



- Further to the A/Officer i/c C.I.B. memorandum dated in Ottawa on the 21 MAY 68, the only persons who could possibly identify the photo of STEIN would be Mr. and Mrs. QUINTAL, former janitors of the Harkay Apartments, who are now residing in Windsor, Ontario.
- It is to be noted that the QUINTAL's have already been interviewed in respect to this investigation. 


