At 7:30 PM, this date, MRS. GENETT MANDERY, Lot D-9, Isle-a-Gold Trailer Park, 2640 South Federal Highway, Homestead, Fla., no telephone, telephonically contacted this office to relate the following information:

MANDERY was acquainted with DONALD E. ESTES around October or November of 1963. At that time, ESTES was a sergeant in the U. S. Air Force, stationed at Homestead AFB. ESTES received a discharge from the Air Force in 1963 and thereafter MANDERY did not see him. MANDERY spoke of ESTES as being a avowed racist, having anti-negro sentiments, and an "expert marksman".

During the live telecast of the March on Memphis, which MANDERY watched, she saw a man standing in the background who she believes was ESTES. MANDERY said this man was wearing a sports shirt and long trousers, and appeared to be viewing the proceedings.

MANDERY described ESTES as a W/M, 6' 2-3", 200-210 lbs., dirty blond hair, blue eyes, late thirites. ESTES' family resides in Birmingham, Ala. and ESTES is from unknown city in Alabama.

MANDERY is of the opinion that because of ESTES' beliefs concerning negroes and his marksmanship and the fact that she saw him on television in Memphis, that ESTES is a logical suspect in assasination Martin Luther King, Jr.

Syracuse, NY and uses it in all his other related companies. He estimated he handles between 30-40% of all local business and explained that due to cost of machine, only large volume businesses would have this equipment. He stated however, that the marking system in use, is not similiar with 02-B-6 or D2-B-6, he uses no numbering beginning with 0 or an alphabet letter. He added that he known of no other local company who uses this equipment but suggested the following major companies for contact.

Mrs. EISIE JAMESS, Secretary Kent Cleaners & Laundry, aka Southern Linen & Supply, Inc., advised that all their work is done in their Miami Office, kind of machines used unknown here.

NATHAN SLOMOWITZ, owner Fenray Cleaners & Laundry, 421 Belvedere Rd., WPB, Fla. advised his Thermo Marking Machine is an English make, Poly Marking Machine and he uses no red tape markings.

JOHN GIES, Gulfstream Laundry, Inc. 609-24th. St., WPB, Fla. and J. E. ADAMSON, East Coast Laundry 921-27th. St., WPB, Fla., both advised they do not use this type of marking machine and know of no one in the area who does, except Acme Cleaners.

Mr. RAY RUFFING, Swift Dry Cleaners & Laundry, 247 NE 2nd. Ave., Delray Beach, Florida advised that he has the only machine of instant type in this area. He doses not use the questioned system of matking, he uses same system as that used by ACME at West Falm Beach.

Mr. JOS. FREDERICKS, Boca "aton Laundry, 30 SE 1st. St., Boca Raton, Fla. advised he has the only type of instant machine in this area, does not use the questioned system of marking, uses same method as Acme and Swift Laundry in Delray Beach.

He expressed a distinct dislike for Negroes. CARCIA advised that during conversation with this individual he asked GARCIA where he was from. When GARCIA told him he was from Tampa he asked if GARCIA knew anything about the Mafia. GARCIA told him that his father, MANUEL GARCIA, an Attorney, had done some legal work for the TRAFFICANTES in Tampa. He told GARCIA he was going to Orlando to do some work for the Mafia. for which he would receive a new Mercury and \$7000. He told GARCIA upon arrival in Orlando he was to walk up and down a certain street, name unrecalled, in Orlando until someone contacted him. He further stated that from Orlando he was going to Mismi after which he would head north through Tennessee, to Idaho, and would feel better when he had a "few G's" in his pocket. He teld GARCIA that his job had nothing to do with dope and indicated his job would be done in a week, after when he would be on his way to Idaho. He showed GARCIA a picture which he removed from his billfold of a place where he was going in Idaho. GARCIA recalls this picture showed snow covered mountains and a mountain lake. He claimed he was going to a small camp where he had "laid up" before. GARCIA recalls that he mentioned a waterfall at this place which gave off a spray revealing an image that looked like a reclining woman.

GARCIA advised that this individual appeared to know quite a bit about weaponry and stated that he talked about the AK47, Chinese assault rifle, laser beam, and light anti-tank weapon.

GARCIA advised after arriving in Gainesville he let this individual off on West University Avenue where he claimed he wanted to wash his clothes in a washateria. GARCIA stated that on Sunday, 3/31/68, around noon, he saw this individual hitchhiking on Archer Road toward I-75. He stopped and asked GARCIA if he would give him a ride as far as I-75, but GARCIA was in a hurry and unable to do so. Be has not seen this individual since.

GARCIA stated that he did not give too much thought to the conversation he had with this individual until after the announcement of the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. on 4/4/68. He stated after this announcement he began to give thought to the conversation mentioned herein that he had with this individual, particularly to his expressed dislake for Negroes and he also mentioned the Communist element among Negroes and he therefore thought he should report this to the proper authorities.

GARCIA reviewed all the pending identification orders but was unable to make an identification. He was asked to study the identification order of ROBERT BOLIVAR DE PUGH, IO \$4176, inasmuch as process is outstanding for DE PUCH in Seattle and the description of the hitchhiker somewhat fits DE PUGH. After closely studying DE PUGH, GARCIA stated he could not state whether or not DE PUCH was identical with the hitchhiker, primarily in view of the fact the hitchhiker had such a full bush beard.

The above information is being submitted for the evaluation of the Memphis Division in connection with captioned matter and for evaluation by Seattle in connection with DE PUGH. Any leads to be set forth is being left to the discretion of the office of origin.

Information copies being sent to Atlanta, Mismi, and Tampa, in the event it becomes necessary to request investigation by these offices concerning the individual described herein.

King Case Alert Issued in Florida

A police teletype alarm for a man driving a white Mustang like the one believed to be used by the murderer of Martin Luther King Jr. was issued in Florida and later withdrawn Thursday night by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

The message identified the man as Eric Starvo Galt, 36, a white man. Sources said Galt was sought in connection with the assassination, but emphasized that no warrant had been issued.

While the alarm still was out, the FBI in Atlanta impounded a white Mustang that had been parked since Friday in Capitol Homes, a public housing project. The FBI refused to talk about the car.

It could not be determined whether or not the impounded auto was the same one registered to Galt, which bore license tag number 1-38993.

The number 1 indicates the car was registered in Birmingham, Ala.

The address on the registration was 2608 Highland Ave., a rooming house in Birmingham. Residents there said they had been questioned extensively by the FBI soon after King's death, but they had not seen Galt "for about three months."

Galt was described in the police bulletin as five feet 11 inches tall, with blue eyes and brown hair. Birmingham sources said he had no criminal record there.

No warrant had been issued for Galt's arrest. The FBI, before withdrawing the teletype message at 10:30 p.m., said that if Galt was located, Special Agent Charles Bell of the Miami FBI office should be potified.

When the message was withdrawn, the cancellation notice was signed by Special Agent John Hanlon. He would not comment on the bulletin, and would not say who could explain.

It was learned that the Mustang found in Atlanta was locked up in the Peachtree Baker Building, where the FBI has its offices.

Authorities believe the murderer of Dr. King bought a .30-06 caliber Remington rifle in Birmingham several days before King was killed last Thursday.

A resident of the Atlanta neighborhood in which the 1966 Mustang was found said she saw a well-dressed darkhaired man near the car during the past several days. But she could not be certain if he resembled a police artist's sketcl of the suspect who rushed from a rooming house across the street from King's

Memphis motel just after he was shot down.

In Atlanta, FBI agents

In Atlanta, FBI agents swarmed around the car taking photographs and fingerprints before hauling it away.

Mrs. Ernest Payne of Atlanta said she saw a man step out of the Mustang last Friday. She described him as between 25 and 30 years old, about five feet nine or 10 and weighing about 165-170 pounds.

A 13-year-old boy, Johnny

Niesen, said he had seen cigaret ashes all over the car's floor and red mud on the driver's side. He also saw two 1967 Mexican visa stickers on one window.

His mother called the FBI Wednesday night after remembering news reports that a man fitting the description of the murder suspect had visited the Mexican consulate in Memphis and obtained a visitor's pass before the murder of King.

Dealer's Records Seized

FBI Tracing Rifle In King's Murder

Miami Herald-Los Angeles Times Wire BIRMINGHAM, Ala. — The FBI has seized the gun sales records of the dealer believed to have sold the rifle used to assassinate Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. in Memphis last week.

Using the rifle's serial number, the FBI obtained from the manufacturer, Remington Arms Co., of Bridgeport, Conn., the name of the wholesale distributor and apparently traced the retail sale to a sporting goods store near the Birmingham airport.

The firm's manager told The Los Angeles Times Thursday that he was first approached by the FBI agents last Monday, four days after the slaying.

He said he could not confirm or deny that his firm had sold a rifle of the type used in the slaying because the FBI agents had taken away the sales records.

The weapon, left by the suspected slayer as he fled the scene of the assassination, has been identified by Memphis police as a Remington .30-06-caliber pump rifle, with a scope.

There were indications that the interrogation by FBI agents of the manager and employes of the sporting goods store near the airport here had failed to identify the purchaser of the rifle.

One such indication was

that FBI agents have been questioning other dealers here. The dealers are not being asked whether they sold the rifle. Instead, they are being asked whether any customer in the period preceding the assassination approached them to inquire about the known capacity of rifles of various calibers, the value of using a scope, and other such information.

This line of questioning tended to support speculation that:

THE FBI believes that the slayer was an amateur, rather than a professional killer.

THE FBI believes there is a chance that the slayer is a resident of the Birmingham area.

In Memphis, meanwhile, there were published reports that a second white Ford Mustang parked near the slaying scene may have been the getaway car used by the killer.

The Memphis Commercial Appeal said a car with Arkansas tags and a similar car, parked a short gistance north, both left the scene within 15 minutes after King was shot.

For the information of San Juan, the following is furnished:

Search of premises believed occupied by UNSUB who assassinated Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING on 4/4/68, disclosed suitcase in which was located tee-shirt and undershorts bearing laundry mark on red tape with black lettering believed to be Thermo-Seal type, manufactured by Textile Marking Machine Co., Inc., Syracuse, N.Y. The tape is ½" wide and 1 1/16" long and bears letters and numbers C2B-6.

Experts at Textile Marking Machine Company advise type on this machine is unusual in that the first two characters are 15 point type and the last three characters are eighteen point type, with the middle character, the letter B, probably being narrow rather than regular type. The usual machine carries 15 point type for the first three characters and 18 point type for the last two characters.

Textile Marking Machine experts also stated this machine is defective in that it is producing a tape 1 1/16" long instead of 1 1/8" long and is not projecting the tape far enough resulting in cutting off a portion of the first letter. The code used in the Northeast part of the U.S. is as follows:

The first letter O stands for lot number; the first number 2 indicates the day of the week, two being Tuesday; the second letter indicates the first letter of the store name, this is the letter B; the last number is the bundle number, this is 6. Color coding of the tag may designate various things such as a different month or the identity of a store in a chain. Experts also state the use of this system on laundry items is unusual in that the system is normally used on garments being dry cleaned.

The Bureau has instructed that all textile machines using this type tape be located and machines using this code be identified.

On 4/12/68 JOSEPH JAMES GAULT and SIMONE MATTE GAULT were interviewed by the writer. The GAULTs advised they were not related to or acquainted with anyone named ERIC STARVO GALT or KARL GALT or with anyone who knew the family who might have used these names.

JOSEPH JAMES GAULT was born in Scotland on and stated that GAULT and GALT are both accepted versions of spelling that name and are often used interchangeably.

GAULT advised he has one son by a former marriage named DONALD CAMERON GAULT born in apparently in the U. S. Navy, whom GAULT has not seen since 1928. GAULT further advised that his former wife and mother of DONALD CAMERON GAULT is named Mrs. GEORGE STEADLEY and resides at 158 Beach Street, Jersey City, New Jersey 07307. Mrs. STEADLEY in all probability knows the whereabouts of DONALD CAMERON GAULT.

W. 1st Avenue, Miamir Florida, advised that a man named EARNEST SUMPTER GAULT had worked intermittently at Labor Pool, Inc. from November 28 to December 12, 1967. GAULT listed his Social Security Number as his address as 511 N. W. 5th Street, Miami, Florida.

COOK described GAULT was being approximately 6' tall, 50 years old, weighing approximately 140 pounds, and having gray hair.

A neighborhood check was conducted in the vicinity of 511 N. W. 5th Street, Miami, and it was determined that this address is non-existent.

On the same date, the records of the Miami P. D. were reviewed with reference to EARNEST SUMPTER GAULT and it was determined from ANNE BRASSELL, records clerk, that EARNEST S. GAULT of several addresses in the Miami area, has been a habitual drunkard for the past ten years. GAULT was last arrested on 2/22/68 for being drunk in public. He is described as a white male, age 47 years old, height 6', weight 140 pounds, eyes blue, hair gray.

In view of the above description of EARNEST GAULT, he is no longer being considered a suspect in this matter.

KING SLAYING CLUES?

Assassin Hunt On, Off Here

The FBI issued a pickup order in Florida for a man wanted for questioning in the Martin Luther King murder at about the same time the man's car was located in Atlanta, it developed today.

The pickup order was on the Florida police network for four hours last night before it was withdrawn by the FBI with the explanation that it had been issued "by mistake."

The Miami FBI, which issued the order, refused any further comment as did Attorney General Ramsey Clark's office in Washington.

The pickup notice added further mystery to the FBI's intensive but secrecywrapped hunt for the assassin who shot the civil rights

leader to death in Memphis a week ago.

But the public now has a name linked with King's assassination and the FBI has an automobile with which to broaden its investigation.

The name is Eric Starvo Galt, a white man born July 20, 1931, described as 5-feet-11, 175 pounds, blue eyes and brown hair. His last known address was 2608 Highland Ave., Birmingham, Ala., once a fashionable address in that city. But a Birmingham newspaper reporter who went there found a decaying rooming house and got no answer to his knock on the door.

The FBI notice said that Galt was driving a 1966 white Mustang hardtop, license tag 1-38993, Alabama 1968. The "I" in the number denotes Jefferson County, or Birmingham.

With the FBI notice freshly in circulation, word came from Atlanta that a Mustang with the Alabama tag described had been impounded there by the FBI.

The car had been parked since last Friday, the day after the assassination, at Capitol Homes, a housing project neaf the Georgia capitol in Atlanta. Atlanta is about 400 miles driving distance from Memphis.

The FBI announced shortly after the slaying that the hunt for King's assassin had stretched "several hundred miles" from Memphis.

Attorney General Clark said then that FBI agents were seeking a white man "on the run." He indicated that the name the man had used to register at a flophouse from which King was shot, John Willard, was not believed to be his right name.

Atlanta residents who spotsed the Mustang before the FBI hauled it in noticed a Mexican "Turista" sticker on the windshield. It had been reported in Memphis that a man assimption of the King suspect had sought a tourist card at the Mexican Consulate there.

More and more, the hunt appeared to concentrate on the Birmingham man, although the FBI notice pointed out no warrant had been issued for Galt.

Little was known about Galt. Several persons in the Highland Avenue neighborhood said they were acquainted with him, but had not seen him for about three months.

The manager of a sporting goods firm near the Birm-

ingham airport said the FBI had sized his sales records after questioning him about purchasers of Remington rifles.

The apparent murder weapon, which killed King with a single shot, was a .30-06 caliber Remington pump rifle abandoned near the slaying scene.

Other Birmingham arms dealers said Federal agents wanted to know if a man had questioned them recently about various types of rifles, and their capabilities.

First reports said the slayer of King raced away in a White Mustang with Arkansas plates. Arkansas, just across the Mississippi River from Memphis, has red and white tags — like Alabama.

But Negro John Gibson Saw Confederate Pennon Lowered

John Gibson, who represented Miami Beach's city employes at Dr. Martin Luther King's funeral, saw some of Dixie die.

In Atlanta for the funeral, Gibson noticed that one hotel displayed the Confederate Flag at half-mast in honor of the slain civil rights leader.

"I never thought I would live to see the day that would happen," said Gibson.

Not once, said Gibson, did signs of racial hatred appear on the Tuesday that King was buried. The crowds were sullen. No hysterics.

Stores in Atlanta were closed but the white merchants who owned them provided both black and white mourners with free sandwiches and nourishment when temperatures soared into the 80's.

Gibson arrived in Atlanta early Tuesday and went to view King's remains almost immediately. The body lay in the Ebenezer Baptist Church.

"He looked as if he was just sleeping," commented Gibson in reference to the brutil gun shot that struck the fight side of King's neck and severed his spinal cord. "The only thing was a scar on his cheek and neck - it was something more like a discoloration.'

While Gibson viewed King, While Gibson viewed King, "Tears came to my eyes he said his thoughts, were when I saw them and "What, is going to happen thought about my own chil- mami (Beach), Fla. now that this man, who addren," said Gibson. vocated non-violence, is gone?"

The same question apparently pervaded all of Atlanta. "Most of the people talked about who was going to take

his place? That was the question they wanted answered. Nobody could answer it," observed Gibson.

"They don't think there's a man in the United States who can take his place as a non-violence leader."

Mourners didn't appear concerned over who killed King, said Gibson. "The person who pulled the trigger is not what killed him - It was the struggle for the rights of the poor all over the U.S., both black and white."

Only once, said Gibson, did the funeral lose solemnity. "The only time it ceased to be a funeral was when Bobby Kennedy showed up, and later Jackie got even a bigger hand."

When the private funeral services ended in Ebenezer, the two-hour procession left for Morehouse College for public ceremonies. Handkerchiefs fluttered all the way to the college as men and wdmen wiped tears.
