sold to one HARVEY LOWMEYER on 3/30/68 by Aeronarine Supply Co., Birmingham, Alabama.

Investigation at Memphis disclosed that an individual had purchased a set of binoculars at the York Arms Company in Memphis on 4/4/68. These binoculars were among the material abandoned with the rifle and recovered in Memphis. Also recovered was a brown and green herringbone bedspread. The items abandoned in Memphis were all wrapped in this bedspread. The blue bag which was inside the bedspread contained numerous items, among which were the binoculars and a set of underwear consisting of a T-shirt and shorts. The T-shirt and shorts are those on which appears the laundry mark which has been a natter of interest in this case.

A search of motel records in the Memphis area disclosed that an individual using the name ERIC S. GALT had spent the night of 4/3/68 at the Rebel Motel, Memphis, Tennessee, and was driving a 1966 white Mustang bearing Alabama License 1-38993. Investigation at Birmngham disclosed that this automobile had been purchased by ERIC S. GALT on August 30, 1968, from a private person in response to a newspaper ad. He paid a total of \$1995 cash. While in Birmingham he furnished the address of 2608 South Highland Avenue, Birmingham. This is also the address which appeared on a driver's license issued to him by the State of Alabama. The driver's license identifying data listed his birth date as July 20, 1931, his height as 5'll", his weight as 170 and his eyes blue and hair brown.

The automobile in question, the white Mustang bearing the Alabama tags mentioned above, was recovered in Atlanta on 4/11/68 and determined to have been abandoned there prior to 9 a.m. on 4/5/68.

In connection with the evidence submitted by Atlanta, Birmingham, and Memphis, identifiable latent prints were recovered. It was on the basis of these latents that identification was made of JAMES EARL RAY. In handling future leads, all offices should be particularly interested in securing an identifying number, military, police, or FBI, in connection with suspects so that the necessary check can be made through the Identification Division.

On 4/17/68, AUSA R. MACEY TAYLOR, Birmingham, authorized the filing of a complaint charging ERIC STARVO GALT with a conspiracy to violate Section 241, Title 18, U. S. Code, and

recommended bond in the amount \$50,000. On that same date, SAC JOSEPH H. GAMBLE filed a complaint before USC MILDRED F. SPRAGUE, Birmingham, and warrant was issued that same date.



THOMAS ROOD, 1827 South U. S. #1, Vero Beach, Florida; mailing address, Post Office Box 1913, Vero Beach, Florida, was interviewed at his residence. He furnished the following information:

He is not currently employed and has not been employed since he resigned his position with the Hartford Insurance Group with whom he worked as an insurance adjustor from October, 1966, through April, 1967.

ROOD broke a rib shortly following his resignation and was "laid up" for four weeks. He then became involved in marital difficulties with his wife, RITA NOE ROOD from whom he separated in July, 1967, and who divorced him in August, 1967. Following his divoce he was unable to find a suitable position and remained unemployed until December 1, 1967, when he entered the Veterans Administration Hospital on Montrose, New York. He was treated at the hospital for his general physical run down condition and for his condition due to a nervous disorder. He was released from the hospital on January 3, 1968. He straightened up his personal affairs in New York State, including the sale of his former residence at 7 Jervin Drive. Stony Point, New York, and he came to Vero Beach, Florida, at the end of January to reside with his mother and stepfather.

He has resided with his mother and stepfather since the end of January, 1968, and has taken no trips out of Vero Beach, which have lasted more than one day.

ROOD advised that he had not been outside the State of Florida, since the end of January, 1968. He did not recall his activities on March 29 and 30, 1968, but he did recall that on April 4, 1968, he slept until



Hoover said Ray's criminal record dated back to 1949 when he was convicted of burglary in Los Angeles. He was convicted of armed robery in Chicago in 1952 and of forging U.S. postal money orders in Missouri in 1955.

He had served time in the Los Angeles County jail in 1949; in state prisons at Joliet, Ill., and Pontiac, Ill., from 1952 to 1954; and in the federal penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kan., from 1955 to 1958.

The FBI attributed a number of characteristics to Galt which it did not mention in its a mouncement of Ray.

It said Galt had a nervous habit of pulling on an ear-

lobe, a taste for beer and vodka and a love for dancing.

It had identified Galt by profession as a cook on Mississippi River vessels and as a seaman. It said Ray worked as a baker, laborer and "color matcher."

Ray was named as a federal fugitive in an FBI complaint filed on July 20, 1967, charged with illegal flight.

"Ray should be considered armed and extremely dangerous," the FBI said.

In addition to being convicted on two armed robbery charges for holding up the St. Louis supermarket, Ray was convicted of automobile theft and was sentenced to 20 years.

A mental examination in the fall of 1966 showed him to have no personality difficulties not common to confined men, Warden Swenson said.

Ray Called 'A Loner' In Prison

JEFFERSON CITY, Mo. — (UPI) — James Earl Ray, identified Friday by the FBI as the man sought in the murder of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., was known as a "loner" to officials at the Missouri State Prison, where he escaped April 23, 1967.

Warden Harold Swenson said Ray presented no special problems as a prisoner, except for two escape attempts.

In 1966, he escaped from his cell and spent several chilly nights hiding in the prison's ventilating system before he was discopered.

His later successful escape apparently was carefully planned.

Ray was working in the food service system at the main prison, and hid in a bread truck which was leaving the walled area.

In the fall of 1966, Ray was sent to the state mental hospital at Fulton for evaluation, not commitment. The Fulton Hospital maintains maximum-security facilities for convicts in need of mental treatment, but Ray was returned to the main prison after study by psychiatrists.

Swenson said Ray displayed no personality troubles or adjustment difficulties not common to confined men.

"He just had the usual type of troubles," the warden said.

Swenson called Ray "an evasive type of person."

"I don't think anybody either liked him or disliked him," the warden said.

Prison records showed he was born March 19, 1928 at Alton, Ill., and that he had a long police record in several states.

At the time of his escape, the warden said, he was serving three concurrent terms, on two counts of armed robbery and one of automobile theft. Under the state's Habitual Criminal Act, the combined sentences amounted to 20 years.

Here's Ray's Long Record Of Arrests

ST. LOUIS — (AP) — This is a chronology of the arrest record of James Earl Ray, sought by the FBI in the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King, compiled by the St. Louis police department:

OCT. 11, 1949 — Burglary arrest and conviction in Los Angeles; served eight months in the county jail and released on probation.

APRIL 18, 1950 — Arrested for vagrancy at Cedar Rapids, Iowa. No record of conviction.

JULY 23, 1951 — Arrested in Alton, Ill., for no operators license and no city license.

MAY 6, 1952 — Arrested in Chicago and convicted of robbery a month later and sentenced to the Illinois penitentiary at Joliet for one to two years. Transferred to state prison at Pontiac, Ill., and released from there March 12, 1954.

MARCH 23, 1955 — Arrested by Missouri highway patrolman in Hannibal Mo., for breaking and entering of a Kansas City post office. OCT. 10, 1959 — Arrested in St. Louis for armed robbery. Convicted and sentenced to 20 years in prison.

JULY 20, 1967 — The FBI filed a complaint charging Ray with anlawfully freeing Missouri to avoid confinement.

Hunted Man's Long Record

James Earl Ray, alias Eric Starvo Galt, who is being sought in the killing of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., is a man described as a loner. Yet he is known as an avid dancer.

He has been convicted of armed robbery and automobile theft, but less than a year ago he applied for and received a legal license to drive a newly purchased white Mustang.

Ray has lived as far west as California, as far south as New Orleans — and in Memphis, Tenn., where on April 4, 1968, King was assassinated.

Here is the most current information available on Ray:

Description: Height, 5 feet 10; weight, 163 to 174 pounds. Brown hair. Blue eyes. A small scar on his forehead and right palm. His left ear protrudes farther than his right ear does. White male about 40.

Relatives: Born in Alton, Ill., March 10, 1928, son of a laborer of the same name. Hospital records in Fulton, Mo., indicate his parents are deceased but prison records list his mother as Mrs. Lucille Ryan at 1913 Hickory St., St. Louis. A brother, Jerry, reportedly has an address of Box 22, Wheeling, Ill.

Aliases: Two aliases listed on FBI warrant — John Willard and Harvey Lowmyer. Other names used are James McBride, James Walton, W. C. Herron and James O'Connor.

Education: High-school dropout in 10th grade. Graduate of International School of Bartending in Hollywood, Calif., on March 2, 1968. Took dancing lessons in New Orleans in 1964 and 1965, in Birmingham during September and October 1967, and in Long Beach, Calif., from December 1967 to February 1968.

Military Record: Served as an enlisted man in the U.S. Army from February 1946 to December 1948 when he was given a general discharge for ineptness and lack of adaptability. While in the Army he received a threemonth sentence at hard labor for being drunk and "breaking" arrest.

Criminal record: In 1949 served eight months in county jail in Los Angeles on a burglary charge. In 1952 convicted in Chicago of armed robbery and served two years in state prisons at Joliet and Pontiac, Ill. In 1955 convicted of forging U.S. postal money orders in Missouri and confined to Fort Leavenworth, Kanf, penitentiary intil 1958. In 1960 sent to the Missouri State Penitentiary for a 20-year sentence for armed robbery and car theft in St. Louis and, on April 23, 1967, escaped.

Occupation: Has worked as a baker, laborer and color matcher. On a driver's license application he put "merchant seaman, unemployed." Claimed to have been a cook on a Mississippi riverboat and to have worked in shipyards.


Mental history: Sent for mental observation in connection with a charge of attempted escape from Missouri State Penitentiary. Hospital officials found "no mental disease or defect within the law."

Pastimes: Beer and vodka drinker. Fond of hillbilly and Western music. Avid dancer.

King Killer Suspect Dangerous, FBI Says

WASHINGTON — (AP)
— The FBI, in its first positive identification of the man sought since the April 4 assassination of Martin Luther King in Memphis, Tenn., says James Earl Ray "should be considered armed and extremely dangerous."

There was no indication the FBI was any closer to catching Ray than it was Wednesday when it put the name Galt on a fugitive warrant charging him "and an individual whom he alleged to be his brother" with conspiring to deprive King of his civil right to travel from state to state.

The FBI has said Eric

Starvo Galt purchased a .30-06 rifle in Birmingham five days before the assassination. That rifle, with a telescopic sight intact, was recovered outside the rooming house just after the assassination.

The FBI did not make clear where it got the fingerprints which it matched against its files to show Galt is actually Ray

But speculation was the prints may have been left in the rooming house, on the rifle or on a 1966 white Mustang — since impounded in Atlanta — that witnesses reported seeing leaving the vicinity of the shooting.

Ray-Galt Hentification Muddled in Conflict

MEMPHIS, Tenn. — (AP)
— The mystery of who fired the shot that killed Martin Luther King Jr. became even more muddled Sunday as further conflict came to light over the identification of the mysterious Eric Starvo Galt as an escaped convict named James Earl Ray.

The FBI issued a conspiracy warrant last Wednesday for Eric Starvo Galt. Two days later the agency said a comparison of fingerprints found in the King investigation revealed that Galt in

reality is James Earl Ray, a 40-year-old escapee from a Missouri prison.

A murder warrant issued here in Galt's name subsequently was amended to carry the name of Ray.

The second identity was only the latest in a series of puzzles which have surrounded the investigation.

Witnesses who said they saw the alleged assassin leave the flophouse from which the fatal bullet was

fired said he appeared to be between 26 and 32 years of age. The FBI's Wednesday announcement said Galt had given his birth date as July 20, 1931 — which would make him 36. Friday the FBI said Ray was 40.

THE FBI also said Galt was said to be an avid dancer and took dancing lessons in New Orleans in 1964 and 1965, in Birmingham during September and October of 1967 and in Long Beach, Calif., from December 1967 to February 1968.

But during the time Galt allegedly took dancing lessons in New Orleans, Ray was serving part of a 20-year term for armed robbery in the Missouri State Penitentiary at Jefferson City.

At the time Galt was attending a bartending school in California, a duplicate Alabama driver's license was mailed to him at a rooming house in Birmingham.

The woman who runs the flophouse here said the man to whom she rented a room just three hours before King was slain had a southern drawl. Also, the FBI said Galt liked country and Western music and drank beer and vodka.

But in Jefferson City, an inmate of the Missouri prison, who said he "ran around" with Ray, said Ray — listed as a native of Illinois — did not have a southern accent.

"Jim didn't drink, except a little prison home brew," said the convict, who asked not to be identified. "He never talked about himself very much and never expressed any liking for music, dancing and he was too tight tolgamble."

Galt seemingly was a rree spender. Aside from the dancing lessons, which cost

him about \$500 in California alone, he paid \$2,000 cash for a white Mustang that is now impounded in Atlanta, and paid to attend the bartending school.

"He was tight as a tick," the Missouri convict said of Ray. "Boy, if you owed him money, even a few cents, he'd bug you to death."

The penitentiary inmate said he did not think Ray was the kind of man who would kill for profit. And the warden, Harold Swenson, said, "It's odd, but I won't believe he did it (killed King) until it is proven.

"None of the inmates gave blab about it. But while he's doing something, you don't hear a word."
