TINKER, 2261 Rolling Green Road, Saginaw, Michigan, occupied Room 118 from 12/18/67 through 12/23/67, and that Mr. and Mrs. E. S. KNUTH, 514 Ebony, Duluth, Minnesota, occupied Room 112 on 12/17/67. Investigation at Duluth, Minnesota, indicated Mr. and Mrs. KNUTH moved to 110 North 13th Street, Escanaba, Michigan. Mr. and Mrs. KNUTH and Mr. and Mrs. TINKER advised they did not see anyone resembling JAMES EARL RAY while staying at the Provincial Motel, New Orleans, Louisiana, during 12/67.

DETAILS:

This investigation was predicated upon receipt of information from the New Orleans Office of the FBI that Mr. and Mrs. W. G. TINKER, 2261 Rolling Green Road, Saginaw, Michigan, had registered on December 18, 1967, at the Provincial Motel, 1024 Chartres Street, New Orleans, Louisiana.

On May 10, 1968, the Minneapolis Office of the FBI advised that Mr. and Mrs. E. S. KNUTH, 514 Ebony, Duluth, Minnesota, were registered in Room 112 of the Provincial Motel, New Orleans, Louisiana, on December 17, 1967, and are currently residing at 110 North 13th Street, Escanaba, Michigan.

Mr. and Mrs. EDWIN S. KNUTH, Post Office Box 172, Route One, Escanaba, Michigan, were contacted by SA HARRIS J. MILLER on May 16, 1968. Photographs of JAMES EARL RAY were shown to Mr. and Mrs. KNUTH, and they advised that they could not identify this person as anyone they had seen during their stay at the Provincial Motel, New Orleans, while there in December, 1967. Mr. KNUTH advised that they had arrived at this motel while on their honeymoon about 5:00 p.m. on December 17, 1967, and departed this motel at about 7:00 a.m. on December 19, 1967. Mr. KNUTH advised that he is émployed by Williams Brothers Engineering Company, 110 North 13th Street, Escanaba, Michigan.

Following negative attempts to contact Mr. and Mrs. W. G. TINKER on May 14 and 17, 1968, they were interviewed at their residence on May 20, 1968, by SA GEORGE M. KUKER and were shown various photographs of JAMES EARL RAY. Both Mr. and Mrs. TINKER advised that they did not recall seeing anyone resembling RAY while they were guests at the Provincial Motel, New Orleans, Louisiana, from December 18, 1967, through December 23, 1967.

On April 16, 1968, Mrs. LORRAINE MARTIN, Secretary, FUTURA BOOKS, INC., 21839 South Avalon Boulevard, Torrance, California 90502, telephone 830-7903 furnished the following information:

This concern receives a large volume of mail daily, upon its receipt, it is dated, the orders are filled that day and either sent out that night or the following morning. They do not keep an index of individuals ordering their material. The money orders are set out by their numbers and amounts on one bank deposit sheet with a carbon copy being retained by the date of the deposit. This same procedure is followed in recording of checks. Names are not used.

Both Mrs. LORRAINE MARTIN and another office assistant were reductant to furnish any information at first in view of the fact they thought someone had made a complaint to the Federal Government about their not filling an order. Mrs. MARTIN did not furnish her name until the conclusion of the interview and the other employee would not furnish her name. Both stated that they recognized the name of ERIC GALT from having read it recently in the local newspapers.

Mrs. MARTIN stated that unless she had a date that the order arrived, or an approximate date, she would be unable to locate this account.

Mrs. MARTIN, in checking her money order bank deposit carbon copy records located money order 0799 1943011 the amount of \$6.44 which was received on February 27, 1968. She thereafter located in the February 27, 1968 "Orders Filled" folder an Order Blank which had been dated February 27, 1968 from:

The Order Blank is one which is furnished in a brochure and Mrs. MARTIN advised was probably torn from such a brochure. She advised that he either called or sent a letter for such a brochure or possibly obtained same from a friend. She would have no record of such a request for the brochure. Mrs. MARTIN furnished a sample brochure which has the same Order Blank in it.

Mrs. MARTIN pointed out that the Order Blank of ERIC S. GALT is for the book entitled:

THE SEXUALLY RESPONSIVE WOMAN \$5.95
(Special Handling Charge) .25
California Sales Tax .24
\$6.44

Mrs. MARTIN stated that the inked date of "February 27, 1968" is placed there by one of their employees when the order is received. The individual handling the order, using a red felt writing instrument, placed the letters of "S H" in the upper right corner of the Order Blank which means "Special Handling". Further, this same employee underlines the name of the book order and then places a large check mark through it to reflect that the order was filled with that book. The employee then places an initial to reflect the identity of the person filling the order. This order bearing the initial of "O" was filled by:

ORTRUD RIEDEL

The amount, in red of \$6.44 reflects that is the amount received with the order.

Mrs. MARTIN stated that no one places a signature on the Order Blank and the signature at the bottom of this Order Blank must have been placed there by the person using the Order Blank.

Mrs. MARTIN made a Xerox copy, for her files, of the Order Blank, turning the original copy over to the Interviewing Agent. The Interviewing Agent furnished a handwritten receipt on the back of the Xerox Copy for this document. LA 1/4-1574

Mrs. MARTIN said that the person to issue a subpoena to in order to identify their records would either be GORDON W. SCHINDLER or MAUREEN MUSFELT.

It was noted that an emergency telephone number was set forth on the wall of this office for SCHINDLER as 672-3946.

As to the type or contents of this book which had been ordered, Mrs. MARTIN furnished a sample brochure, which also contains a similar order blank, which sets forth the following description of the book:

"THE SEXUALLY RESPONSIVE WOMAN"

"The latest book by the Doctors Phyllis and Eberhard Kronhausen. Here is a book devoted exclusively to the feminine side of sexuality. An especially valuable volume for husbands seeking a fuller insight into women's thoughts on sex. It is clear that many women will discuss the subject in more detail with scientists than with their husbands.

"Here we have wives confessing their greatest conquests---before and after marriage---as well as their greatest disappointments; descriptions of how the orgasm feels, favorite coital positions (as well as the problems encountered with others); varied methods of satisfying husbands; first sexual experiences; pre-marital adventures; extra-marital escapades; miscegenation (confessions which bring some surprises from black men and white women copulating);

"Experiences with a multitude of lovers (as well as experiences with various-sized penes); preference during fore-play and coitus; various means of achieving orgasm; masturbation; thoughts on the use of artificial penes; lesbian activities; sex practices of over-sexed wives (as well as reactions of husbands); varieties of oral sex technic (including wives who desire such activities);

ADMINISTRATIVE

Racial, Security, and Criminal Informants and Sources were contacted regarding JAMES EARL RAY. None of these Informants and Sources were acquainted with RAY, nor did they have any information regarding him. The identities of the informants and sources contacted are recorded in the El Paso file.

In regard to telephone calls made by subject RAY in December, 1967, while en route from Los Angeles, California, to New Orleans, Louisiana, the El Paso Office checked out more than 115 telephone calls made to individuals residing in the El Paso Division which had originated from telephone booths and pay stations along the route in question during the pertinent period. None of these individuals contacted were acquainted with JAMES EARL RAY. None of them had any information regarding RAY. This information is not being included in the body of the report in view of the fact that the information regarding the telephone calls in question was obtained from the confidential records of various telephone companies.

In regard to telephone calls made from telephone booths at the St. Francis Hotel, Los Angeles, California, one such call was received at the Del Camino Motel in El Paso. The identity of the recipient of the telephone call was not determined. This information is not being included in the body of the report in view of the confidential nature of records of the telephone company.

In those instances where information was received by the El Paso Office regarding suspects and it was subsequently determined that the suspects were not identical with JAMES EARL RAY, such information has not been included in the body of this report.

It is noted that the El Paso Office has no known bombing suspects in its division.

In connection with the checks made under the names HARRY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER and ERIC STARVO GALT, the San Antonio Office advised by teletype dated 4/9/68 that it would cover state-wide checks for the Selective Service System, Texas Department of Public Safety (Identification Division and Drivers License Records).

The additional inquiries made in an effort to locate Mrs. RUTH RETZOLKA, Route 80, Clint, Texas, as noted on Page 37, were contacts on 4/11/68 with Mrs. FERN C. FIELDS, U.S. Post Office, Clint, Texas, and Mrs. BERNICE CORNWALL, U.S. Post Office, Fabens, Texas, (protect identities) neither of whom had any information regarding Mrs. RETZOLKA.

The identities of the persons contacted in connection with the checks regarding HARRY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER and ERIC STARVO GALT are maintained in the El Paso Office file and were not included in the body of this report.

El Paso teletype to the Director, Dallas, and Los Angeles (air mail copy to Memphis) dated 5/23/68 set out the following information:

Mrs. NORMA KIRKPATRICK (protect identity) 1007 West Griffin Street, Midland, Texas, advised SA PAUL D. SJODAL on 5/23/68 that when she boarded the Greyhound bus at Tulsa, Oklahoma, on 5/22/68, a white male whom she described to be age 35 to 38, 6', 185 to 190 pounds, who had small brown speck marks on face, slightly slanted eyes and mouth, $1\frac{1}{2}$ " V-shaped scar on back of head, brown crew-cut hair, brown eyes, wearing old brown suit, brown knit sweater, dark blue sport shirt, was sitting in the aisle seat about

C COVER PAGE two thirds of the way back in the bus on the left side as one walks to the rear. Mrs. KIRKPATRICK stated that about one hour en route from Tulsa to Dallas this individual made the remark in a loud manner so that the other bus passengers could hear, "I killed one man. I am wanted in 48 states, but they will never catch me. I'll tell you about MARTIN LUTHER KING. There are 20 of us in on that. We are in law enforcement and who would suspect us?" This individual stated "I am going back to old L.A." He also discussed presidential history.

Mrs. KIRKPATRICK stated this individual left the bus at Dallas and boarded a Greyhound bus at Dallas at about 11:10 p.m., 5/22/68. Mrs. KIRKPATRICK knew no other individuals on the bus from Tulsa to Dallas. She stated that the photograph on the Wanted Flyer on JAMES EARL RAY was definitely not identical with the individual on the bus.

Leads were set out for the Dallas and Los Angeles Offices in the above-mentioned teletype.
