Reference is made to your letter of July 18, 1968, your reference 95-100-473, requesting a check of the files of this Bureau concerning 25 members of local law enforcement agencies who will be assigned to security detail during the above subject's incarceration in Shelby County.

The files of the FBI have been reviewed based on the identifying data furnished by you and our files reveal no identifiable pertinent information concerning the individuals listed by you with the exception of the following:

Hobert Jackson Beckham, Jr. We have not investigated Beckham. However, our files reveal that Hobert Jackson Beckham, Sr., who may be the father of Hobert Jackson Beckham, Jr., was the subject of two civil rights investigations. He, the father, was a deputy sheriff of Hardin County, Tennessee. Copies of the reports of these investigations were furnished the Civil Rights Division of the Department of Justice in the cases captioned "Con D. Seaton, Sheriff, Hardin County, Savannah, Tennessee; Hobert Jackson Beckham, Sr., aka, Deputy Sheriff, Hardin County, Savannah, Tennessee; James L. Hunt - Victim" and "Richard Clay Jerrolds; Et Al.; Harvey McHeal Vanhoose, Et Al. - Victims."

Howard Don Clifton. This individual was the subject of a civil rights investigation in September, 1964. A copy of the investigative report was furnished the Civil Rights Division of the Department under the title "Howard Don Clifton; Jimmy Donald Music; Hemphis, Tennessee, Police Department; James Edward Pugh - Victim."

William A. DuFour. This individual was the subject of a civil rights investigation along with others in 1966. Copies of the investigative reports were forwarded to the

Fe's Stickler For the Law'

Criminal Court Judge W. Preston Battle, one of the most experienced trial judges in Memphis, was announced teday as the judge in the trial of James Earl Ray for the slaying of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

A short, heavyset man who runs a no-nonsense courtroom, Battle has been trial judge for a number of major cases since he first took the bench in 1959.

He presided at both trials of Louis F. Montesi, grocery executive convicted of killing his wife.

Battle's decisions have been reversed several times, including the first Montesi trial, but lawyers say this is the mark of a judge who hears a lot of cases and isn't afraid to blaze new trails.

Serious, almost scowling, on the bench, the 60-year-old

judge is a stickler for legal aspects of a case and often recesses court to check a point of law.

Lawyers who try grandstand tactics in the courtroom are likely to draw sharp weeds from the judge, but he displays exceptional patience with defendants or witnesses who appear nervous or seem not to understand legal procedures.

A lifelong Memphian, Judge Battle attended Washington & Lee University and the University of Memphis Law School, now part of Memphis State University School of Law.

ONCE SHY

He has said in the past that his shyness and timidity in his younger days led indirectly to his law career, that he had an aversion to speaking in public and joined the literary society at Memphis University School to overcome it.

After receiving his license to practice law in 1933, he became assistant district attorney general for Shelby County, a post he held for 11 years, serving on the staffs of Atty. Gens. W. T. McLain, Marion Boyd and Will Gerber.

In 1945 he entered private law practice in Memphis, with the majority of his cases devoted to criminal law. In 1959 he was appointed judge for Division III of the Criminal Court of Shelby County, a newly created court, and has since been elected to the bench.

BAR LEADER

A member of the Memphis and Shelby County Bar Association, he has served on the board of directors and executive committee. He has served as president of the Memphis and Shelby County Mental' Health Association, has been active in adult education classes at Southwestern and goes deep sea fishing for a hobby.

Married in 1941 to the former Florence Warfield Boyce of Memphis, he has four children, Mrs. E. Frank King, W. J. Britton III, Mrs. E. R. Kinnebrew III, and W. Preston Battle Jr.

HAYNES, Assistant Attorney General, Shelby County, Memphis, Tenn.; Lt. JAMES P. TALLEY, Police Department, Memphis, Tennessee; HAROLD WARD YATES - VICTIM, CR." In this Civil Rights complaint, victim YATES alleged that Judge BATTLE refused to let him say anything during course of trial and alleged BATTLE violated his rights by this and the exclusive sentence which was given him.

In addition, City Attorney JOSEPH A. CANALE former Special Agent (Retired), advised he has known Judge BATTLE personally for 25 years. He described BATTLE has being respected both socially and professionally in the community. Judge BATTLE further described as Judge who makes all attorneys "toe the line" in his courtroom and is strict in regard to proceedings. Former SA CANALE advised in confidence that he had never heard a word against Judge BATTLE's character, reputation, integrity, or ethics as a Judge.

ROBINSON, Memphis, Tennessee. advised on 7/23/68 that the contents of the message appearing on the postcard directed to Judge BATTLE contains a veiled threat and that he would authorize prosecution of the individual for violation of Title 18, Section 876, USC, if the individual who is responsible for preparing and mailing this postcard is identified.

The Memphis Division has initiated a separate investigation in this matter and has advised the Bureau Airtel by airtel dated 7/23/68 captioned "UNSUB; W. PRESTON BATTLE - VICTUM EXTORTION - RACIAL MATTER: OO MEMPHIS".

RAY, Memphis, Tennessee. This postcard, which was postmarked at New York, New York, 7/22/68, bore the message "You are next to die."

USA THOMAS L. ROBINSON, Memphis, advised on 7/24/68 that the contents of the message appearing on the postcard directed to E. RAY contains a threat to RAY's life, therefore, he would authorize prosecution of the person responsible for preparing and sending this postcard, if identified, under Title 18, Section 876, USC.
