Records disclosed that WILSON resigned on March 10, 1968, to go into business for himself. Records failed to show that WILSON was employed by the U.S. Government on April 4, 1968.

In the course of his jewelry store business, BURGESS Synopsis: AUDI WILSON alleged he met a white male Italian in late 1960s who operated a jewelry trade shop on Walnut Street in Kansas City, Missouri. WILSON alleged that this male later introduced him to another Italian, MITCH (LNU), approximately 5'10", 190 pounds, black wavy hair, and had some business connection with a bonding company. BOB HADEL, Hadel Jewelers, said he heard of a person named MITCH (LNU) associated with a jewelry store on Walnut Street in Kansas City, Missouri, and also had some association with a bonding company. HADEL indicated that the only MITCH of whom he was aware having any association with a jewelry store and bond company was MITCH ZAMMAR. HADEL indicated that ZAMMAR used to hang out at FECHTER Jeweler, 12th and Walnut, Kansas City, Missouri. HADEL said that a few years back, a BOB SEREDICH purchased a jewelry store from THURMAN FECHTER. Both ZAMMAR and SEREDICH were subjects of prior Kansas City FBI cases. Both were subjects of KC 92- violations,

anti-racketeering. Both men have arrest records.

#### DETAILS:

Investigation was initiated on August 21, 1978, upon receipt of an immediate teletype from Memphis indicating that BURGESS AUDI WILSON surrendered to FBI Agents of the Jackson Office. WILSON at that time alleged that he assassinated MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.

ROY G. KULP, General Delivery, Lewiston, Idaho, voluntarily appeared at the Lewiston Federal Bureau of Investigation Office furnishing the following information:

WULP acknowledged that he wrote a letter to "Warden, Federal Penitentiary, Leavenworth, Kansas," on August 1, 1978, in which he indicated that JAMES EARL RAYE escaped from Missouri State Penitentiary at Jefferson City in 1967, receiving this information from J. T. HULL, Sheriff's Office (Morgan County, Missouri), also indicating that HULL could have been involved in Stringbean-Hee-Haw (1974) regarding Nashville, Tennessee, Police Department.

When asked the significance of this information, KULP could not furnish any logical statement to indicate the relevance of this hypothesis.

At various points during the interview, KULP indicated that he could prove that he was the originator of "Stringbean" and "Hee-Haw" and, in fact, brought a suit of \$100,000.00 concerning this matter at Nashville, Tennessee.

He further advised that he is presently in the U. S. Army and has been waiting for orders since 1969. KULP advised that he is receiving his salary through Veterans Administration (VA) compensation; however, did not wish to dwell on this topic. He advised his last report from the Army indicated that he was a "full bird" Colonel.

KULP also acknowledged that he wrote two letters to the Police Department at Memphis, Tennessee, both dated August 17, 1978, and which reported the death of "Racul" in Miami, Florida. KULP advised the death of "Racul" may be a coincidence; however, he did not like coincidences in his life.

The inference the interviewing Agent received from KULP concerning this topic is that during the investigation of the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, Jr., JAMES EARL RAY

from newspaper accounts, indicated if "Raoul" could be located it would prove his innocence. KULP advised that it is possible that "Raoul," who died in Miami, Florida, could have been identical to the "Raoul" mentioned by RAY.

KULP advised that although "Raoul" lived and died in the same apartment house, 320 Northwest 7th Avenue, Miami, Florida, he never had an occasion to actually speak to "Raoul."

KULP indicated the death of "Raoul" was too much of a coincidence and moved away from Miami.

He cited several other coincidences, indicating that the last day he celebrated his 30th anniversary in the U.S. Army, DONALD DAVID DEFREEZE, leader of the "SIA" was killed in Los Angeles, California. He also advised in 1965 he was accused of killing a seventeen-year-old girl in Versailles, Missouri; however, it was proven he could not have been responsible for the girl's death, in view of the fact that at the time of her death he was in Blackfoot, Idaho, at the State Hospital South, a mental institution.

KULP could furnish no other logical explanation concerning the relevance of the information contained in the three letters mentioned above.

KULP advised he was departing Lewiston, Idaho, permanently on September 12, 1978, displaying a bus ticket destined for Phoenix, Arizona.

## Evidence Will Clear Ray, Attorney Claims

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Attorney Mark Lane said Saturday he has "irrevocable evidence" that James Earl Ray did not murder Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and that he knows who did and can provide the names of at least two members of the assassins' group.

Lane said persons in high positions in the U.S. government are aware of the information clearing Ray of the sniper murder in Memphis in 1968 but have not divulged

"They are, all of them, accessories to the fact in the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King," Lane said.

Lane is the attorney who appeared with Ray in recent hearings before the House Assassinations Committee that investigated the murders of King and President John F. Kennedy.

Ray is serving a 99-year sentence for his confession to killing King with a rifle at a Memphis motel. Ray has recanted the confession, contending he was duped by others who killed King, but the Assassinations Committee did not call for a new trial for Ray.

Lane, in a telephone call to Washington radio station WRC, an NBC affiliate, said he will soon file motions in federal and district courts demanding a trial for Ray.

"We now know, with irrevocable evidence, evidence which is beyond any question, that the most cynical person in the country, even members of Congress, have to accept, we know for the first time who killed Martin Luther King" Lane said

Luther King," Lane said.
"Not only the group involved, but we have the names of two of the people involved in the group. We know James Earl Ray is not guilty, we know who was involved.

"We know who killed Martin Luther King. We are prepared to prove this, prepared to prove people in powerful positions of the U.S. government today who learned of this information before we did, who have this information

"I now feel confident for the first time that Mr. Ray nust be given a trial. At that trial we will prove that we know who killed Dr. King and that James Earl Ray played to part in the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King."

Lane said the information was a wedding present to tay, who married artist Anna Sandhu Friday in brief eremonies before returning to his cell.

On November 20, 1978, SOLOMON JONES, JR., who is confined at the Shelby County Jail (SCJ), Memphis, Tennessee, telephonically contacted the Memphis Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and requested that a Special Agent of the FBI be sent to interview him. On November 21 and 22, 1978, Special Agents Burl F. Johnson and James A. Davis interviewed Jones at the SCJ and obtained the following information:

SCLOMON JONES, JR., was interviewed at the Shelby County Jail (SCJ), Memphis, Tennessee. JONES furnished the following information:

JONES is serving a jail sentence at the SCJ following conviction on a charge of embezzlement. He is married to ELIZABETH JONES and they have six children, ranging in age from 4 to 18 years. His permanent address is 852 Faxon Street, Memphis, telephone 525-3447. Prior to his incarceration, he was employed by the Hughes Bonding Company, 95 North Second Street, Memphis, which is managed by NEILS JONES. JONES is represented by WAYNE EMMONS, Attorney, 100 North Main Street, Memphis, in all legal matters involving him.

In 1968, JONES served as chauffeur for Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING while Dr. KING was in Memphis. He was present at the Lorraine Motel, Memphis, on April 4, 1968, and was standing near Dr. KING when he was killed on that date. Immediately after Dr. KING was shot, JONES observed an individual dressed in something white moving behind the building across the street on the west side of the Lorraine Motel. This is the direction from which JONES heard a noise that was apparently the sound of a gun shot. He did not know the identity of this individual.

On November 22, 1978, SOLOMON JONES was again contacted at the Shelby County Jail. He furnished the following information:

On an unrecalled date, WAYNE EMMONS, JONES' attorney, informed JONES that DUNCAN RAGSDALE was attempting to locate him for MARK LANE, an attorney. RAGSDALE was a candidate in the 1978 election campaign opposing Congressman HAROLD FORD for U.S. Representative in the congressional district in Memphis represented by Mr. FORD. RAGSDALE learned JONES was incarcerated at the SCJ.

On an unrecalled date, approximately 30 days ago, RAGSDALE and MARK LANE made an appearance at the SCJ and requested permission of SCJ officials to see JONES. RAGSDALE

told the SCJ officials JONES had invited him and LANE to visit him, which is not true. RAGSDALE later told JONES it was necessary for him to tell the jail officials this in order to obtain permission to see JONES. After JONES signed a memorandum prepared by SCJ officials indicating his willingness to see RAGSDALE and LANE, the jail officials allowed them to visit with him.

LANE opened the interview by asking, "Would you take \$1,000 to put some hot news on the front page?".

JONES asked, "What kind of news?". LANE said. "You know the FBI was harassing Dr. KING." JONES said, "No, I don't know. Dr. KING had personal business. I was Dr. KING's driver." LANE asked, "Don't you think the FBI set up the plot to kill Dr. KING?". JONES said, "I don't know who set up the plot and I don't know who killed him." LANE said, "I'm going to get you before the Committee and I want you to tell the Committee that WALTER FAUNTROY, representative from the District of Columbia, and Dr. KING had women living at the Lorraine Motel. Was that true?". JONES answered, "I don't know whether that was true." LANE stated, "The man you described running from the scene dressed in something white - don't you think it was the FBI?". JONES said, "I don't know who it was." LANE said, "The FBI put the woman in the crazy house to keep her from testifying she saw the FBI around the building before the shooting took place. Don't you think the FBI has gotten hold of FAUNTROY to keep him quiet and from bringing the FBI to testify before the Committee?".

JONES is of the impression thatMr. LANE wants him to testify before the House Select Committee on Assassinations (HSCA) provided he testifies that the FBI helped kill Dr. KING and prefers JONES not testify otherwise.

Following the appearance of Mr. RAGSDALE and Mr. LANE at the SCJ, they proceeded to the Lorraine Motel where they held a press conference. At this conference Mr. LANE announced he had met with SOLOMON JONES, the chauffeur of the late Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., but that Mr. JONES would be unable to accompany him at that time.

The following day a news release attributed to LANE contained information to the effect that JONES is a key witness to the killing of Dr. KING and that the HSCA would not let him testify because his testimony would destroy the Committee.

Also on the following day, Mr. RAGSDALE reported that Congressman FORD knew there was a cover-up in connection with the death of Dr. KING. Congressman FORD responded that this was a political stunt on the part of RAGSDALE.

JONES' wife, ELIZABETH, and mother-in-law, MAGGIE MOORE, have heard a radio broadcast on Memphis radio station WDIA wherein it was reported that WDIA has received a letter from LANE stating he was acting as an attorney for JONES. The letter also stated that JONES would be in danger if he appeared as a witness before the HSCA.

LANE is not now, has never been and will never be retained as an attorney by JONES. JONES was subpoened by the HSCA and was scheduled to appear as a witness on January 17, 1978. This appearance was canceled due to the death of Senator HUMPHREY. JONES was informed by the Committee he would be subpoened at a later date but has not been subsequently subpoened.

On November 22, 1978, JONES furnished a written statement which is as follows:

Memphis, Tennessee November 22, 1978

I, Solomon Jones, Jr., make this free and voluntary statement to Burl F. Johnson and James A. Davis, who have identified themselves to me as Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). No threats or promises have been made to induce me to make a statement. I realize any statement I do make may be used in a court of law.

I am currently serving a jail sentence at the Shelby County Jail (SCJ), Memphis, Tennessee, following conviction on an embezzlement charge. My permanent residence is located at 852 Faxon Street, Memphis, telephone 525-3447. Prior to the incarceration I was employed by the Hughes Bonding Company, 95 North Second Street, Memphis, which is operated by Neils Jones.

In 1968 I served as chauffeur for Dr. Martin
Luther King, Jr., while Dr. King was in Memphis. I was
present at the Lorraine Motel, Memphis, on April 4, 1968,
and was standing near Dr. King when he was killed on that

ELIZABETH JONES, 852 Faxon Street, Memphis, Tennessee, was interviewed at the lobby of the Shelby County Jail, Memphis. She furnished the following information:


ASSASSINATION OF DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., APRIL 4, 1968, MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE

The November 23, 1978, issue of the Memphis Commercial Appeal, a daily newspaper published in Memphis, Tennessee, contained an article on page 71 entitled, "Payoff not Accepted, King's Driver Claims". According to this article, on November 22, 1978, SOLOMON JONES, JR., chauffeur for the late Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., said that Attorney MARK LANE offered him \$1,000 to say the FBI had harassed KING and might even have set up the plot to kill him. JONES, who was one of the last persons to talk to KING before he fell dead of an assassin's bullet in 1968, said he told LANE he knew nothing of such allegations and refused the money.

LANE, the attorney for JAMES EARL RAY, convicted killer of Dr. KING, strongly denied the accusation on the night of November 22, 1978. He said he had met JONES in the jail in the presence of lawyer DUNCAN RAGSDALE and no such offer was made. LANE said, "Either the reporter (who talked to JONES) is a liar or Solomon Jones is a liar".
