LELAND CLIFFORD PEARCE, Owner, Buckhead
Ridge Subdivision, Okeechobee, Florida, was advised
of the identity of the interviewer as a Special Agent of
the Federal Bureau of Investigation and of his rights as
contained in an executed waiver of rights form. Upon
signing the form PEARCE furnished the following information:

He was in the cattle business in Cuba in 1956 and 1957 and upon leaving Cuba he came to Okeechobee, Florida where he developed the Buckhead Ridge Subdivision, of which he is the sole owner. He is no longer in the cattle business and devotes all of his time to the developing of the subdivision and selling lots. He does not own any buildings or cottages on the property. For eighteen years, prior to going to Cuba, he was in the cattle business in Belle Glade, Florida. While in Belle Glade he became acquainted with WILLIAM PIERCE, who also went to Cuba in the 1950's to promote a middle east fiber called "Raime". He did not associate with WILLIAM PIERCE and in fact only spoke to him about a half a dozen times. He does not know what line of business WILLIAM PIERCE is in now nor does he know how he could be located.

He is not now nor has he ever been a member of the Ku Klux Klan nor is he sympathetic to their cause. He does not know the following individuals; BOB and WILLIAM BRICKLEY, BEN THOMPSON, EDDIE WILBURN nor JIM GARRISON, although he has read about JIM GARRISON in the paper. He did not do any building while in Cuba nor did he believe WILLIAM PIERCE did any building while in Cuba. He has never been to Kansas City, Kansas or Kansas City, Missouri, and in fact the only places he has been outside of the State of Florida are New Orleans for a cattle auction in the early 1950's, New York City, Washington, D.C., Thomasville, Georgia and Cuba. He does not own a plane nor does he do any flying.

He did not kill MARTIN LUTHER KING nor does he know who did nor does he know who might have been involved in the murder of KING. There is a member of the local Ku Klux Klan, JOHN THOMAS BOWLES, who was capable of participating in the murder of KING. BOWLES has a strong hatred for Negroes and was recently tried in Martin County, Florkda for beating up a school superintendent because of his efforts in integrating the schools. BOWLES owns a small two passenger Cub airplane that he keeps on Hog Island which is next to Buckhead Ridge. It is an open field without any lighting facilities. Deputy CURTIS WRIGHT, Glades County Sheriff's Office, had asked PEARCE to keep an eye on the airplane, particularly if the Klan was planning anything, so that BOWLES' whereabouts could be accounted for. He recalls that on the evening of the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING he made it a point to check the airplane and noted that it was gone. The next morning, around seven AM, while on his way to Okeechobee for coffee he noted that the plane was there; however, when he returned approximately an hour later the plane was gone. It was either the day following the death of KING, April 5, 1968, or the next day, April 6, 1968, that the airplane was gone and stayed gone for about two or three days. He had been told by BOWLES' girl friend, MARY KNIGHT, a barmaid at the Fin and Feather Bar in Buckhead Ridge that BOWLES had gone to Tampa to get his teeth fixed. BOWLES' wife, GERALDINE, is presently seeking a divorce although he believes they are still living together. He sold BOWLES a couple of lots in Buckhead Ridge and BOWLES built a home on one and his brother-in-law, CHARLES P. GRIZZAFFE, built the Ridge Apartments on the other lot. There are about sixteen units in the apartment. GRIZZAFFE is a businessmann who lives in Tampa, Florida. BOWLES and his wife, GERALDINE, manage the apartments for GRIZZAFFE.

WILLIAM SOMERSETT, formerly MM 607-R, who is no longer being contacted by the Miami Office and who is characterized as having furnished reliable information in the past, and in addition has furnished information which cannot be verified or corroborated, telephonically advised on 7/12/68 as follows:

Since the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., he has made trips to Atlanta, Ga. and Memphis, Tenn. at the request and expense of the Florida State Attorney's Office and the Miami, Florida Police Department. He indicated the purpose of these trips was to try and develop information relative to the assassination of Doctor KING and other information relating to the National States Rights Party. He did not elaborate on his assignments nor did he indicate he had developed any unusual or pertinent information. He reportedly was in contact with witnesses involved in the KING case and based on information heard on the "street," it was said that the chauffeur of Doctor KING was suspected of "setting up Doctor KING for the assassination." SOMERSETT was unable to identify source of this information.

On 7/24/68, PHILIP M. ZANG, who requested that his identity be protected although he would not mind, if necessary, his name being given to U.S. Secret Service, 2431 NW 28th St., Miami, Fla., telephonically advised at 2:20 PM as follows:

ZANG, who has been contacted by SA HURST in the past in connection with another case, inasmuch as his stepson, GARRETT BROCK TRAPNELL, is currently a Bureau fugitive (Miami 88-7644), owns two Diamond taxi cabs and operates one himself. He requested that if anyone needed to recontact him that he not be recontacted at his home, but that the Diamond Cab number, FR 9-7575, be called, and requested that ZANG call a certain person at a certain number. He stated that he goes into service from approximately 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM. ZANG stated that something has been bothering him, and he wanted to furnish the following information for whatever value it might have.

ZANG stated on 7/11/68, sometime around noon, he picked up a passenger at Leon's Bar, which is located at SW 8th St. and 70th Ave., Miami. He stated that the passenger had had a few drinks. He stated the passenger indicated through his conversation that he"disliked Negroes" and he also bragged about what had been done to ROBERT KENNEDY and to Reverend KING.

He indicated that he had no employment other than "working with his buddies". He indicated that any time he needed money that he could go to the nearest GEORGE WALLACE Presidential headquarters and obtain same. The passenger requested to be taken to the GEORGE WALLACE headquarters, Hialeah, Fla., which is located at about 3rd or 4th Street, just off Palm Ave. The man went into the headquarters and after a while, came out and said the boss was not in and he could not get any money. The passenger then requested he be taken to Cooper's Ranch Motel located on SW 8th St. where he was staying in Room 5.

He was taken to this address, and in lieu of paying a \$15.10 taxi fare, he packed two suitcases and gave them in payment of the fare. He signed the receipt showing that he owed \$15.00, which receipt he signed "ERNEST F. SIMPSON". The passenger described as a white male, age 60, 5'11" - 6', 175 pounds, reddish hair turning to gray, very outspoken in a rather loud way, indicated he had been in the construction business in the past.

On 7/25/68, D. LEE COOPER, owner and manger, Cooper's Ranch Motel, 7017 S.W. 8th Street, Miami, Florida, advised that ERNEST SIMPSON has been known to him for several years. He stated that SIMPSON is an alcoholic and has been arrested numerous times for drunkenness. He stated further that when drinking, SIMPSON is a "loud mouth and a braggart of many wild and exaggerated stories." At one time several years ago, SIMPSON was employed as a painter but has not held any steady employment of any type for many years.


COOPER is of the opinion that SIMPSON does not like Negroes. He has never known SIMPSON to openly or actively proceed against Negroes in any way. He does not believe that SIMPSON is associated with the WALLACE for President campaign and does not think SIMPSON is smart enough or stable enough to have had anything to do with the KING or KENNEDY assassinations.

COOPER advised that SIMPSON has no permanent address as he often sleeps where he falls when he is drunk, which is most of the time.

A white female named E. MOSLEY, whom COOPER also described as an alcoholic, rented Room 5 at

MM 44-1854 MM 44-1880 Cooper's Ranch Motel from 7/5/68 to 7/12/68. so much profane language that COOPER asked her to leave on the 10th of July. Since she had paid her rent until 7/12/68, she gave the room to SIMPSON for the remaining two days in order to get even with COOPER for asking her to leave. She left no permanent address and COOPER does not know where she went or where she came from. When SIMPSON slept in Room 5 on 7/11 and 7/12/68, he did not register since the room was already paid for. COOPER has not seen him since and does not know his current whereabouts. On 7/26/68, IC CLIFFORD M. WERNER reviewed the records of the Credit Bureau of Greater Miami with reference to ERNEST F. SIMPSON. These records contain no information identifiable with SIMPSON. On 7/26/68, IC WERNER reviewed the records of the Miami Beach PD with reference to SIMPSON. These records indicate SIMPSON was arrested for drunken driving on 2/1/63. On 2/22/63, he paid a \$125 fine as a result of this arrest and his license was suspended for three months. He was described as white male, born 7/19/12 at Greensboro, N.C. His eyes were listed as brown, his hair as gray, his height, 6'12" and his weight, 210 pounds. On 7/29/68, IC WERNER reviewed the records of the Dade County Department of Public Safety with reference to SIMPSON. These records indicate he was arrested on 10/23/65 for drunk driving and was sentenced to nine months in the Dade County Jail on 11/2/65. The Miami Municipal Court records indicate that SIMPSON was tried for drunkenness on 3/25/68 and received a 30-day sentence. He has been tried for drunkenness on at least 12 other occasions in the last five years and has received sentences ranging from fines to jail terms.

Mobile was requested to be alert as to activities of SIDNEY C. BARNES who reportedly was leaving for Jackson, Miss., 8/2/68.

SIDNEY CROCKETTE BARNES, 1379 East Riviera Drive, Mobile, Ala., is a bombing suspect of the Mobile Office and his activity has been covered in the past month by four different neighborhood sources. No information has been reported by these sources to indicate that BARNES was away from his residence just prior to or subsequent to the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING. These sources have furnished no information indicating that THOMAS A. TARRANTS, III or KATHLEEN AINSWORTH had stayed at the BARNES' residence.

In the late afternoon of 8/2/68, neighborhood source, Mrs. MARY LONGCRIER, 1382 East Riviera Drive, telephonically advised that at about 5:20 PM that date she had observed BARNES in his stationwagon which vehicle appeared to be packed as if BARNES was moving from the residence. She did not see Mrs. BARNES on that occasion.

On 8/5/68, neighborhood source, Mrs. GERALDINE WILKINSON, 1383 East Riviera Drive, advised that both Mr. and Mrs. BARNES, according to Mrs. WILKINSON's daughter, were at their residence late in the afternoon of Sunday, 8/4/68, and left in their stationwagon which was loaded down. She had not seen them on the morning of 8/5/68.

It appears that BARNES may be moving, possibly to Miss., since he works in Miss. His activities are being followed in order to determine whether or not he moves and to determine any contacts which may have a bearing on this case.

MARGARET CAPOMACCHIA, 2000 Jefferson Street, Hollywood, Florida, was interviewed at her residence. Prior to being interviewed, CAPOMACCHIA was appraised of the identities of LEONARD C. PETERSON and DAVID N. JELLISON as Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). She was advised of her rights and furnished with an Advice of Rights and Waiver form, which she read, but declined to execute.

At the outset of the interview, CAPOMACCHIA was very pleasant, cooperative and friendly; however, when asked to discuss the assassination of MARTIN LUTHER KING, she refused to do so. She said she wanted to hear nothing concerning KING or what happened to him. CAPOMACCHIA declined to furnish her whereabouts on the night of April 4, 1968.

CAPOMACCHIA denied knowing anyone by the name of THOMAS ALBERT TARRANTS, and said she had no knowledge of anyone named HAWKINS, DUNN, HARPER or WILSON.

CAPOMACCHIA stated further that she has been under severe stress and strain since the death of her daughter KATHY. She stated further that since her daughter died, she has had a constant headache.

While discussing the activities of her daughter, CAPOMACCHIA advised she was unaware of the extent of KATHY's involvement with individuals connected with bombing matters. She went on to describe her daughter as the best fifth grade school teacher in the United States.

CAPOMACCHIA declined to furnish any background information with regard to herself or her family.

The neighborhood sources have reported during the past weeks that BARNES has been loading boxes and clothing in the rear of his personally owned station wagon and has been taking them with him each morning as he drives to work, returning to his home in the evening with an empty car.

A review of the files of the Mobile Office fails to reflect current information concerning NOAH JEFFERSON CARDEN, but reflects that on 12/15/67 he operated a night club in Mobile called Jeff's Smokehouse, and resided at the time at 2359 W. Hollwood Rd., Mobile. CARDEN was observed in the Mobile area on 8/19/68 by members of the Mobile PD Intelligence Unit.

The current residence and employment of NOAH JEFFERSON CARDEN will be ascertained.

A review of the files of the Mobile Office fails to reflect any information concerning HORACE BYRON GAAR, JR., and there is no record of his having been in the Mobile area. As of late 1965 the whereabouts of GAAR were unknown at the Mobile Office, and no information has come to their attention indicating his present whereabouts.

DONALD LEE MITCHELL was interviewed at the Collier County Jail at his request. Prior to the interview, he was advised of his rights as reflected on an executed waiver of rights form.

MITCHELL furnished the following statement in his own handwriting:

"September 30, 1968

"I, DONALD LEE MITCHELL, make the following statement to Special Agent ERNEST HARRISON,
JR., whom I know to be a Special Agent of the
Federal Bureau of Investigation.

"In 1961, I had the opportunity to meet one JAMES EARL RAY. I was introduced by a friend of mine by the name of HAWKS, who was doing twenty four (24) years. He was from New Madrid, Missouri, not far from my home town of Kennett.

"He informed RAY that I was about the last of the good convicts. RAY said he was pleased to meet me, because the big city boys from St. Louis, and K.C., Mo. were turning out to be a bunch of 'punks'. This was the Mo. State Pen, Jefferson City, Mo.

"RAY was the quiet type of guy. He had very little to say to convicts or guards for that matter. I seen him every now and then, but didn't ask many question. We had used a little dope together, but that was all.

"RAY showed great comtemp for the colored convicts, as he very seldom talked to them except on business deals for dope or money. He was always telling me how the boys from St. Louis

MM 44-1854 "So I wanted to know what his plans were. This is how RAY, explained it to me. Some people (friends in St. Louis) fixed it with some one in Philadelphia, for him to kill Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. "I told RAY I didn't want to get mixed up in it. So he let me know real politely that I was already in it only didn't realise it yet. An I couldn't get out unless I wanted it. Than I agreed to go along, after I heard this. Also he told me I was coming up there to the pen, for chicken feed, was I afraid to get ahead? I told him no, but killing KING, we couldn't get away with. "RAY told me not to worry about a thing. Also how did a grand some of Fifty Thousand (50,000) dollars sound to me? I said great. but what if we get caught? He explained we wouldn't and if we did we would get out of it with a fixer lawyer, besides who in the South like "Niggers"?? "RAY also said after we get KING, we'll beable to get more for one of the KENNEDY's. I said that the Kennedy Family had done more for the United States, than anyone ever had. He said they were like KING, a bunch of Cominists all of them and that in the way they wanted people to believe, an I did. "RAY said: Take that punk J.F.K. (meaning JOHN F. KENNEDY, Late President) for instants, he made you eat with a nigger on the streets didn't he? He made you live by them, go to school with them. So how is he so great? I said, that a change had to come and we had better be ready for one. RAY got mad at me and said not as long as I can kill one of the (Obscene #2) . I seen he was angry, so I told him, I guess he was right about it. He said, he knew he was and would get KING to prove it. . 4 w 2025 RELEASE UNDER E.O. 14176

"At this time I wanted to know how, JAMES EARL RAY, planned to escape from the walls, of the Mo. State Pen.

"This is how it was to be done. RAY would leave his cell in the month of April, or approx. for the show. He would than have his bed fixed so as a gaurd would not discover him missing. Than I came into the picture:

"RAY was to place himself on top of the main kitchen, where I worked. Than at 2:30 AM I was to send him food and cigarettes, with a jar of water. He was to remain there for about three days, after that I was to get some kind of pills he gave me into the coffee that was to be sent to the Gauard Towers.

"After that he would wait until they were asleep and he would go over the wall. He had someone, by the name of VINCE or VINCESON waiting on him from St. Louis, Mo.

"RAY continued to pass me notes, on the matter up until the night he plan to leave.

"The first note read: DON L. don't let me down if you do you know the score. But you won't!

"The second was. Tear these notes up and flush them! Say can't you just see all that money for one lousey Nigger? We will live in style and travle the world. You can bring your girl along. Your Pal JIM.

"#No. Three: 'Pal, the time has grown near, so all is left is the wait. I think April 12, is a good day, or do you believe Lucky 13. Smile friend, JIM.'

"The last note was:
