MR. GEORGE J. BRADLEY, OFFICIAL, REICHHOLD CHEMICAL CO., ADVISED TUSCALOOSA RESIDENT AGENT THAT ON A. REMYCAB APRIL TWO FIVE INSTANT.

RE PAUL VARNER LINDHARD:

LINDHARD LOCATED AT MAZATLAN, SINALOA, APRIL TWO FIVE INSTANT AND INTERVIEWED DIRECTLY. HE RECALLED HITCHHIKER PICKED UP HIGHWAY, MEXICALI, BAJA CALIFORNIA, ABOUT NINE PM, APRIL ONE EIGHT LAST, AND SAID THIS INDIVIDUAL "COULD BE" THE SUBJECT. SUSPECT PICKED UP AT TOLL STATION WHERE EMPLOYEE TOLD LINDHARD THAT SUSPECT WANTED TO GO INTO MEXICO BUT SPOKE NO SPANISH AND ASKED WHETHER LINDHARD WOULD GIVE HIM A RIDE.

LINDHARD SAID HE AGREED, AND THEY ARRIVED AT CHECK POINT AT SONOYTA, SONORA, BETWEEN ONE ONE PM AND MIDNIGHT ON APRIL ONE EIGHT LAST AND THAT MEXICAN IMMIGRATION OFFICERS ON DUTY WOULD NOT GIVE SUSPECT A TOURIST CARD BECAUSE HE HAD NO MONEY AND LACKED PROPER DOCUMENTS TO ESTABLISH UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP. SUSPECT TRIED TO BRIBE OFFICERS BY OFFERING HIS WRIST WATCH, BUT OFFER REFUSED.

OFFICERS DID TELL LINDHARD IN SPANISH THAT SUSPECT COULD "GO UNDER THE FENCE" AND POINTED TO NEARBY ARROYO WHERE THIS COULD BE DONE. LINDHARD RELAYED THIS INFORMATION TO SUSPECT BUT DOES NOT KNOW WHETHER HE ACTED UPON IT.

LINDHARD SAID SUSPECT CARRIED MEDIUM SIZE SUITCASE BELIEVED TO BE BLUE IN COLOR AND A TWELVE STRING GUITAR. HE SAID HIS NAME WAS "CLIFF" BUT NO OTHER NAMES WERE EXCHANGED. HE WAS ABOUT FIVE FEET EIGHT OR NINE INCHES TALL, CLAIMED TO BE THREE FIVE YEARS OLD, BROWN HAIR, BLUE EYES, FAIRLY WELL DRESSED WITH A BLUE "DINNER JACKET" AND BOW TIE AND WAS WEARING A MADRAS HAT WITH RIM PULLED DOWN.

LINDHARD SAID SUSPECT DURING ENTIRE TRIP APPEARED TO BE "DOPEY" AND TOLD LINDHARD HE HAD BEEN SHOT IN HEAD BY WIFE WITH A SHOTGUN AND, AS RESULT, HAD FORGOTTEN HOW TO READ AND WRITE AND WAS JUST LEARNING TO SPEAK AGAIN. HE SAID HE HAD BEEN BEATEN AND ROBBED IN TIJUANA, BAJA CALIFORNIA, AND HAD NO MONEY. UPON ARRIVAL AT SONOYTA, LINDHARD HAD BETTER OPPORTUNITY TO OBSERVE SUSPECT AND SAW A SCAR ON RIGHT SIDE OF FOREHEAD ABOUT HALF WAY BETWEEN CENTER OF FOREHEAD AND RIGHT EAR. THIS SCAR WAS A ROUND SCAR APPROXIMATELY ONE

INCH IN DIAMETER AND STRADDLED THE HAIRLINE WITH MORE OF THE SCAR FALLING INSIDE THE HAIRLINE THAN OUTSIDE. LINDHARD SAW NO OTHER SCARS.

SUSPECT CLAIMED TO BE FROM MICHIGAN AND TO HAVE A TEEN AGE NIGHT CLUB THERE AS WELL AS SEVERAL OTHER BUSINESSES WHICH RELATIVES WERE OPERATING. HE SAID HE EXPECTED TO EARN MONEY BY PLAYING THE GUITAR, ONCE INSIDE MEXICO, AND DID PLAY IN LINDHARDS PRESENCE. LINDHARD SAID SUSPECT WAS NOT ACCOMPLISHED IN HANDLING GUITAR AND PLAYED COUNTRY AND WESTERN MUSIC.

HE SAID HE DOES NOT KNOW WHETHER SUSPECT WAS SUCCESSFUL IN CROSSING BORDER AND HAS NOT SEEN OR HEARD ABOUT HIM SINCE. SUSPECT TOLD LINDHARD HE MIGHT TRY TO SLEEP IN ONE OF THE IMMIGRATION BUILDINGS AT BORDER IF HE WAS SUCCESSFUL IN CROSSING. LINDHARD DESCRIBED IMMIGRATION OFFICERS ON DUTY AS YOUNG "BOYS" AND THE ONE IN CHARGE SEEMED "PRETTY SHARP" AND MADE THE DECISION TO REFUSE TOURIST DOCUMENTATION TO SUSPECT AND DECLINED HIS BRIBE OFFER.
