIS SHEPPARD, Negro male, was arrested 3/24/68, as a passenger in a 1962 Chevrolet convertible, blue, wherein the driver of the vehicle was arrested for DUI. MARGIE CURTIS, 1838 Dunlap Avenue, East Point, Georgia, employed by National Car Rental, Atlanta, Georgia, advised on 5/17/68, she was the individual who rented the 1968 Dodge Dart to S. M. SCHNEIDERMAN on 4/2/68. She described SCHNEIDERMAN as being in his late 30s or early 40s, approximately 5' 7' 8" tall, of small build, weighing approximately 140-145, with dark hair, possibly black. She viewed a photograph of JAMES EARL RAY, and stated from her recollection, did not believe RAY identical to SCHNEIDERMAN, however, photograph of RAY, particularly the hair, did resemble SCHNEIDERMAN.

SCHNEIDERMAN appeared at the National Car Rental Office at the Atlanta Airport at approximately 9:42 am, wearing a business suit and presented 3 Millionaire Club credit cards, 2 in plastic covering, and 1 plain paper card, all in the name of S. SCHNEIDERMAN. She could not recall if SCHNEIDERMAN had luggage, and stated she was sure that he was not accompanied by anyone. She stated she obtained the DL # from SCHNEIDERMAN's Illinois DL, and also listed the Holiday Inn at the Atlanta Airport as SCHNEIDERMAN's place of contact.
