> At 10:00 PM, 4/13/68, Reverend S' Oklahoma City Oklahoma telephone advised as follows: At approximately 7:15 PM, that date, he was proceeding to Earlsboro, Oklahoma, to conduct religious services at a local church. Shortly before reaching the Earlsboro exit on Interstate 40. a young man in a black convertible Mustang passed him at a high rate of speed. He stated as the Mustang passed, he noted the license number to be Hines County, Mississippi tag HB931 After noticing the Mustang bore a Mississippi license, he passed the car in order to get a further look at the occupant. He noticed that the occupant had a long sharp nose and resembled the artist's conception of the murderer of KING, which he had recently seen in an Oklahoma City newspaper.


stated that shortly after passing this individual he pulled off the Earlsboro exit and the subject also pulled off the exit and pulled into a cafe located on the right hand side of the exit. The subject parked behind a service station located adjacent to the restaurant, even though parking space was available in front of the restaurant. stated he had driven past the restaurant Reverend H but returned and parked near the motel adjacent to the restaurant and walked by the window of the restaurant in order to obtain a closer view of the Subject.

He described the subject as about 27 to 28 years of age; 5' 10" to 6'; 165 to 170 pounds, short dark hair which was windblown at the time. Subject was dressed in green trousers and a lighter green shirt, which appeared to be uniform type work clothes. He observed the Subject was in the restaurant for only a few minutes, left the restaurant and got in his car, and proceeded east on Interstate 40.





Further, on 4/15/68, SA d made personal contact with W. in the presence of J \mathbf{H} Which time advised that his permanent address is Cleveland, Ohio, that he left home 4/4/68in his personally owned vehicle which he described as a 1967 Chevrolet, bearing 1968 Ohio license AG 1321. He stated that en route, he stopped at a roadside reststop to the east side of Angolia, Ohio where he said he was attacked from behind by two Negro males, age about 18 and 22, whom he could not further describe. He stated these Negroes had beaten him about the chest and legs and broke his glasses and left him lying face down in a dazed condition at the roadway, near his car. He said they stole over \$200 from him which he had rolled up his one of his trouser pockets. He said they drove off in what he thought was a 1956 Buick. G said he did not report this incident to any law enforcement agency because he was mainly interested in getting out of that area. He said he proceeded to Chicago, Illinois where he spent Saturday and Sunday nights. 4/5 and 6/68, with a cousin, D. Chicago, Illinois.

He said that he had intensions when leaving Cleveland to go to El Paso, Texas. frFnom Chicago, he arrived in Oklahoma City, 4/11/68 where he checked into the YMCA on Northwest 5th Street, where his car is currently located at a parking lot at that location.

He said that early Sunday morning, 4/14/68, he began to feel very uncomfortable in the area of his left chest, that he had taken about 4 ozs. of brandy to relieve what he thought may have been conjection. He said the situation did not improve, that he was taken by an ambulance first to St. Anthony's hospital and then transferred to V.

said that he has never been in Memphis, Tennessee, that in fact he has never been in the state of Tennessee and stated that he knows nothing concerning the assassination of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. and that he said that upon admission to the VAH or at least that he meant to say that upon admission to VAH, that he had been beaten about the chest on the same date of the assassination in Memphis, Tennessee. 

DIRECTOR J. EDGAR LOOVER STITED THAT A FEDERAL COMPLAINT WAS FILED BY THE FBI IN BIRMINGHAM, ALAEAMA, TODAY CHARGING GALT WITH CONSPIRING TO VIOLATE THE CIVIL RIGHTS OF DR. KING IN VIOLATION OF TITLE 18, SECTION 241, OF THE UNITED STATES CODE.

THE FBI COMPLAINT CHARGES THAT "ON OR ABOUT MARCH 29, 1968, AT BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA, ... ERIC STARVO GALT AND AN INDIVIDUAL WHOM HE ALLEGED TO BE HIS BROTHER, ENTERED INTO A CONSPIRACY WHICH CONTINUED UNTIL ON OR ALOUT APRIL 5, 1968, TO INJURE, OPPRESS, THREATEN, CR INTIMIDATE MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.,... IN THE FREE EXERCISE OR ENJOYMENT OF A RIGHT SECURED TO HIM EY THE CONSTITUTION OR LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES; NAMELY, THE KIGHT TO FREELY TRAVEL FROM STATE TO STATE. IN FURTHERANCE OF THIS CONSPIRACY, ERIC STARVO GALT DID, ON OR ABOUT MARCH 30, 1968, PURCHASE A RIFLE AT BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA..."

ACCORDING TO MR. HOGVER, A 30.06 RIFLE EQUIPPED WITH A TELESCOPIC SIGHT WAS FOUND NEAR A ROOMING HOUSE ON SOUTH MAIN STREET IN MEMPHIS IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE FATAL SHOOTING OF DR. KING OCCURRED. THE ROOMING HOUSE OVERLOOKS THE LORRAINE HOTEL AND NOTEL WHERE DR. KING WAS STAYING.

MR. HOGVER SAID THAT FBI AGENTS DETERMINED THAT THE 30.05 RIFLE HAD BEEN PURCHASED FROM A GUN DEALER IN BIRMINGHAM, AL B'M7, ON MARCH 30, 1968. THE TELESCOPIC SIGHT ALSO WAS PURCH. SED FROM THIS DEALER.

THE FBI DIRECTOR SAID THAT CALT, WHO HAS USED THE MOMES OF JOHN WILLARD AND MARVEY LOWMYER IN THE FAST, IS THE OWNES OF A 1966 WHITE MUSTANG BEARING ALABAMA LICENSE PLATES WHICH WAS LOCATED ADAMONED IN ATLANTA, GEORGIA, ON APRIL 11, 1968. INVESTIGATION DISCLOSED THAT GALT FURCHASED THIS CAR FROM A PRIVATE CITIZEN IN EIRMINGHAM ON AUGUST 30, 1967. THE MUSTANG'S OLOMETER SHOWED THAT IT HAD BEEN DRIVEN MORE THAN 19,000 MILES BETWEEN LATE AUGUST, 1967, AND EARLY APRIL, 1968.

ACCORDING TO MR. HOOVER, GALT'S TRAVELS IN THE MUSTANG INCLUDED TRIPS TO LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA; NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIAMA; BIRMINCHAM, ALABAMA; AND MEXICO, AS WELL AS TO MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE, AND ATLANTA, GEORGIA. GALT WAS REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN IN MEMPHIS ON APRIL 3 AND 4, 1966, AND TO HAVE DEPARTED FROM THERE FOR ATLANTA.

INTENSIVE INESTIGATION BY THE FFI HAS DISCLOSED THAT CALT HAS CLAIMED TO PAVE BEEN EMPLOYED AS A COOK ON MISSISSIPPI RIVER VESSELS AND AS A MERCHANT SEAMAN. FE IS SAID TO BE AN AVID DANCER AND TOOK DANCING LESSONS IN NEW ORLEANS IN 1964 AND 1965; IN BIRMINGHAM DURING SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER, 1967; AND IN LONG BEACH CALIFORNIA. FROM DECEMBER, 1967 TO FEBRUARY, 1968.

HIS WHITE MUSTANG TO NEW ORLEANS, WHERE HE CLAIMED HE CONTACTED





An actual photograph of GALT has been received from the Bureau and copies of the photograph are being made to furnish all Agents. A memorandum is also being prepared for all Agents setting forth all information known to this office regarding GALT's activities and whereabouts which will assist in the handling of leads in this case.


