In addition, the Sheriff's Offices of the above-mentioned counties, and the County Clerk Offices of these counties, advised that their files also failed to reflect any information identifiable with the suspect names in the birth, marriage, or death records held by those counties. It is also noted that records of the credit bureaus covering the above Wisconsin counties have failed to reflect any information identifiable with these names.

For the information of the file, on 4/11/68, LEONARD KOWALSKI, Records Clerk, Wisconsin State Prison, (WSP), Waupun, Wisconsin, advised his files reflect no names identifiable with HARVEY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER. He stated that a review of other names in his file for similarities to the name of GALT reflected in the Alias Card File an H. T. GALT. On the same date, ALBERTA HARRISON and ANDREA CARTWRIGHT of Northwest and United Airlines, respectively, advised that their airlines had no overseas flights arrival or departure direct from Milwaukee without previous or subsequent stops in the continental United States.

On April 19, 1968, VICTOR CHORINSKI, Special Sheriff's Deputy, general Mitchell Field, was contacted concerning the above. He advised that no scheduled airlines depart on direct overseas flights nor are there any arrivals direct from overseas to Mitchell Field. He stated, however, that there are, at times, special charter flights coming into or leaving the continental United States from or for overseas.

CHORINSKI was advised of the nature of the investigation and the reason that he was contacted. He stated that he had photographs of subject GALT which he had clipped from local newspapers and that he would place stops with appropriate personnel concerned with the above described special charter flights and would keep the FBI advised.

Atlanta, Ga. -UPI- An At- the Friday after King was lanta taxicab driver identified slain. for the federal bureau of investigation Tuesday a sketch of the mystery figure who is a suspect in the slaying a sketch of the man the FBI of the Rev. Martin Luther King, jr. The driver said the man rode in his cab the day after the slaying.

A second taxicab driver working for the same company said he, too, gave the man a ride the Friday after King was shot by a sniper in Memphis, Tenn., Apr. 4.

Both drivers said the trips were in Atlanta's hippie neighborhood around Peachtree and 14th sts. The area is about seven miles from the public housing project where a white Ford Mustang, registered to the suspect was located by FBI agents last Thursday.

Both taxi drivers work for the Atlanta Million Co-operative Cab Co. Their names were withheld at the request of the taxicab firm.

The FBI has pored through the records of Atlanta Million cab and other taxicab firms in the city in an attempt to trace the suspect from the time he apparently abandoned the Mustang.

Apparently working on a new lead, however, FBI agents returned to the offices of Atlanta Million cabs Tuesday the hippie neighborhood on at King," the sheriff said.

Two drivers, who had made such pickups were questioned by an agent who showed them apparently thinks is the sus-

Both drivers identified the man in the sketch as the one they picked up.

In Birmingham, where the suspect once lived, Jefferson County Sheriff Mel Bailey said he thought the assassin may have originally planned to kill King in the Alabama steel city.

Bailey, who threw a security net around King when he was in the city last October to serve five days in jail, said he thought a conspiracy existed to murder the civil rights leader.

The sheriff said that his theory was only conjecture but that "it is based on the evidence uncovered so far in the

Bailey noted that the suspect, who has been identified; by fellow boarders in a rooming house in Birmingham as being the same man shown in FBI sketches of the suspected assassin, lived in the city when King was serving his jail term.

- Galt left Los Angeles last Dec. 15 and drove his Mustang to New Orleans where he claimed he contacted either an erigineering or a contracting firm. He left there Dec. 19 and arrived in Los Angeles Dec.
- While in the Los Angeles FBI agents have determined area early this year, Galt took a course at a bartending school and was graduated Mar. 2.

Described as Loner

An FBI description of Galt said persons who have met him "describe him as a loner and state his language and diction have a rural quality. and suggest that he probably does not have a high degree of education. He is said to drink alcoholic beverages and has a preference for vodka and beer. He is a fan of western and country music."

The bureau warned that "Ga'lt should be considered armed and dangerous," and any information concerning him should be furnished immediately to the FBI.



HE HAS SERVED TERMS IN THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY JAIL IN
1949; IN STATE PRISONS AT JOLIET AND PONTIAC, ILLINOIS, IN 1958-54;
AND IN THE FEDERAL PENITENTIARY AT LEAVENWORTH, KANSAS, IN 1955-58.

RAY WAS AN ENLISTED MAN IN THE UNITED STATES ARMY FROM FEBRUARY, 1946, TO DECEMBER, 1948, AT WHICH TIME HE WAS GIVEN A GENERAL DISCHARGE DUE TO INEPTNESS AND LACK OF ADAPTABILITY FOR MILITARY SERVICE. WHILE IN THE ARMY, HE RECEIVED A THREE-MONTH SENTENCE AT HARD LABOR FOR BEING DRUNK AND BREAKING ARREST.




