HOMER HENDERSON, Henderson Laundry, 116 E. Colo., Walters, Okla. W. F. ORISWOLD, 1015 C Ave., Griswold's Cleaners & Laundry, Lawton.

HENRY MICK, Superintendant, Laundry & Dry Cleaning Branch, Special Services, 5650 Sheridan Rd., Ft. Sill, Oklahoma, advised he uses the Thermo-Seal Marking Machine, however he uses only white tags and marks fatigue uniforms with the machine and no other type of clothing. He pointed out this machine costs over \$2,000 and it would be used only in the larger laundries in cities such as Oklahoma City and about that size.

The Lawton issues of the current Telephone Directory and Polk's 1967 Directory were searched for the names, HARVEY LOWMEYER or LOWMYER, and ERIC STARVO GALT, with negative results.

SA DON ROBERTS, contacted MORELLA ROBERTS, Cotton County Court House, Walters, Oklahoma, and KAY DALEY, Comache County Electoral Board, Lawton, regarding the possible registration of HARVEY LOWMENER or LOWMYER, with negative results. SA ROBERTS also contacted the SO & PD, Lawton, in this regard with negative results.

SAS ROBERT E. HUTCHINGS was give the specific assignment making the above checks at Anadarko, Chickasha and other small towns in Grady and Caddo County. 
