DRIBINSKY DESCRIBED UNKNOWN MALE AS WHITE, AROUND THIRTY, FIVE FEET EIGHT, ONE SEVENTY POUNDS, STOCKY BUILD, FAIR COMPLEXION, LIGHT BROWN HAIR, NEED OF HAIR CUT, GROWING NEW MOUSTACHE, RAGGED IN APPEARANCE AND HAD NO SUIT CASE OR OTHER TYPE OF BELONGINGS.

DRIBINSKY STATES WENT BACK TO SLEEP AND LATER HEARD AIRPORT CAB DRIVER TELL RONALD AND GARY HIS FARE, ASSUMED TO BE UNKNOWN MALE, RESEMBLED MAN WANTED BY FBI. AS A RESULT DRIBINSKY THINKS GARY CALLED FBI FROM AIRPORT.

R. E. ROSE, Brigadier General, Salvation Army, 130 N. Lauderdale, Memphis, Tennessee, contacted 4/19/68, and furnished the following information regarding ERNEST SUMPTER GAULT.

ROSE advised that GAULT stayed at the Salvation Army November, 1965, for approximately 2 weeks, to December 10, 1965. According to GAULT's record at the Salvation Army, he said he worked for the Michigan Tug Boat Company, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, had a 9th grade education, was in the U. S. Navy, no year given, and was of the Protestant faith.

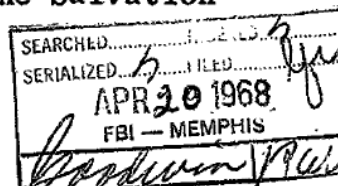
Records further revealed GAULT listed 20 years experience as a truck driver and file listed his Veterans Administration claim number [REDACTED], regional office, Nashville, Tennessee.

It is noted that according to FBI press release for 1968, JAMES EARL RAY was allegedly in the Missouri State Penitentiary at Jefferson City, Missouri, at the time that ERNEST SUMPTER GAULT apparently registered at the Salvation Army.

In view of the fact that it appears RAY was incarcerated, it is highly unlikely that this individual, ERNEST SUMPTER GAULT, is identical with JAMES EARL RAY, and therefore, no leads are being set forth in this matter.

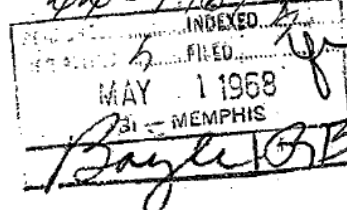
