MARTIN LUTHER KING was at Wausau, Wis. 5/12/67. He gave a speech in the area and then held a news conference at about 4:00 PM that date.

Investigation at Wausau has developed the following in this case.

On the afternoon KING was in Wausau, an anonymous call was received by the PD. The caller said he would "put a bullet through King's head." Call was anonymous; however, PD suspects caller was one THEODORE J. ADANK, who is described by PD as being possible mental case and individual capable of committing violence. Regarding THEODORE J. ADANK, he has a father named HARVEY and both he and his father are employed as chefs at the Lomar Supper Club, 3701 N. 6th St., Wausau. About two or three weeks ago, THEODORE ADANK left his job and whereabouts since that time unknown.

THEODORE has a brother, ALAN PAUL ADANK, who is of similar description and whose current whereabouts are also unknown. He is described by PD as being an individual capable of committing violence.

On the night of 4/7/68, Roger Priest, Federal Conservation Warden, Eau Claire, Wis. telephonically contacted SA Graham and advised as follows.

Priest was at Nelson, Wis. on 4/7/68 observing individuals in that area near the Mississippi River. He said that he was watching several individuals whom he thought might try to hunt ducks, which is prohibited at this time. He stated that shortly after noon he noted a man standing near the Railroad tracks as though he was waiting for womeone. He advised that this person was dressed in heavy outdoor clothing and was using field glasses. He could not determine what he was watching.

Priest said that this person remained at this same location for about ohe and ohe half hours before he left in a 1966 Ford automobile with 1968 Wisconsin License E32789. He advised that he had determined that this license was issued to Alvin P. Leque of Wausau. Wis.

Priest described this individual as follows.

Race white xex male age 40 yrs. 51 8n height weight 170# build medium hair-dark

Priest said that this person seemed to be looking down the tracks in a southerly direction with his field gaases as though expecting someone or something.

Priest advised that the only reason that he brought this to the attention of this office was because of the recent killing of Martin Luther King. However, he furnished nothing to indicate any possible connection with that incident.

The above information was furnished telephonically to SA Kenna, who will submit information on Leque. No further action is contemplated.



Leads are to be afforded immediate, thorough and imaginative attention. All logical possibilities must be exhausted.

The best suspect in this case is an individual who purchased a Remington 700 automatic at a sporting goods store in Birmingham on 3/29/68. Suspect stated he wanted to do some hunting in Wis. A second person exchanged this gun on 3/30/68 for a Remington 760 pump action 30.06 "Game Master," doing so for his "brother" who purchased the gun initially. This second gun was abandoned near the scene of instant matter by the person believed to have shot KING. The purchaser of the gun gave his name as MARVEY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER. He is generally described as white, male, age 36, 5'8", 150-160, black or dark brown eyes.

Composite description, based on Birmingham and Memphis investigation, is white male, age 26-40, 5'8"-5'11", 150-170, dark brown or sandy hair combed straight back, blue or green eyes, medium build, average to smooth complexion, neat appearance. Possibility exists suspect is a mon-smoker.

Tags are 2 in. wide and 1 1/16 in. long, red in color, bearing marking which appears to be "02B-6" or "D2B-6." Only a portion of the first character is present on each tag, and this character is cut on slight bias. No other visible laundry marks were found on either garment. Bureau directs all offices immediately telephonically contact all laundries in the division to identify laundry using this code and these tags, and pursue logical leads If pertinent laundry identified, Bureau is to be developed. advised immediately telephonically.

investigation should be deferred on other than these three locations until further notice.

In the event it is determined in checking with these three companies that these specific machines have been sold to other laundries, the specific machines of course should be traced to their now owners. Thermoseal Company officials have advised that this is a very unusual type of cutting and they are certain that the machine which made the specific tape in question can be identified when located.

Memphis now advises that the best suspect by name at this time is ERIC STARVO GALT. Basis for this thinking is that GALT resided in Birmingham, Alabama, from September through November, 1967, and is known to have purchased a white Mustang for \$2,000 cash in August, 1967. GALT registered in a Memphis flophouse type of motel in the vicinity of the assassination the night before it took place. He checked out the next day. Witnesses in the vicinity immediately after the assassination have stated a white Mustang with red and white license tags (Alabama has red and white license tags) sped away from the scene. Further, binoculars were found in the rooming house from which KING was shot. Fingerprints from the binoculars are identical with fingerprints on the rifle purchased in Birmingham and located at the scene of the shooting. No information is available on GALT's residence or whereabouts since November, 1967, other than his registration in Memphis the night before the assassination. He is described, set forth below and, according to witnesses, is close to that of the individual seen running from the rooming house in Memphis immediately after the assassination. Information has been developed that GALT told people he was a merchant mariner. He is described as possibly born white male, 5'11". 175 pounds, possibly with medium dark hair.

Investigation to further identify GALT should be conducted immediately and prior to any other investigation in this matter. Investigation at once should include credit, criminal, birth record, marriage and any other logical records check, as previously set forth in this memo for LOWMEYER, to identify GALT. In connection with the GALT lead any logical possibility on merchant mariner should receive top priority in making these records checks.

Apparently some of the best leads to the slayer have been su plied by residents of the rundown apartment building from which the fatal sot came.

The landlady, Mrs. Bessie Brewer, 44, said that less than





Re phone call from SA Goerge Vopal 4/11/68 instructing that samples of the lettering of the Thermoseal Marking Machine, located at Huebsch Laundry Co., Eau Claire, Wis. be obtained.

On 4/11/68, John Vaudreuil, President, Huebsch Laundry Co., 101 North Dewey St., Eau Claire, Wis. made available samples of the lettering of his machine with the markings 02B-6 and D2B-6 each repeated twice. Vaudreuil said that his concern does not usually use this lettering sequence. He also advised that most customers usually will remove the label from their garments before they wear them or thex laundry will remove them when a garment is subsequently laundered so that the numbers will not be confused. He said that the number can be removed easily from the garment.

The samples obtained are being forwarded with this memorandum.

JOHN BOSSHARD, General Manager, Spic & Span, Inc., 4301 North Richard Street, advised that five Thermoseal machines are located at 4301 North Richards and three are currently used in daily operations at Spic & Span, Inc., and the other two are out of order.

Machines bearing Serial Numbers 32584, 32574, and 32585 are operative and samples were obtained.

Machines bearing Serial Numbers 32582 and 32549 are inoperative, however, samples were obtained from inside the machine where they had fallen during previous operations.

BOSSHARD advises that the numbers on the laundry tags are used to indicate the lot, week and bundle numbers as follows:

The numbers to the left of the letter indicate the lot number and the letter indicates the week in which received and the numbers to the right of the letter indicate the bundle number within the lot.

He stated he does not know whether or not this system is common to all users of this type of machine.

He advised that either D2B-6 or O2B-6 would not be one of Spic and Span's numbers as they did not utilize a zero in front of single numbers and never used a letter as the first digit. He further stated that the last week his firm used B was the week of 17-23 December, 1967, and that these tags were violet colored tape.
