AMONG ARTICLES RECOVERED AT SCENE OF SHOOTING, APPARENTLY ABANDONED BY UNSUB, WERE A PAIR OF BROWNISH CHECKERED PRINT UNDERSHORTS AND WHITE JOCKEY TEE SHIRT BEARING CLOTH LAUNDRY TAGS. THESE TAGS WERE MADE BY A THERMO SEAL MARKING MACHINE MANUFACTURED BY THE TEXTILE MARKING MACHINE COMPANY, SYRACUSE, NEW YORK. THESE TAGS ARE ONE QUARTER INCH WIDE AND ONE AND ONE SIXTEENTH INCH LONG, RED IN COLOR AND BEAR MARKING WHICH APPEARS TO BE "O TWO B DASH SIX" OR "D TWO B DASH SIX." ONLY A PORTION OF THE FIRST CHARACTER IS PRESENT ON EACH TAG, AND THIS CHARACTER IS CUT ON A SLIGHT BIAS. NO OTHER VISIBLE LAUNDRY MARKS WERE FOUND ON EITHER GARMENT.

He stated he was recently told by R [REDACTED] and D [REDACTED] that they saw the composite photograph of the murderer of MARTIN LUTHER KING and they believed this individual is a person who has resided with the mother of D [REDACTED] B [REDACTED]. Mr. M [REDACTED] stated he recalls that approximately one year ago he reported information to the FBI, originating with R [REDACTED] and D [REDACTED], regarding their knowledge of this same individual being responsible for the bombings and killings of Negroes in the Florida area. He stated the B [REDACTED] were interviewed by the FBI regarding this matter. He stated he was told by the B [REDACTED] that they have seen this individual in Oklahoma City since the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING.

A review of Oklahoma City files reflects [REDACTED] captioned "T [REDACTED] L [REDACTED] aka, MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING," wherein R [REDACTED] and D [REDACTED] furnished information regarding T [REDACTED] L [REDACTED] being responsible for racial offenses in Florida and Alabama.

It is noted M [REDACTED] advised that neither R [REDACTED] nor D [REDACTED] are at their residence during the daytime hours but should be available at the home of a relative, R [REDACTED], [REDACTED] Del City, Oklahoma.

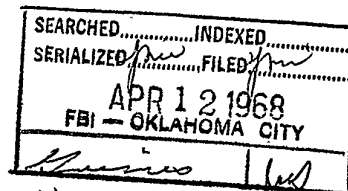

Search of premises believed occupied by Unsub who assassinated Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING on 4/4/68, disclosed suitcase in which was located tee-shirt and undershorts bearing laundry mark on red tape with black lettering believed to be thermo-seal type, manufactured by Textile Marking Machine Co., Inc., Syracuse, N. Y. The tape is $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide and $1\frac{1}{16}$ " long and bears letters and numbers 02B-6.

Experts at Textile Marking Machine Co. advise type on this machine is unusual in that the first two characters are 15 point type and the last three characters are 18 point type, with the middle character, the letter B, probably being narrow rather than regular type. The usual machine carries 15 point type for the first three characters and 18 point type for the last two characters.

Textile Marking Machine experts also stated this machine is defective in that it is producing a tape 1 1/16" long instead of 1 1/8" long and is not projecting the tape far enough resulting in cutting off a portion of the first letter. The code used in the Northeast part of the U. S. is as follows:

The first letter O stands for lot number; the first number 2 indicates the day of the week, two being Tuesday; the second letter indicates the first letter of the store name, this is the letter B; the last number is the bundle number, this is 6. Color coding of the tag may designate various things such as a different month or the identity of a store in a chain. Experts also state the use of this system on laundry items is unusual in that the system is normally used on garments being dry cleaned.

The Bureau has instructed that all textile machines using this type tape be located and machines using this code be identified.
